Dear Affiliate Partner:

To assist you in complying with the reporting requirements for children's television and the requirement that stations air "core" children's programming, we are providing you with episode-specific descriptions (the '**NBC Kids**' educational and informational programming block) as set forth in the attached Community Relations Quarterly Children's Programming Report for the 1st quarter of 2015. The report includes information to help prepare FCC Form 398. Please note that we have not included the specific dates and times for each of the programs as that may be station-specific.

This report is divided into the following categories:

1. Educational Objectives: NBC Kids for both 1st quarter 2015 and 2nd quarter 2015.
2. Core programming: Regularly scheduled programming furnished by the NBC Network that is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children 16 and under. Each of these programs is identified on-air as educational and informational with the "E/I" icon, and is similarly identified to the national listing services. To assist stations with the preemption report section of FCC Form 398, we have added specific episode numbers. Please note that the age target for NBC Kids programming is identified as 2-5 years old.
3. Other programming: Programming furnished by the NBC Network that contributes to the educational and informational needs of children 16 and under, but is not specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs of children.
4. Public service announcements targeted to children 16 and under.
5. Non-broadcast efforts that enhance the educational and informational value of NBC Network programming to children.
6. Network on-air promotional efforts, which include a schedule of NBC on-air promos for NBC Kids programming.

The regularly-scheduled children's programming and promotional content furnished to you by the NBC Network during the 1st quarter of 2015 complied with the commercial limits of the Children's Television Act, and 47 C.F.R. §§ 73.670(a)-(d), provided that you broadcast and distributed such programming as furnished to you by NBC, and did not add any promotional or advertising content thereto other than as directed by NBC via weekly postings on APT.

Note Regarding FCC's Video Description Rules: The programs supplied in the NBC Kids block are video-described to provide a better viewing experience for blind or visually impaired children. *Under the FCC's video description rules that became effective on July 1, 2012, full-power affiliates of the ABC, CBS, Fox and NBC networks that are located in the top 25 television markets must provide 50 hours per calendar quarter of video-described programming during prime time or in children's programming. A video described program may be counted toward the 50 hours when it is originally aired and on one re-airing. Although much of the programming aired with video description is likely to be newly produced, stations may count any program they are airing for the first or second time with video description after the effective date, even if the program aired on that station without video description prior to the effective date. Similarly, a station may count programming toward its 50-hour obligation even if that programming has aired elsewhere with video description, as long as it is airing with description for the first or second time on that station.*

1st QUARTER 2015 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the Children's Television Act regulations that became effective January 2, 1997, the **NBC Kids** programming block features an on-air icon (E/I) indicating that each program is "educational and informational" for children. **This icon is displayed throughout each program.** Also, in compliance with the regulations, the following document, which includes "early educational and informational" objectives of **NBC Kids**, must be placed in your public file.

The **NBC Kids** programming block also meets the requirements for video described content, as established by the Twenty-first Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act, effective October 8, 2010. Full-power affiliates of NBC that are located in the 25 television markets with the largest number of television households must provide video-described content at any time they are providing children's programming. Each episode of content can be aired no more than twice in the calendar year.

Each of the programs listed below, which make up the three hour **NBC Kids** programming block, is specifically designed to serve the early educational and informational needs of children ages 2-5. All of the programs have educational objectives and messages that are core to the content and appropriate for the program genre.

From January 3rd – March 28, 2015 **NBC Kids** aired six shows returning from the 4th Quarter 2014. These are: **Astroblast, The Chica Show, Tree Fu Tom, Lazy Town, Poppy Cat, and Noodle and Doodle.**

All six shows were developed specifically for a target audience composed of children ages 2-5. **Noodle and Doodle** is a live action, fact based, craft and cooking show. The five remaining shows have a narrative format and two of the shows (**The Chica Show** and **Tree Fu Tom**) use elements of fantasy and imagination to develop the educational content. **The Chica Show** and **Tree Fu Tom** combine live action with animation, while **Lazy Town** is live action with puppets. **Poppy Cat** and **Astroblast** are both animated series.

Astroblast, based on the book series by author and illustrator Bob Kolar, is set on a space station in an unknown solar system. Five animal characters and one three-eyed octopus (of unknown derivation) populate the station. Each episode begins with an everyday conversation or incident that grows into a predicament needing a solution. While these predicaments take place in a fantasy environment, the issues and resolutions resonate for a preschool audience. Through comedy and zippy action, our target audience sees how the characters learn lessons for practical living such as how to keep track of things that belong to

you, practice good habits, clean up when you've made a mess, rebound from a failure or an embarrassing incident, or resist the urge to blame others for your mistakes.

