During the last twelve months, WVLA and KZUP , in accordance with the FCC, has adopted

a 3-prong approach outreach recruitment program for each full-time job opening

(except) internal job promotions:

Prong One : Recruitment for all full-time vacancies. Widely disseminate information concerning each full-time (30 hours or more) job vacancy, except for vacancies filled in exigent circumstances.

Prong Two: Notification to Community Groups. Notification of all full-time job openings to any organization that distributes employment opportunities to job seekers to potential employees and requested to be notified, and ;

Prong Three: Menu Options. Engage in a specified number of activities selected from a menu of options-four (for employment units with more than ten (10) full-time employees located in larger markets)
