1) Minorities/Communities

March 17, 2015

3pm to 4pm 1 hour

Howie discussed the CEO of Starbucks' attempts to enter the race and prejudice discussions in this country by requiring their baristas to talk about race with customers. Howie was outraged and wanted to know from callers who else was offended by Starbucks requiring customers to discuss race in order to get a cup of coffee. Howie and many listeners felt this proposal makes the race situation worse.
