Dear Blue Mountain Broadcasting Association:

This letter is to advise you that, pursuant to Section 614 of the Communications Act and the implementing rules of the Federal Communications Commission, Charter Communications has not received your 2005 letter of election notifying us of K22BI's intended status (must carry or retransmission consent) for the three-year period beginning January 1, 2006. Since Charter Communications has not been notified of your station's election, your station will be deemed to have elected a must carry status for the relevant three year period.

If Charter Communications is in error regarding your must carry election status, please promptly provide a copy of your retransmission consent election letter sent to Charter Communications, as well as, proof that the letter was mailed by the October 1, 2005 deadline to the attention of:
