This certification is in addition to the attached list for the FCC's Issues/Programs Report for this quarter. WCLF TV-22 routinely produces and airs approximately 190-198 hours of programming each quarter, which helps to educate people in *skillful, purposeful-living*, in addition to those already listed in this quarterly report. These meaningful programs help one to manage life's issues, are based on Biblical principles and precepts, and accomplished through a live phone-in program.

"You & Me" is aired live each weekday night (from <sup>11 pm to 2 AM</sup> ~~12: Midnight to 3:00 AM~~) with the live-host, answering questions, offering advice, and involving the other callers in recommending guidance, discussing and praying for a variety of topics, which could include: women's issues, family, health, community ventures and co-ops; teenage issues; as well as financial advice, adult education, substance abuse – prevention – recovery; in addition to soup kitchens, and homeless ministries or for otherwise impoverished people. The hours that the program is aired suggests; lonely, hurting, distressed, intoxicated, or otherwise dejected people.

"You & Me" is not scripted, there is usually no format, and as you might imagine, it would be cost prohibitive for us to tape record and save each three-hour presentation. Taped programs are used only in an emergency, where the "live" host could not make it to the studio, and a guest host could not be summoned in time. I'm sure that there are many other categories I have failed to mention, as on certain occasions, the host will select a specific theme for that night.
