At least 11 Israeli soldiers have been killed so far in this operation, which has really broadened over the past several days. Of course, Israel, in the immediate aftermath of that Hamas massacre perpetrated on October 7th, the worst massacre of the Jewish people since the Holocaust, Israel responded immediately with major air strikes throughout Gaza, weakening the Hamas terror infrastructure in the strip and now Israel has followed up with a ground invasion, air, land, and sea forces striking Hamas in Gaza. Tonight a very Special Edition of Israel Under Fire: March for Israel. Erick Stakelbeck is in Dallas, but tonight he takes us to the nation's capital, Washington D.C., for a massive march for Israel. Over the past several weeks we've shown you the disturbing clips here on TBN of these massive pro-Hamas, anti-Israel, openly Anti-Semitic rallies. This massive rally today in D.C. is a much-needed response to that. Some estimates say at least 100,000 people are converging on the National Mall. Jews, Christians, united together in support of Israel, standing with the Jewish people for such a time as this. Again, a time when Anti-Semitism is skyrocketing to levels we haven't seen since World War II. There are several speakers, including Pastor John Hagee, a bi-partisan list, because support for Israel should be something that unites us across partisan lines in an increasingly polarized obviously political climate. We should all be able to agree that Israel is a rock-solid ally of the United States, a beacon for freedom and democracy in the heart of the middle east. The state of play: October 7th, over one month ago, that heinous massacre, the greatest massacre of the Jewish people since the holocaust. Well, right now, the Israel Defense Forces are in Gaza City, Hamas's main power base, and they are making major strides. It looks as if Hamas, this vicious Iran-backed terror group, really a death cult, is on the ropes right now as the IDF continues to push the offensive. Hundreds of thousands of Palestinian civilians are fleeing to the south. We've had persistent constant calls by the Israel Defense Forces to the Palestinian people to flee, to evacuate that Gaza City area. Again, hundreds of thousands of Palestinians are fleeing to the south because in essence, the IDF has cut Gaza in two. There is now southern Gaza and northern Gaza. The bulk of the fighting is taking place in the northern half of the strip, in particular, in and around Gaza City. Hamas is using hospitals, civilians, patients, doctors, and nurses, as human shields, throughout Gaza, as their main command and control centers. There is one hospital in particular, Al-Shifa Hospital, located in Gaza City and Hamas's main command control center is literally beneath this hospital including Hamas leaders. Keep an eye on the northern front. Hezbollah, another Iran-backed terror proxy, is a force that is much more powerful and well-equipped than Hamas. So it's become an unsustainable situation to Israel's north. Hezbollah perched on Israel's northern border some 150,000 rockets and missiles pointed at Israel at every inch of the world's one and only Jewish state. In recent days, we had major flare ups along that Lebanon border. Just on Sunday we saw 21 Israeli civilians wounded and one killed in a Hezbollah rocket attack. We are going to the March for Israel in Washington, D.C. Guest speakers include Tovah Feldshuh, Actress, Natan Sharansky, Former Soviet Dissident, Mijal Bitton, Shalom Hartman Institute, Julie Platt, Chair of Board at Jewish Federations of North America, Isaac Herzog, President of Israel, Chuck Schumer (D-NY) Senate Majority Leader, Mike Johnson (R-LA) House Speaker, Debra Messing, Actress, Orna Neutra, Mother of Hostage Omer Neutra, Alana Zeitchik, Cousin of 6 Hostages, Michael Herzog, Israeli Ambassador to the U.S., Pastor John Hagee, Founder and Senior Pastor of Cornerstone Church. CBN Reporter Charlene Aaron Reports: Well-known Israeli-American activist Noa Tishby once served as her country's first envoy for combating antisemitism. While she no longer holds that official role, her advocacy for her homeland continues, especially after October 7. Tishby is no stranger to the fight against anti-Jewish hatred, something that has risen since Israel began fighting to end Hamas' stranglehold on Gaza. According to the Anti-Defamation League, following the October 7th massacre, a significant spike in antisemitic incidents has been reported across the U.S. Cases of harassment, vandalism, and assault have jumped by almost 400 percent. Tishby recently told the Friends of the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) that underlying messaging paved the way for the Hamas attack and the atmosphere that has followed. Pro-Palestinian protests have broken out worldwide on college campuses and in major cities around the country and internationally. Countless protestors have gone around ripping down posters of Jewish hostages still held captive by Hamas. In September, Tishby reached out through the renowned entertainment magazine Variety to write about the dangers of antisemitism masquerading as anti-Zionism - the movement for the self-determination and statehood of the Jewish people in their ancestral homeland. Tishby, who is also the author of the book Israel: A Simple Guide to the Most Misunderstood Country on Earth, condemns the phrase "From the River to the Sea' which has become a rallying cry at many pro-Palestinian demonstrations. She also pushes back against those trying to equate the October 7 attack with Israel's military campaign in Gaza while also condemning the Hamas act of hiding behind innocent Palestinians. Meanwhile, the vocal activist warns that this entire moment should be seen as a wake-up call to the U.S. and other countries.

