WODC provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **9/11 Day of Remembrance:** This special edition from iHeartRadio and hosted by Shelli Sonstein discussed 9/11 Day as a day of remembrance and the continued impact 9/11 has had on first responders. Other topics included a first-hand account from the highest ranking first responder who has actually fallen ill from 9/11 toxins and interviews with Edward Cetnar, Superintendent of Police/Director of Public Safety of New York/New Jersey and 9/11 Day co-founder Jay Winuk, whose younger brother died in the line of duty in the terrorist attack at the World Trade Center.
- **Asthma and allergies:** Representatives from the American Lung Association talked about how asthma and allergy sufferers can keep allergy triggers out of their homes.
- **Avoiding foreclosure scams:** Michael Wallace, a local mortgage management expert, talked about the rise in foreclosure scams. He discussed how troubled homeowners should seek assistance from a HUD-approved counselor or work directly with their mortgage lender.
- **Blood pressure and heart health:** Dr. B.J. Hicks, a local cardiovascular surgeon, talked about how important it is to monitor your blood pressure, as high blood pressure is a symptomless disease that can increase your risk for a number of health problems, including damage to the heart and coronary arteries.
- **Cancer and women:** Kathy Thompson of the Department of Recreation talked about the many exercise programs developed to help battle cancers unique to women, including a regular walking activity. She said it can also help cancer survivors live longer, healthier lives.
- **Heart health:** Officials from the American Heart Association talked about atrial fibrillation - or A-Fib, which they said are sensations of having a fluttering or rapid heartbeat, increasing the risk of clotting and stroke.

- **New treatments for Parkinson's disease:** Officials from the Parkinson Foundation discussed how they strive to discover new and better treatments for Parkinson's disease, a progressive neurological disorder.
- **Obesity and anesthesia:** Members of the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists talked about how being extremely overweight can raise the risk of complications from anesthesia. They said that anesthesia professionals are well-prepared to care for obese patients, but a healthy lifestyle that includes regular exercise, good eating and proper rest can help ensure a safe and comfortable anesthesia experience.
- **Selective Service System registration:** Mark Elliot of the Selective Service System talked about how young men who turn 18 soon after graduation will need to produce proof that they have registered with the Selective Service System in order to get a job, enter training programs or college or join the military.
- **Seniors and hot weather:** Officials from the U.S. Administration On Aging talked about how the extreme heat of this summer's weather can pose a threat for older adults, especially those with health problems. They offered information on staying hydrated and getting help with energy bills.
- **Small business and local dollars:** Marla Williams of the U.S. Small Business Administration, discussed how community banks use local dollars to help families purchase homes, finance college educations and build financial security.