The Chica Show features a five-year-old “baby” chick that spends her days with her parents in their costume shop, the Coop. The shop's one employee, Kelly, doubles as Chica's nanny and the ensemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit, and Stitches, a straw mannequin that sits in the window. In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately resolve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgment, and inter-personal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work on the problem through an adventure—a fantasy transformation to animation—where Bunji and Stitches come alive and join Chica and Kelly for the problem solving process. The core educational content is primarily socio-emotional development as Chica learns how to express herself properly, think before she acts, and interact with others effectively. She often learns that it takes hard work and practice to become proficient at different skills.

Tree Fu Tom is a live action/animated series about a little boy who lives in a rural area, yet has a rich fantasy life in the woods behind his home. Tom uses specific movements to summon up magic powers that permit him to morph into an animated hero and fly around in Treetopolis, the fantasy version of his woods. While in Treetopolis, Tom and his friends, Ariella, Twigs, Squirmturn and Zigzoo will invariably run into a problem or disaster that needs fixing. Tom calls upon the audience to practice original dance moves that will bring him “Big World” magic so he and his friends can resolve their challenge of the day. Educational messages reinforce positive socio-emotional content, with examples that model: being loyal to good friends, knowing how to ask for help, doing the right thing instead of what is convenient, making the effort to share rather than being selfish and relying on teamwork in order to accomplish a goal.

Lazy Town encourages fitness and healthful habits for preschool children. In the imaginary setting of Lazy Town, characters' eating and fitness habits are linked to problem solving in their world. The lead character is Stephanie, a young girl who guides the audience through the story as she and her friends (“human” puppets) and her Uncle (Mayor Milford Meanswell) navigate life within Lazy Town. Robbie Rotten, the underground spy and influencer who personifies the ethos of Lazy Town, is determined to ruin the health and fitness practices of Stephanie and her friends. When the kids have difficulty with Robbie Rotten, Sportacus (a gymnast/athlete prepared to answer any call for help) comes to the rescue from his home in a zeppelin-like aircraft that hovers over earth. The underlying themes of Lazy Town stress the importance of eating “sports candy” (aka fruits and vegetables), always obtaining sufficient sleep, and going outside to engage in a wide range of physical activities that include playing games, competing athletically, and even building forts and play structures.

Poppy Cat based on a book series by Lara Jones, models the use of imagination and storytelling to encourage creative thinking in viewers. Each episode features the narrator Lara, reading a story about Poppy Cat, to her own cat (who is also named Poppy). She weaves an exciting tale following her imagination, which leads her to distant lands reached by boat, plane, hot air balloon or train. Each story features Poppy Cat as the leader of a group of animal friends, including the resident bully Egbert the badger, and other occasionally recurring characters. A prevailing message emerges within each episode to be nice to your friends and always work together. There remains an overarching implicit message within every episode as well; think creatively and exercise your mind through reading and storytelling – for these activities always lead to enjoyment and adventure.

Noodle and Doodle, an instructional series, features art and cooking projects around a specific theme. Host, Sean, drives around in a double-decker bus fully equipped with art supplies and a kitchen, ready for

any assignment. The projects encourage parent engagement and often feature families working together to make something to display within the child's home. Sean's side-kick, Doggity, is an ever-faithful beagle who transforms into an animated character during interstitial trips to a parallel universe, set in a kitchen full of prank playing animated characters. The art projects typically promote utilizing recycled materials in order to demonstrate that creativity can transform something intended for one purpose into something that achieves a completely different goal.

2nd QUARTER 2015 EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

In the 2nd quarter, **Noodle and Doodle** will be replaced by a new animated series, **Earth to Luna**.

Earth to Luna is a Brazilian animated series specifically aimed at teaching 2-5 year old children how to ask questions about nature and science and vigorously pursue the answers. The show encourages curiosity, research, and critical thinking. Each episode of the show is focused on a particular creature, object, or phenomenon that would be of interest to the target audience. For example, Luna might wonder how she can grow a plant without a seed and finds the answer through her inquiry process. The characters, Luna, Jupiter (her brother), and Clive (their pet ferret) embark on a research effort that takes the audience through each step that answers their overarching question. The show uses recurring features, signature phrases, and songs to cue the audience when they need to do research, when they transition to the adventure, and when they have reached the ending to review all they've learned.

1st QUARTER 2015 SHOW SUMMARIES

Astroblast is the space station and home of six animal characters in Bob Colar's book series of the same name. The space station is managed by an over-confident and exuberant commander, Comet the dog. The crew includes, Sputnik the pig, a very knowledgeable reader; Haley, a rabbit, Comet's true peer and an athlete; Radar, the monkey, who is somewhat self-involved, Jet, a silent alligator whose gestures and expressions are his mode of communication, and Sal, a congenial three-eyed octopus who runs the counter in the Smoothie Shack, the space station café. While the space station supports the missions of a bizarre and diverse array of aliens, the Smoothie Shack is the hub of social interaction for the galaxy. There is always something happening at Astroblast and everyone on the crew has plenty to learn to keep the community happy and on an even keel.