CBN News Senior Correspondent Wendy Griffith Reports: Officials continue to struggle with an overwhelming surge at the U.S. southern border. In response, the border patrol is shutting down crossings, and Texas Gov. Greg Abbott (R) is taking matters into his own hands. Abbott faces growing pushback for his new law allowing police to arrest people they suspect are crossing illegally. On Monday alone, the Border Patrol encountered more than 12,000 people crossing into the U.S. from Mexico. Hundreds were seen huddling in Eagle Pass, Texas. Some were wrapped in blankets as the awaited processing. Meanwhile, Abbott is going on the offensive. He sent more than 100 migrants to Chicago by plane after the city council targeted his busing mission. The governor signed a new law, empowering local and state police to arrest migrants suspected of crossing into the state illegally as well as letting judges send some back to Mexico. The Biden administration doesn't like it. Rev. Samuel Rodriguez of the National Hispanic Christian Leadership Conference said the White House could and should stop the flow of migrants from Mexico immediately. El Paso County and the ACLJ are suing Texas, claiming the federal government has exclusive power over immigration. They also claim the new law will overburden jails and deny migrants the chance to request asylum. Meanwhile, federal officials temporarily closed several border entry points, including some railway crossings. One freight company said that's costing as much as \$200 million a day.

CBN Reporter Charlene Aaron Reports: After an urgent meeting with U.S. officials, Mexico has unveiled a new task force to stem the tide of migrants crossing the southern U.S. border. The country's leaders announced the step after meeting with Secretary of State Antony Blinkin and Homeland Security Alejandro Mayorkas in Mexico City on Wednesday. Mexico's government is agreeing to step up immigration enforcement within their country, help reopen key ports of entry, and encourage migrants to stay in Mexico. As part of the agreement, Mexico will regularly meet with officials from other countries in Central and Latin America. The action comes at a time of unprecedented surge of migrants crossing illegally in the U.S. According to U.S. Customs and Border Protection as many as 10,000 migrant arrests are made along the border each day. A caravan of some 6,000 migrants is currently heading to the U.S. U.S. cities are struggling to manage the growing problem as some border states are sending migrants to them by bus and plane. New York City Mayor Eric Adams (D) says his city can't handle the massive influx of migrants, and he's criticizing the governor of Texas while calling for the Biden administration to take action. Meanwhile, Mexico's president is calling for the U.S. to work more to strengthen its ties with Cuba and Venezuela, two of the top countries migrants are fleeing, while Mexico also promises to crack down on drug smugglers.

