WODC provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Asthma and allergies:** Representatives from the American Lung Association talked about improving the understanding of asthma, allergic asthma and some available testing options.
- **Bone health/calcium deficiency:** Representatives from the American Dairy Association discussed a USDA report that says nine out of ten women and seven out of ten men fail to meet the recommended two to three servings a day of calcium and more than half of all children don't get enough. They gave information to help stop the trend toward calcium deficiency.
- **Buying a home:** Members from the Ohio Board of Realtors talked about how the process of buying a home has changed dramatically, and how working with a mortgage lender is the best way to get solid information on hand when you start your search for a home.
- **Community involvement:** Area schoolchildren talked about their holiday volunteer work during the winter school break and the importance of community service while in school.
- **Diabetes: Genetics and Prevention:** This special edition produced by iHeartRadio and hosted by Shelli Sonstein, took a closer look at what it means to live with diabetes, the risk factors of prediabetes and the role genetics play in preventing and understanding the disease better.
- **Managing personal finances:** Local financial expert Terrance Williams talked about how a growing number of people are finding that keeping their checking and savings accounts at the same bank is costing them money. He discussed how an intranet bank can be a viable alternative.