The Chica Show features a five-year-old "baby" chick that spends her days with her parents in their costume shop, the Coop. The shop's one employee, Kelly, doubles as Chica's nanny and the ensemble is rounded out with Bunji, a large floppy eared rabbit and Stitches, a straw mannequin that sits in the window. Chica's parents were formerly entertainers in the vaudeville tradition and they regale the audience with stories and songs from their theatrical past. They enjoy and indulge Chica, who sometimes acts younger than her age and gets into all kinds of predicaments. Kelly uses fantasy play to transform herself, Chica, Bunji and Stitches into animated characters in another universe, who are struggling with a problem similar to the one Chica experienced in the Coop. Without fail, they find the problem can be solved and they carry that knowledge back to the Coop to use on another day.

Tree Fu Tom focuses on the amazing adventures of a young boy called Tom who, with the power of 'Big World' magic that depends upon specific movements, can transform into a tiny but mighty magical super hero who travels to the wondrous enchanted kingdom of Treetopolis. During each program Tom calls upon the audience to follow his moves and send him the "Big World" magic he needs to solve the problem he and his friends are facing. These friends include Ariella, a butterfly who is also a rancher and has rope lassoing skills, Twigs, an acorn sprite who folds himself into an acorn when he's frightened, Squirmturn, a pill bug

who looks like a large and imposing coal miner but is often timid and fearful, and Zigzoo, a green tree frog who is the resident genius inventor. In each episode there are action adventure sequences that are key to resolving the challenge of the day.

Lazy Town is a show featuring the importance of health, fitness, and being good friends. Set in a fantasy world known as Lazy Town, which is populated by inactive residents, we meet a visitor named Stephanie who is determined to coax her friends and relatives into adopting a healthful, active life style. She wins over her new friends, Ziggy, Stingy, Trixie and Pixel, convincing them to leave their gaming consoles and candy stashes at home so they can go outside and play. She persuades her uncle, Mayor Milford Meanswell, and his friend Ms. Busy Body to support her efforts. Robbie Rotten, who lives underground, and is determined to return Lazy Town to its former state of inactivity and quiet, constantly foils the characters' efforts. The athlete Sportacus, who lives in a zeppelin-like aircraft and receives signals from the kids or the Mayor whenever they need help, frequently comes to their rescue. Sportacus has two goals, to keep the peace and to promote healthful, positive living. When Robbie Rotten is discovered and contained through comic pratfalls, he returns to his underground lair and all is well in Lazy Town, until another day and another time when Robbie will rise again.

Poppy Cat is based on the **Poppy Cat's Adventures** book series authored and illustrated by Lara Jones. A narrator, also named Lara, reads a story to her cat in each episode. This story stars the narrator's own Poppy Cat, who envisions and takes his friends on imaginary adventures. The friends are Zuzu, a Dalmatian who zips around on a skateboard; Alma, a southern belle bunny who is ultra-feminine and sweetly dramatic, Mo, a little mouse who tries his best to do as much as everyone else despite his size; Owl, the wise one who is prone to neck rolls and commentary when things irritate him or don't make sense, and the grouchy Egbert, an arrogant and obnoxious badger who refuses to play with the group and invariably attempts to sabotage their adventures. Occasionally Hilda, a forgetful and ditzy pigeon who flies into their adventures, appears, says hello and provides misguided directions to the friends. Once their mission is accomplished, the friends return to their little village and resume their cheerful, active lives. At the conclusion of her story, Lara closes her book and says good-bye to Poppy Cat, who is usually ready for his nap.

Noodle and Doodle is a live-action show hosted by Sean Roach that also blends animation and puppetry into the overall format. Sean drives a double-decker bus into various communities to meet children who have written to him with a problem that they would like to solve using an art and/or a food experience. Sean is accompanied by Noodle, a puppet character and Doodle, a digital character that lives inside a tablet computer, and Doggity, a faithful beagle. Doggity has a mini-show of his own through an animated alter ego that appears during a transitional segment of the episode. Overall, Noodle and Doodle, demonstrates how recycled materials can become art and how food, art, and problem solving can be combined to create a fun experience in everyday life. Every episode can be replicated at home with ease by parents and children playing together.

2nd QUARTER 2015 SHOW SUMMARIES

In the 2nd Quarter, **Noodle and Doodle** will be replaced by **Earth to Luna**, a new animated series.

Earth to Luna is a Brazilian animated series about 12 year old girl, Luna, who loves science and the outdoors. There is nothing she doesn't question, and she shares everything she learns with her little brother, Jupiter, her parents or her friend Alice, and Clive, her pet ferret. In each episode Luna and her brother develop questions about whatever they find curious, e.g., "what goes on inside the snails' shell?" or "Why does a firefly blink?" In pursuit of answers, Luna, Jupiter and Clive go off on an imaginary adventure to do their research. They transform into the object or creature they are studying so they can personally

experience the answers to their questions. When the threesome is finished with the “field trip” Luna summarizes everything they have learned with a show and a song.

