WBIG-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community, as determined by discussions with members of the Clear Channel Washington Local Advisory Board and other community leaders. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Animal Safety:** Poplar Spring Animal Sanctuary,
- **ARTS:** A music organization helps people with disabilities
- **DRUNK DRIVING:** Under-age drinking, drinking myths, drunk driving legislation and the Sober Ride free taxi service.
- **Employment:** Assertiveness at work, how graduates should look at careers, competition, networking and early jobs, habits that get you fired, diversity in the work place.
- **ENVIRONMENT:** County recycling goals, requirements, awareness awards, what happens to recycled materials.
- **Health:** Youth cigar smoking cessation campaign, brain tumors, prescription drug abuse.
- **HUNGER PREVENTION:** Discuss hunger in the region and the Capitol Area Food Bank.
- **Parenting:** Child Abuser Prevention Month, Kids Need Connections, foster care, teachable moments.
