**Re:** KDVR and KWGN (each, a “Station”), each a broadcast television station that is licensed to a subsidiary of Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. (“Nexstar” or “we”) and licensed to the Denver DMA (the “Covered DMA”)

Dear Stacy:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter to the Station, dated October 7, 2019, notifying the Station of your intent to provide cable television service solely in the Covered DMA beginning December 7, 2019.

Pursuant to 47 USC § 325(b)(3)(B), 47 CFR 76.64(f)(2), and 47 CFR 76.64(k) Nexstar elects, for the remainder of the three-year period ending December 31, 2020, to assert its right, under 47 USC § 325(b)(1)(A) and 47 CFR 76.64(a), to have the broadcast signal of each Station carried on cable systems only if we have provided our express written consent. This election applies to each system identified in your letter and any other cable or other qualifying multichannel video programming distribution system that you own, operate, or manage. This election is not intended to affect any retransmission consent or other agreements that Nexstar (or any related companies) may currently have in place with you.

I also note that Rodeo Networks, LLC currently has in place a retransmission consent agreement with Nexstar that covers carriage of all of Nexstar’s stations (including these Stations, which Nexstar recently acquired from Tribune Media Company) on all of Rodeo Networks, LLC’s qualified systems.

We look forward to discussing your retransmission of the Station’s signal and related matters with you in the near future.