Sputnik returns to find Comet anxious and he confesses to everything. When Sputnik opens the door, Zorky grows throughout the Space Station. Comet apologizes to Sputnik, and Sputnik lets the Astroblast crew know that if they don’t feed or water him, Zorky will shrink back in a few months.

[Educational Message: It is important to follow directions when taking care of any living thing; otherwise, it might get sick or weak.]

BUILDING THE PERFECT PRESENT [EATB101DH]

Comet is making a present for Sputnik’s birthday: a custom-made bookmark to replace the one she lost. However, when he compares the gift he *made* to the gifts his friends *bought*, he starts to doubt if his gift is good enough. Comet creates new presents based on what his friends used in theirs, but fails. He then combines all the features of his friends’ gifts to create the perfect gift. When he shows Sputnik her gift: A Super-Rain-Sparkle-Glitter-Plant-Music-Balloon, Sputnik is hesitant, but tells Comet she likes it. While showing her present, the balloon pops and goes zooming through the air to the ground. Comet is upset, but Sputnik says she enjoyed her present and their friendship is the only present she needs. Comet is still upset, but remembers the bookmark he made and gives it to Sputnik, who loves it.

[Educational Message: The best gifts come from the heart; whether they are purchased or handmade is not important.]

CAPTAIN CHICA REDCOMB [ETCS101DH]

Billy comes to the shop for a pirate’s hat. Chica then pretends to be a pirate with one of the Coop’s costume hats. Though she is reminded frequently to put the pirate hat where it belongs, Chica misplaces it. When Billy returns to get five more hats, Kelly finds she is missing one hat from the order. After the store closes Chica and Kelly go on their fantasy adventure to an island where they meet pirate Captain Stitches. Kelly reminds them that they wouldn’t have to go through so much trouble to find things if they put them where

they belong, but if they can't find it they should retrace their steps. Chica finally remembers she dropped the hat next to Bunji's cage. As they close the store, Kelly packs the hat to take to Billy's birthday party.

[Educational Message: You should always put things back where they belong so they do not get lost. If not, you will have to retrace your steps to remember where you left it.]

THE AMAZING CHICADINI [ETCS101DH]

Chica shows talent for becoming a magician, but she gets so nervous and frightened during rehearsals for her magic show that she cannot perform at all. When the store closes, Chica and Kelly create a magic show right in the store. Chica performs her first trick well, but her second trick (turning Bunji into a daffodil) doesn't work. They move on to Chica's magic trick to make Stitches disappear and it is a failure too. Kelly tells her to just have confidence and believe in herself. Chica tries again and Stitches disappears. Then, she makes him reappear. The audience is very pleased.

[Educational Message: It takes practice and belief in yourself to overcome being nervous.]

TOM'S FAN CLUB [ETFT203DH]

Tree Tog teaches a class of little sprites about the skills they will need to live successfully in the woods. The sprites are so impressed that they lavish fawning praise and adulation on Tom. Flattered, Tom completely ignores Tree Tog's request to take the spring beetle eggs to Ariela's farm where they can hatch and be sent to open space for jumping and playing. Needless to say when Tom passes the responsibility on to Twigs (because he's enjoying himself with the sprites) the beetles not only hatch at the barn, they tie up Ariela strapping her to the roof. Finally Twigs is able to get a message to Tom who comes to the rescue and releases the beetles into the wild. He is very apologetic for letting the little sprites distract him from his most important task.

[Educational Message: Compliments and praise really make us feel special but never feel so special that you disrespect your elders and ignore your responsibilities.]

They then realize she wasn't writing the mean notes; they had to have come from another source, Robbie Rotten.

They almost lose the toothbrush to Egbert and an underwater volcano, but the explosive force of the volcano convinces them to believe it probably did get blown inland from the sea. She is very appreciative and Mouse thanks everyone for believing he could do something big after all.

[Educational Message: Even someone who is very small can do something very big.]

ACORN TIME [EPCT201DH]

The group is playing outside, but Owl is grumpy. He wants to go on a vacation. He wants another house. He wants to be left alone to sulk. The group starts talking about how to help Owl, when Mouse and Clara decide that Owl might feel better by planting an acorn tree that would grow really big. Poppy Cat suggests going to a forest where trees can grow very fast and then Owl will have his own tree to make him happy. They go on their adventure, have a mishap, thanks to Egbert, but eventually get to the special forest where Owl's acorn is planted and his new tree really does grow very tall and wide. Treehouse Trevor agrees to take care of Owl's tree and he tells the group they can all use the big tree as a vacation home.

[Educational Message: It always good to do things that will cheer up a grumpy friend. When people see how much you care about them, their mood will change to show their gratitude.]

