WODC provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Ashville & Pickaway County family health:** Pickaway County Health Department officials discussed the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic and how it has impacted local medical facilities.
- **Ashville-Area Heritage Society springtime programs:** Ashville-Area Heritage Society members and volunteers discussed the winter services taking place for seniors and how they are following current COVID-19 protocols in managing these events.
- **Ashville & Pickaway County heart health for women:** American Heart Association Communications Director Brianne Harman talked about women's heart health.
- **Military & Veterans:** Veterans talked about the Ashville Memorial Day weekend festivities honoring veterans and their families.
- **Women and cancer screening:** Officials from Ohio Health talked about women's health as part of the Women's Health Initiative. She offered information and advice to women who weren't able to get their mammograms and other cancer screenings done since COVID-19 started.