CBN News Senior Correspondent Dale Hurd Reports: Campus rallies celebrating the atrocities committed against Israel show just how deeply antisemitism has infected many of America's colleges and universities. After the horrific Hamas terrorist attack on Israel, students at the University of Wisconsin Madison chanted, "Glory to the martyrs." Cornell University Professor Russell Rickford called the Hamas killings "exhilarating." An instructor at Standford has been suspended for allegedly making Jewish students stand in a corner while publicly referring to them as "colonizers." Critics call it a direct result of the Boycott, Divestments, and Sanctions (BDS) movement against Israel. Many colleges and universities have allowed and even promoted pro-Hamas anti-Jewish rhetoric for decades. The attack on Israel has shown just where that policy has led. The anti-Israel BDS movement has been allowed to flourish on campuses nationwide and uses the chant "from the river to the sea" in protests, calling for the destruction of Israel. After the Oct. 7 Hamas attack on Israel, the BDS movement's website posted and later deleted that it supported the slaughter of Israelis by Hamas calling it "heroic" and "justified." The BDS movement, which has long claimed to have originated from the Palestinian people, was, according to BDS historian Gerald Steinberg, created by the Soviet Union, the British Labor Party, and Muslim nations who oppose Israel. Dexter Van Zile, managing editor at Focus on Western Islamism, said the Hamas terror attack finally exposed the BDS movement for what it is really about, the destruction of the state of Israel. A major campus group behind the BDS movement is Students for Justice in Palestine (SJP). After the Hamas attack, Boston University's SJP chapter posted that "victory is ours." Universities like Harvard have been embarrassed and have also lost donations because of pro-Hamas support. It's gotten so bad that Ezekiel Emanuel, longtime Democrat and brother of Rahm (current United States ambassador to Japan) wrote an op-ed published in Wednesday's New York Times titled "The Moral Deficiencies of a Liberal Education."

CBN Reporter Abigail Robertson Reports: As former President Jimmy Carter celebrated his 99th birthday celebration, thousands of volunteers traveled to Charlotte, North Carolina, this week to carry on one of his greatest legacies: Habitat for Humanity's Jimmy and Rosalynn Carter Work Project. Throughout the years, the project has worked in 14 countries to build, renovate, and repair thousands of homes. For 35 years, the Carters have donated one week of their time each year to building safe and affordable homes as part of the Carter Work Project. Since this is the first year, they haven't been on-site, Country music superstars Garth Brooks and Trisha Yearwood are taking the reins. They are in Charlotte this week leading more than 3,000 volunteers in building 27 new homes. The Country music power couple has volunteered with Habitat for Humanity alongside the Carters for more than a decade. This year Brooks and Yearwood get the honor of handing the new homeowners their keys and a Bible, a longstanding tradition at Habitat for Humanity. With faith at the organization's core, volunteers begin each day with a morning devotional and along the way write scriptures and encouraging messages on homes as they build them. While the organization has been building homes since 1976, CEO Jonathan Reckford credits the Carters for turning the once small operation into what it is today. In order to qualify for a Habitat for Humanity home, homeowners must volunteer for almost 300 hours plus take classes on financial management and home maintenance. As part of the home purchasing process, Habitat works with the buyer to ensure the mortgage allows the family to spend no more than 30% of their income on housing. He says part of the reason Charlotte was selected for this year's Carter Work Project is because it's one of many cities nationwide dealing with an affordable housing crisis. For future homeowners like Brianna Sandford, Habitat for Humanity is a dream come true. Sanford helped design her home that she'll soon share with her two kids. While many first-time homeowners will receive their keys this week, Habitat for Humanity volunteers will continue working at the Charlotte Plato Price site until 39 homes in the community are completed.

CBN News Senior Correspondent Dale Hurd Reports: For those Americans wondering if they're safe from the kind of attack Hamas carried out against Israel, the answer from terrorism experts is not encouraging. Under questioning by FBI agents. New Yorker Ali Kourani admitted in 2017 to being a member of something called "Unit 910." It's the Black Ops unit of Hezbollah, controlled by Iran. Kourani told agents he was trained to be a suicide bomber and was scouting targets in New York City. He's now in prison. Another Unit 910 member imprisoned this year, 42-year-old New Jersey resident Alexei, alias Alex Saab, had also scouted potential targets around New York City. While the exact number of Hamas and Hezbollah sleeper cells operating within the United States is not known, a comprehensive study by George Washington University last year found the most Hezbollah activity in Michigan, New York, North Carolina, and California. So far this year, authorities have caught 151 people on the FBI's Terrorism Watch list trying to illegally enter the U.S. through the southern border, 50 times higher than two years ago. Most are coming through Panama's Darien Gap, where journalist Michael Yon says he's seeing 3-to-5,000 migrants pass through every day on their way to the U.S. CBN News correspondent Chuck Holton has also reported from the Darien Gap and says he has no doubt dangerous persons are headed for the U.S. border. Former FBI Special Agent Eric Caron, now a security and counter-terrorism consultant to governments, is especially concerned about America's ports where Customs and Border Protection says it scans every incoming container for radiation but physically inspects only three percent. Former House Speaker Kevin McCarthy warned this week that what happened in Israel could happen here.