Patrick, Julie, and Elaine are on a camping trip and need a healthy snack for their hike. Sean and Noodle make the popcorn trail mix in the kitchen while the kids gather items from the campsite. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang prepares grab-n-go turkey wraps for a roomful of runners who need energy that will last. The kids return and create a nature picture scene. They take the trail mix to enjoy after a nice hike.

[Educational Message: You can create a special craft from items around the campsite to remember your camping adventures; you can make a healthy treat to enjoy after a nice hike.]

PUPPY SHOW [ENAD119DH]

Mo, Alisha and Laura want to put on a puppet show for their family. They brainstorm with Sean to make a puppet theater, including paper bag puppets using paper bags and other recycled items from around the house. Sean and Noodle prepare a basket of goodies just like Little Red Riding Hood – delicious pumpkin date cookies, so they decide to use the pumpkin seeds as teeth and the recycled containers for the puppets. In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes apple-icious grilled cheese sandwiches for a deserving group of teachers. The kids come and enjoy making puppets from the items they've collected and

the recycled items from preparing the goodies. They put on an amazing show and enjoy the pumpkin date cookies with their audience afterwards.

[Educational Message: You can put on a puppet show using items from around your house to fashion puppets.]

After trying various talents (dancing, painting, etc.), they decide their styles are way too different to perform together. Comet is big, exciting, and messy, while Sputnik is neat, simple, and refined. Sal tells them that working together doesn't mean you have to do the exact same thing. Comet and Sputnik decide to combine their talents (Sputnik reads a story, Comet acts it out) and they win first prize.

[Educational Message: We all have different talents so work together to best use each person's talents and overcome differences.]

When Kelly and Chica go on their fantasy adventure, Bunji becomes the dance instructor and Chica practices the pirouette but it turns out to be the “wing and spin,” a new ballet movement. Back at the Coop, Kelly and Chica continue to practice their moves.

[Educational Message: When you want to learn something new, start with the basics and keep practicing in order to improve.]

TIGER BIKE [EPCT202DH]

Poppy and her friends are watching Zuzu perform tricks on his new bicycle. Alma is worried about a letter from Ravi the Tiger on Tiger Island, because he left his bicycle on the beach, where it washed away with the tide. The group decides to help Ravi find his bicycle though Zuzu reluctantly agrees to go because he’d rather continue practicing his tricks. When the friends arrive at Tiger Island and meet up with Ravi, they dive underwater to look for his bicycle, but Zuzu abandons the search. The friends find an octopus named Ozzie pedaling Ravi’s bicycle and though they plead with him to return it, Ozzie negotiates a deal to give it up if he loses a bicycle race. Fortunately, Zuzu returns and accepts the challenge. He wins the race and is glad he stopped sulking and decided to join his friends by helping to retrieve the lost bike.

[Educational Message: If a friend has a serious problem, you can make the time to help; it always feels better to help a friend than to say “no” because you’d rather play].

In Doggity’s animation imagination segment the gang makes grab-n-go turkey wraps for a roomful of hungry runners needing long-lasting energy. The kids return and create the practice cones and decorate them to look like a mascot for the team! They take the bars to enjoy at halftime and energize them for the rest of the game.

[Educational Message: You can make a craft that will help you practice for your favorite sport, like cones to do soccer drills; you can enjoy a healthy energy bar to keep you going during the game.]

A PIRATE PARTY [ENAD120DH]

A group of friends are having a pirate party and want to make some treasures. They brainstorm with Sean to create golden fish nuggets to eat at the party and recycle the boxes from the ingredients to make pirate telescopes together. Sean and Noodle work together to make the golden fish nugget treasures while the kids get ready for the pirate party. In Doggity’s animation imagination segment the gang prepares treasure chest treats using dried fruits for a group of pirates. The kids come back and create the pirate telescopes. They take the crafts and treats to the party to enjoy together!

[Educational Message: You can make all the decorations and treats for a party from things around your house.]

To make him feel better, the Astroblast crew comes together and creates an obstacle course in the Space Station so Comet can play the game on his own.

When they return to the Coop, Chica resolves to follow the rules.

[Educational Message: Rules are made for a reason and are there to ensure that everyone can be safe, courteous and orderly.]

ICKY, STICKY, CHICKY [ETCS103DH]

There's an emergency at the Coop; Kelly can't find a costume for a customer who wants to be a caveman. Kelly and Chica disappear into a "cave" deep beneath the clothing rack. Mom and Dad then decide they need to figure out a way to better manage inventory so Chica makes signs that illustrate the types of costumes. However, she doesn't want to wash off the glue and other decorations that got stuck in her feathers. During the fantasy adventure, Kelly and Chica are outside in a prehistoric forest and get really dirty with mud. After bathing in a pond, the group plays again when they are clean and realize it feels pretty good to not be messy and dirty.

