Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **Agriculture**. Agriculture is critical to Montana's economy. News about agricultural issues such as the Farm Bill and Clean Water Act are important to the listeners in our area.
- B. **Spy balloon**. In early February, a balloon of Chinese origin, suspected to be for surveillance purposes, drifted over Montana. There was concern and outrage at the local, state, and national levels.
- C. **Grizzly bears**. The de-listing of the grizzly bear as an endangered species opens them up to hunting. It is important in our area given the increasing livestock predation by grizzlies and encounters with humans.
- D. **Law Enforcement**. There has been an increase in violent crime in our listening area recently, raising concerns regarding law enforcement, along with news on the Missing or Murdered Indigenous People project.
- E. **Infrastructure**. Road construction and other infrastructure projects often mean bottlenecks, delays or detours. Knowing when and where such projects will be taking place is appreciated by our listeners.