CBN White House Correspondent Abigail Robertson Reports: There is a heightened sense of threats against the United States, and a sense of urgency to address them. That was the message from experts testifying Tuesday on Capitol Hill regarding threats to the homeland. Both the heads of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) acknowledged that given worldwide uncertainty combined with the war between Israel and Hamas, it is a time to be concerned about terrorist threats to the homeland. They added no threats we face are getting any easier and the chance of an incident on U.S. soil has increased. FBI Director Christohper Wray admitted the gaps in U.S. intelligence are real. Wray also acknowledged threats to the Jewish community are at historic levels. DHS Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas fielded questions on his agency's attempts to keep track of known terrorists crossing the U.S. southern border. Mayorkas was also questioned on the impact of the millions of people who have illegally crossed into the U.S. under President Biden's watch. One of Wray's major concerns was the number of terrorist organizations explicitly calling for attacks in the U.S., which bumps the current threat risk to a whole new level.

He shares that sadly, many of America's most respected elite universities are indulging and endorsing sanctioned student organizations holding celebrations for the murders, which should raise concern, if not outrage. He shares the importance of bringing debate to these important issues. Dr. Phil talks about changing his focus and moving in a different direction, dealing with real people with real problems and seeking real solutions, but in a different place at a different time after the first of the year. He shares that at the time he wrote a book in 2004 called "Family First" the family was under attack. With the advent of the smart phone, today we are dealing with cyberbullying, online predators, scams, kids watching people live their lives instead of living their own lives, conspiracy theories, and different schools of thought now spread overnight on the internet and becomes prolific in society. We have these fringe groups that are tyrannically pushing ideas onto mainstream America. There has to be a rally of common sense in America. He also addresses immigration. He believes we need to return to some fundamental values that are key in supporting families in America and the values that have made this country such a great success over 250 years. Robin shares how she and Phil met and why they have a successful marriage. They also announce a Dr. Phil News Special "School Shooters: How to Stop the Madness" is coming soon to TBN. It's a reckoning about what we know about who does the shooting. We can identify it before it happens and institute programs nationwide to curtail this by using an anonymous reporting system where they can anonymously report someone, not to get them in trouble, but to get them help. Every one of these school shootings are violent suicides, none of them intend to get out alive, and this would be an act of compassion.

CBN Reporter Gary Lane Reports: During the pandemic, Americans experienced food shortages due to the impact on the world's vulnerable supply chain. While that situation has somewhat recovered, another global event could make that recent experience the new normal. Two experts warn a brewing battle between the United States and China over control of the world's food supply could become such an event. This new war is happening right now without armies or any shots being fired. It's a global struggle with deadly consequences. Who will dominate the world food supply? Kip Tom, former U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations for Food and Agriculture explained that China is determined to seize control of the African continent. Gatestone Institute's China analyst Gordon Chana agrees and believes China has a food problem. That's why this year, ports in Shanghai are reportedly on target to receive a quarter of a million tons of food from Africa, valued at more than half a billion dollars. The African Union wants to expand trade with Beijing and gain Chinese innovation to help expand long-term food production. Current agricultural technology has helped South Africa and Nigeria become the continent's largest food producers. Ambassador Tom suggested that led to an August visit by Chinese diplomats with Nigerian officials, followed by President Xi Jinping's trip to South Africa for the BRICS Conference. Chang warns people should be concerned about China's actions in Africa. A future conflict over Taiwan, or tariffs and trade battles, could place the U.S. food supply at risk. Threatened regimes often use food as a weapon against their opponents. During the 1990s, the people of South Sudan refused to embrace Islam, and the Khartoum government retaliated by denying them food, causing many to die from starvation. Chang warns Americans that they should have learned from the COVID-19 pandemic about food scarcity. At the same time U.S. consumers couldn't get meat at grocery stores, the world's top pork producer, Chinese-owned Smithfield Foods, shipped pork to China. Although Smithfield is not a stateowned company, Chang believes it operated at the behest of the Chinese Communist Party. China is also taking steps to lessen its reliance on U.S.-grown food. It has turned to Brazil, making it the top exporter of agricultural products to China, providing 20% of the country's food supply. So, what can be done in the short term to strengthen the food security of the United States? Ambassador Tom insists the country needs to increase domestic food production and manufacture critical agricultural products like fertilizers and others rather than getting them from adversaries like Russia, Belarus, and China. Chang contends China is motivated by the doctrine of Tianxia – the belief that the CCP has the right to rule all under heaven and is obligated to do so.

