WBiG-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community, as determined by discussions with members of the Clear Channel Washington Local Advisory Board and other community leaders. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Animal Safety:** Animal safety during winter and related issues.
- **CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION:** Parenting experts discuss how to deal with child sexual abuse and a SCAN parent education program.

- **Transportation:** Rising gas prices, legislation in MD, VA and DC, HOT lane updates and Metro track work and escalator repairs.
- **VOLUNTEERING:** Free volunteer tax preparation assistance for low income families at an upcoming event
