

CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASS A

Section (f)(2)(A) of the Community Broadcasters Protection Act ("CBPA) and Section 73.6001 of the Commission's rules set for the continuing eligibility requirements for Class A licensees.

To maintain its eligibility for a Class A license, a Class A station must continue to broadcast at least 18 hours per day, and must broadcast at least 3 hours per week of locally produced programming. The FCC has defined "locally produced programming" as programming "produced within the predicted Grade B contour of the station or within the predicted Grade B contours of the stations in a commonly owned group," or "programming produced at the station's main studio." 47 C.F.R. §73.6000.

The aforementioned information applies to KMPH-CD Merced-Mariposa for the period January 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015.
