

**License Renewal Announcements:  
Pre-filing and Post-filing Instructions and Text**

By December 1, 2012, WSWG must file a renewal application on Form 303-S (and an EEO Program Report on FCC Form 396) with the Commission. The first step in the renewal process is to broadcast pre-filing announcements. WSWG must begin these announcements on October 1. These announcements must air on specific days at specific times as explained below.

**Pre-Filing Announcement Instructions**

Notice of a station's upcoming license renewal application filing must be broadcast a total of four times in advance of the December 1 filing date – once a day on October 1, October 16, November 1 and November 16.

At least two of the four announcements must be broadcast between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. The two remaining pre-filing announcements may be broadcast at any time on the scheduled days.

In addition, when presenting pre-filing announcements, you must broadcast visuals with the station's and the FCC's addresses when this information is being presented orally by the announcer.

**Text of the Pre-Filing Announcement**

On October 21, 2005, WSWG was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until April 1, 2013.

Our license will expire on April 1, 2013. We must file an application for license renewal with the FCC by December 1, 2012. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for public inspection at [www.fcc.gov](http://www.fcc.gov). It contains information concerning this station's performance during the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by March 1, 2013.

Further information concerning the Commission's broadcast license renewal process is available at 107 Second Avenue, Southwest, Moultrie, Georgia 31768 or may be obtained from the FCC, Washington, DC 20554.

### **Post Filing Announcements**

After its license renewal application is filed, WSWG must broadcast notice of the filing a total of six times – at least once a day on **December 1, December 16, January 1, January 16, February 1 and February 16.**

At least three of the six announcements must be broadcast between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. Of the remaining three post-filing announcements, one should be broadcast between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., one between 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m., and one between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

As with the pre-filing announcements, when presenting post-filing announcements, WSWG must use visuals with the licensee's and the FCC's addresses when this information is being presented orally by the announcer.

### **Text for Post-filing announcements**

On October 21, 2005, WSWG was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until April 1, 2013.

Our license will expire on April 1, 2013. We must file an application for license renewal with the FCC by December 1, 2012. We have filed an application for license renewal with the FCC.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the FCC by March 1, 2013.

### **Certification**

WSWG must record the date and times of both the pre-filing and post-filing announcements on a certification form. Once all the notices are completed, the station must place this certification in its public file. Attached is a certification form to use for recording this information.