[Educational Message: When you get icky, sticky, and dirty from playing or doing a project, be sure to clean up the mess you made, including the mess that gets left on yourself.]

When they tell Ziggy about the “zapper,” Sportacus is skeptical and teaches them “when there is work to be done, there are no shortcuts.” Robbie Rotten steals the “zapper” while the kids are engrossed in video games. Robbie disguises himself as a child in need of help and zaps Sportacus – but realizes that the zapper only makes things invisible. The kids realize this too, when they discover invisible, sticky messes. Stephanie feels bad that she should have just cleaned her room because her uncle gets injured in the invisible mess. Pixel vows to get the zapper back, and with the help of invisible Spartacus, he fights Robbie Rotten and retrieves it. They get to work rematerializing the invisible things in Lazy Town. Pixel and Stephanie apologize for being lazy and mean to each other, they agree that there are not any shortcuts for the work that needs to be done.

[Educational Message: When there is work to be done, like cleaning your room, there are not any shortcuts.]

The friends run to help her and discover that Hilary rolled right into Pillow Valley, where one of her hedgehog friends is already hibernating. The friends give Mo a chance to take a nap before they leave, and once he's rested with a perfect pillow the friends head home.

Educational Message: Friends needs to understand that everyone needs to get a good night's sleep in order to feel good during the day. If you or your friend is having trouble sleeping, maybe finding the right pillow will help solve the problem.

In Doggity's animation imagination segment the gang makes apple-icious grilled cheese sandwiches for a hungry group of teachers. The kids return and create the piggy bank to keep their earnings.

[Educational Message: You can help with a bake-sale fundraiser by making crafty treats and make a piggy bank from recycled items for a fun way to keep the money safe during the sale.]

Comet understands and cancels the game because they don't have enough players. Radar confesses to Comet that he played Digi-Soccer before and accidentally scored a point for the other team. Comet convinces him to give it another try, and he scores a goal for *his* team.

[Educational Message: You should always tell the truth when you're afraid to repeat something that you once failed; lying may get you into bigger trouble. You might have success with a second try.]

[Educational Message: The first rule of being safe is always to watch where you are going so you don't bump into anything or anyone.]

After going on a fantasy adventure with Kelly she meets two rude and obnoxious Vikings she convinces to have better manners.

Everyone gives him great positive feedback but Owl refuses the job when he realizes that he would have to live away from his friends. Poppy suggests that Owl teach Carol how to cut topiary and once they start, she has ideas of her own.

[Educational Message: Making art is a process that depends upon your own vision of what you want to create. Everyone has their own ideas and will express them in their own way.]

A father and son come into the store and want an artist's costume. When the father shows his son's beautiful painting, Chica is prompted to share her picture of a cow. Kelly doesn't realize it's a cow, nor does she lavish as much attention on Chica's picture, which makes Chica feel less confident about her work. On their fantasy adventure, Chica, Kelly, Stitches and Bunji go to a museum where Stitches and Bunji pose for Chica next to a bowl of fruit and vegetables for a painting. Kelly (as Lavender Lilac) is an art patron who delights in Chica's work and purchases her Still Life. When they return to the store, Chica is confident enough to give Kelly a drawing she made of Bunji and Kelly notices something special: Chica's special signature of polka dots.

[Educational Message: Being a good artist is about enjoying the process of expressing your vision and feelings through painting and drawing. Develop your own style because your vision is what's most important.]

Owl is upset because the clouds are blocking the sun and his sunflower is drooping. Poppy suggests they go to Sunnyside Island, a place in The Salty Seas, where it's always sunny. Using a sailing ship, the friends set off for the island. When Zuzu spots Gilda the pigeon, Poppy asks for directions and Gilda responds that they should ask Owl's sunflower because it will stretch and look for the sun. However, after an encounter with Egbert aka Captain Big Boot, the Most Mysterious Sailor on the Seven Seas-- the friends boat is set off course and run aground a small sandbar. Owl apologizes for them getting stranded because of his flower but Poppy tells him they started on this adventure together and friends will stick together and make it fun. And then they realize they are sitting on the back of blue whale named Charles who offers to guide their boat to Sunnyside Island. When they arrive, they find more sunflowers and before they return home in their boat, Owl decides to leave his flower on the island where it can grow and be happy.

[Educational Message: True friends will help you solve the problems that are important to you and will stick by you even if the job is not easy.]

[Educational Message: You can make a creative game for a family road trip from recycled items; and create a snack for the journey].

It is a really hot day, and a group of friends are doing all they can to stay cool. They brainstorm with Sean to make watermelon ice pops and colored ice cube pictures. In Doggity's animation imagination segment they make treasure chest treats using dried fruit for a group of hungry pirates. The kids return and freeze colored water pops to use to paint paper towel ice cream cones. They enjoy all the creative ways to stay cool on a hot day together.

