Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **November Election** The November election is approaching. We had multiple guests on discussing items that would be appearing on the ballot or impacting the election process.
- B. **Wildfires and Air Quality, Health** There were multiple wildfires across the state this summer, and we also had smoke from out-of-state fires blow in, impacting the air quality. More than one guest mentioned the health impacts of poor air quality and what to do about it.
- C. **Agriculture and Farming** A sizable portion of our listeners are farmers and ranchers. We had several interviews discussing ag-related news and information.
- D. **School Safety** The new school year began in this quarter, and following the shooting in Uvalde, Texas, the topic of how to protect students from a potential school shooting was brought up over the summer. Cascade County Sheriff Jesse Slaughter has put forward a proposal to have armed, plainclothes personnel in the schools.
