| Girls On The Run | April 1st- 23rd | 5 times a day | :30 | These recorded promotional announcements invited listeners to this special 5K and 10K Run for the YWCA Girls On The Run program. The event is April 23 rd in Mankato |
| Fun.com Halfway To Halloween 5K | April 1st-30th | 5 times a day | :30 | These recorded promotional announcements invited listeners to the 5K Run-Walk. This is a fundraiser for the Miracle League and Fallenstein Field in North Mankato. They provide athletic activities for people with disabilities. April 30th 2016 |
| Mankato Hub Autism | April 2 & 3 | 5:35am | 5min | This episode of the Mankato Community Hub featured a discussion on autism touching on prevalence, impacts and treatment. The guest speaker was Karen Wright, who is the chair of the Southern Minnesota Autism Coalition and the mother of a son with autism. |
| Mankato Hub Distracted Driving | April 9 & 10 | 5:35am | 5min | This episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on Distracted Driving with guest speaker Troy Christianson with the Minnesota State Patrol. Each year in Minnesota, distracted or inattentive driving is a factor in one in four crashes, resulting in at least 70 deaths and 350 serious injuries. |
| Mankato Hub Sexual Assault | April 16 & 17 | 5:35am | 5min | This episode of the Mankato Community Hub revolved around Sexual Assault Awareness month and featured guest speaker Laura Schultz with the Women's Center at MSU-Mankato. It's estimated that one-in-five women will be the victim of a sexual assault or attempted sexual assault in their lifetime. |
| Mankato Hub Miracle League | April 23 & 24 | 5:35am | 5min | This episode of the Mankato Community Hub featured guest speaker Eric Sletten with the Miracle League of North Mankato. The Miracle League provides recreational opportunities for those individuals with disabilities. |

| Mankato Hub Elderly Driving | April 30 & May 1 | 5:35am | 5min | This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on the issues around elderly people and driving skills. Guest speaker Troy Christianson with the Minnesota State Patrol talked about the impact of aging on the ability to be safe behind the wheel and what families can do when there are concerns. By the year 2030, about one-fifth of Minnesota's population will be age 65 or older. |
| Mankato Hub School Truancy | May 7 & May 8 | 5:35am | 5min | This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on the issues around school truancy. The guest speaker was Blue Earth County Attorney Pat McDermott, who leads a program that intervenes when a student is missing too much school. McDermott says taking proactive steps and keeping kids actively engaged in classes helps keep them out of the criminal justice system as they get older. |
| Mankato Hub Mental Health | May 14 & May 15 | 5:35am | 5min | This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on mental health. The guest speaker was Ann Rosenquist Fee, the executive director of the Arts Center of St. Peter, which is hosting an exhibition of art made by patients at the State Security Hospital in St. Peter. Research shows that art can help people reduce stress, increase self-esteem and manage behaviors. |
| Mankato Hub Foster Care | May 21 & May 22 | 5:35am | 5min | This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on the need for foster families. The guest speaker was Anne Broskoff, social services director for Blue Earth County. In Blue Earth County, there are about 100 children in out of home placements. Statewide, there are nearly 15,000 foster children. |
| Mankato Hub Lyme Disease | May 28 & May 29 | 5;35am | 5min | This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on Lyme Disease with the guest speaker Dr. Eric Gomez of the Mayo Clinic Health System in Mankato. The discussion involved everything from prevention to treatment. There are about 1,000 cases of Lyme Disease in Minnesota every year. |

| Mankato Hub Election Reform | June 4 & June 5 | 5:35am | 5min | - This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub featured Minnesota Secretary of State Steve Simon, discussing some of the election reforms that passed the legislature this year, along with some of his election priorities. Among the changes approved in the 2016 session was one to move Minnesota from a caucus system to a presidential primary, aiming to get more people involved in the process. |
| Mankato Hub Senior Financial Abuse | June 11 & June 12 | 5:35am | 5min | - This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub focused on the issues around the financial abuse of senior citizens. The guest speaker was Barb Grieman, senior vice president of the Better Business Bureau of Minnesota. Caregiver financial abuse costs seniors \$7 billion a year and the most common pepetrators of financial exploitation of older adults are family members. |
| Mankato Hub Women's Foundation Of MN | June 18 & June 19 | 5:35am | 5min | - This week's episode of the Mankato Community Hub featured guest speaker Mary Beth Hanson with the Women's Foundation of Minnesota. The focus was on sex trafficking in Greater Mankato. Since November of 2014, there have been nearly 60 prostitution related arrests in Blue Earth, Brown and Nicollet counties. |