[Educational Message: You can find creative ways to stay cool on a hot day, like making frozen colored art work and watermelon ice pops.]

Comet gets inspired to be a super hero after reading his Captain Super Duper comic book. After saving Radar from falling down, he realizes that he can be a hero and save people. Later, Sal emphasizes that Comet be true to himself and stop trying to be a fictional super hero. Comet realizes that his friends did not really need his saving.

[Educational Message: You don't have to be a super hero to save people.]

DON'T TOUCH [EATB106DH]

Comet receives a kung fu cape for his Captain Super Duper action figure, and the Astroblast crew plays with him. The crew decides that since his cape is delicate, they won't play with Captain Super Duper unless Comet is around. Radar plays with Captain Super Duper without asking and breaks him. While hiding from Comet, Radar runs into Sal, who notices Captain Super Duper is broken. He tries to fix him but can't and Radar decides that he is going to live in the ceiling for the rest of his life. Sal uses Radar's favorite pencil to write his "goodbye" note to the crew, and he breaks the pencil. Sal has the courage to tell Radar what happened and Radar realizes that he should have the courage to tell Comet what happened to the action figure. Radar apologizes to Comet, and although Comet is mad, he is glad that Radar told the truth. Comet fixes Captain Super Duper and the crew plays with him.

[Educational Message: Always ask before touching someone else's things and always tell if you've broken something that belongs to someone else. It's very hard to do, but if it was an accident people will gradually understand.]

Chica is unable to catch the ball and feels like giving up because she is not the best, despite Kelly urging her to practice. On their fantasy adventure Chica takes a chance and tries three new games and is really good at just one. She realizes that fun is just as important as being a winner. When they return to the store, Chica is willing to give baseball a new try.

[Educational Message: You can have fun at games even if you don’t win or perform the best. The most important thing is that you give games a try and to that you have fun, win or lose.]

SUPER CHICA! [ETCS106DH]

Chica feels badly because Bunji has gone missing; she left the cage door open while getting Bunji’s food. Chica accepts responsibility for Bunji being lost, but everyone pitches in to find the rabbit. After her parents and Kelly help out, Dad finds Bunji sneaking a nibble of the food left on the floor. Chica is glad Bunji was found, but really wanted to be the one to undo her own mistake. On the fantasy adventure, Chica, Bunji and Kelly are “super heroes” in a city where Mr. Bubledeedoo (Stitches) is blowing so many big bubbles he is a nuisance. In order to stop Mr. Bubledeedoo, they have to work as a team and Chica understands that in some cases, it takes teamwork to solve a problem.

[Educational Message: It is not always possible that one person can be the super problem solver. Sometimes it is necessary to work with a group in order to get the job done and the problem solved.]

So Stingy enjoys his treasure while Knight Robbie Rotten proclaims laws that he wants and locks Stingy away. Stingy realizes he misses his friends. The friends don't like Stingy's laws, but want to be his friend even though he's been selfish. Robbie Rotten traps the children when they arrive at Stingy's castle and Sportacus must save them all.

[Educational Message: Even when someone is not acting like a friend, the right thing to do is to be there for them and offer them help; also, selfishness and greed will prevent friends from having fun.]

Poppy Cat continues to facilitate similar compromises. It is because of Alma's picnic that Zuzu finally gets to meet Speedy Sal, as he decided to rest and refuel at Alma's picnic. Alma and Zuzu are pleased that they decided to compromise by simultaneously engaging in both of their new activities.

[Educational Message: It is more fun to listen to and compromise with your friends than it is to argue and play alone.]

DRESSING UP [EPCT206DH]

[Educational Message: Trying to act like another person just makes you a copycat, so it's best to develop yourself based on your own talents and personality. People want to know you not a copycat.]

When an order comes in for a Yak costume, Chica assumes she can fill the order (so her parents can rest), but alas, while the costume is a Chica original, it is not a Yak. Chica feels she totally let her parents down and they won't love her anymore. On their fantasy adventure, Chica and Bunji are parents whose children, Kelly and Stiches, accidentally toss Bunji's perfect carrot cake into the air. Even though the cake was ruined, parents Chica and Bunji reassured their "son" he was still loved. Returning to the shop, Mr. C tells Chica her spa was such a big hit, he is now building her mother a new luxury bird bath. Chica realizes her parents still love her despite her mistake.

[Educational Message: Parents do expect their children to do their best, but even if they get upset if mistakes get made or accidents happen, the love will always be there.]

In Doggity's Diner animation imagination segment the gang makes party pita pizzas. The kids return and make scratch-and-sniff birthday cards using the

orange net bag for lots of texture and gelatin powder to give the paint a scent and texture. They take the cards and treat to Acer to enjoy his birthday together!

[Educational Message: You can make a card and treat to show your friend how much you care about him for his birthday; if you have a blind friend, you can be sure the card engages all the senses.]

Radar is so obsessed with the action figures, Sal decides to leave and warns Radar that he needs to try something new. Radar then goes to a pick-up game of Anti Anti-Gravity Freeze Tag but quickly inserts Billy Starrider into the game. Finally, in frustration, the team goes to work at the Frosty Star, but Radar still wants to play Billy Starrider, driving customers away. Radar's friends confront him about always playing and talking about his action figures. Radar agrees and asks for help on what else he can play that doesn't involve Billy Starrider. Halley takes him out on her surfboard, and he discovers that yes, there are other games to be played.

[Educational Message: Fixating on just one thing all the time means you aren't having as much fun or contact with friends as you could have. You might lose friends because you won't try new things.]

She has definite ideas about how to manage the circus and it doesn't include listening to the ideas of others. No one's act is satisfactory, according to Chica. On the fantasy adventure with Kelly, Chica finds herself as ringmaster to another circus. She enforces a roll call, and pronounces that HER circus is great, but it needs to become AMAZING. Each performer must change their act. Chica's expectations are too high and the new acts do not work. The performers all quit and Chica realizes that she should have listened to her performers and let them do what they do best.

[Educational Message: When you are the leader, it is important to listen to ideas from your team so you can figure out what they can do well and help make your project a big success.]

When they get there, Egbert tries to steal the medallion. To stop him, Poppy uses the medallion to deflect geyser water onto Egbert's pink disco wig. This tactic is successful; however everyone now notices that the medallion is not made of real gold, as the gold paint dripping off on the ground. Despite this, Zuzu still appreciates the medallion because of its story and the fact that it belonged to his great-great-great grandfather.

[Educational Message: Just because something isn't costly, it can still be special because of its sentimental value.]

A family at the lighthouse wants to make a souvenir lighthouse to show their dad. They brainstorm to make a lighthouse from recycled containers and red craft clay. Sean and Noodle make the red craft clay in the kitchen while the kids gather the recycled containers to shape the clay. In Doggity's Diner animation imagination segment the gang makes sea burgers for a group of hungry scuba divers. The kids return and use little containers to shape the craft clay into a lighthouse. They take home their lighthouses to show their dads what they saw!

[Educational Message: You can make a craft to show your parent about something you see on a trip, like a lighthouse.]

Comet is excited because it’s 2-for-1 day at the Pingo Pongian Waterpark Superslide, and Halley decides to stay behind at the store since she’s already been to the Waterpark. After the crew leaves, a large group of Kahoodians comes in and overwhelms Halley. She realizes that it will take forever to make smoothies for the large group if she only does one fruit at a time, so she puts a bunch in and overloads the Zippity causing a big mess in the kitchen. Halley goes looking for Sal but he is not available, so she decides to take it one step at a time. Halley fixes and cleans the Zippity, and successfully fills all the orders of the Kahoodians.

[Educational Message: When you are overwhelmed, try to calm yourself down and take things one step at a time. It might be possible to still get your work done without any help and things will be okay.]

Jett, the delivery man, stubs his toe in the shop. Chica feels that she wasn’t important in helping Jett because she didn’t have the right sized bandage and she managed to wrap Jett up like a mummy. Her mom, Mrs. C. had the right size bandage and fixed it. On their fantasy adventure, Kelly, Bunji and Chica are all doctors in Fairy Land. Stitches, also a fairy, cannot fly so he knows something is wrong. No one knows exactly what’s wrong, but they all try to help Stitches “feel better.” A drink of water, a Band-Aid, and a hug from all three “doctors” improves Stitches’ mood. Even though they did not have a real solution, they discovered how to make a friend feel better.

[Educational Message: Even if you are not a doctor, you can always make someone feel better by being helpful, kind, and supportive when another person is hurt or sick.]

[Educational Message: Even though you may really want your friend to do something, you shouldn't be pushy. Also, when you overcome nervousness, you can end up having a lot of fun!]

So the group changes how they do their cheerleading and find a role for Bunji. Chica realizes that to add people you can change the way the game is played so everyone can have more fun.

[Educational Message: Always tell the truth. The consequences will usually not be so bad because you parents prefer that you be honest and you will feel better too for not lying.]

BLUE RIBBON CHICA [ETCS202DH]

Chica helps an uncle and his nephew reach a compromise on a costume for the Fair by combining the features of both a robot and a dodo bird costume. When Mr. and Mrs. C try to decide what to do with her ruined cherry pie and his "stuck-in-the-door" pumpkin, they reach a compromise by making a pumpkin pie for the Fair's pie competition. Chica isn't convinced this is a good idea, but on the fantasy adventure she discovers something new. Kelly, Chica and Bunji all start to argue about who can do what in the show where they are performing. They compromise by combining all three acts and put on a spectacular show.

[Educational Message: Sometimes you can't agree to do one single thing. So the solution is to compromise and do a little of each thing that each person wants to do.]