At the United Jewish Federation of Tidewater (UJFT) in Virginia Beach, Virginia, the public was invited to grieve and begin the healing process at a rally represented by officials of all levels of government. In attendance, Attorney General Jason Miyares said his Christian faith is what drives him to stand with Israel, inviting America to do the same. Miyares is an outspoken ally of the Jewish people. In February, he helped create the state's antisemitism task force, aware it's more important than ever to protect American Jews from violence and hate. Israeli native Nofar Trem came to America five years ago. Her family remains in Israel and survived the attack. She manages Israeli education and engagement with the Jewish Federation of Tidewater. Betty Ann Levin, CEO of the UJFT, condemns the assault in the strongest possible terms. Her organization is desperate to restore peace to the region and its people. Support is growing nationwide with 18 rallies held in major cities, including New York, Boston, and Las Vegas – in conjunction with the Israeli-American Council. The Anti-Defamation League has scheduled another seven rallies through the weekend, serving the District of Columbia, Maryland, North Carolina, and Virginia. And while the trauma will linger, the hope remains that hearts will begin to heal.

CBN National Security Correspondent Caitlin Burke Reports: A leader of Hamas is calling for a Global Day of Jihad, Friday, causing Jewish communities worldwide to brace for potential attacks far beyond Israel's borders. Here in the U.S. antisemitism has been a major concern long before the terrorist organization unleashed unspeakable atrocities upon Israel. Spurred on by the current conflict in the Middle East, a wave of anti-Israel protests is already spreading more hate against the Jewish community. This type of rhetoric can lead to violence, and sadly Devorah Halberstam, an activist against antisemitism knows that all too well. Her oldest son, Ari, was murdered back in 1994, simply for being Jewish. She calls the hate that fuels antisemitism a threat to all of civilization, not just the Jewish community. While state and local leaders see no current credible threats against their Jewish communities, they aren't taking any chances. In New York City, home to the world's largest Jewish population outside of Israel, the NYPD is under orders to make sure its Jewish community has the resources it needs to feel protected. Gov. Kathy Hochu reiterating that antisemitism will not be tolerated. Virginia Attorney General Jason Miyares tells CBN News state police have ramped up patrols of synagogues, Jewish day schools, and Jewish community centers. Meanwhile in Washington state, members of the Jewish community say their leaders have failed to follow through on promises of increased security. Seattle talk show host Jason Rantz, author of the book, "What's Killing America," says liberal policies in his state have created an environment that feeds antisemitism. He blames the lack of condemnation of the Hamas attacks for causing greater anxiety among the Jewish community rather than providing a sense of security. According to the Anti-Defamation League, a rise in antisemitic activity usually follows periods of increased hostilities between Israel and terrorist groups. The ADL is urging the Jewish community worldwide to remain vigilant.

CBN News Senior Correspondent Gary Lane Reports: A recent congressional hearing about antisemitism brought to the forefront the issue of foreign funding for U.S. universities. Billions in foreign cash are funding anti-Israel instruction and protests on college campuses. CBN News followed some of the money to reveal how various Islamist and left-wing sources are influencing young minds against the Jewish state. We discovered that U.S. colleges and universities are swimming in pro-Hamas, anti-Israel cash. Dr. Rachel Ehrenfeld is the founder and president of the American Center for Democracy and the Economic Warfare Institute. She contends Saudi Arabia and Qatar are buying influence by sending billions of dollars to American colleges and universities for research projects and Middle East studies programs. She believes this funding radicalizes young student minds through classroom instruction. Charles Asher Small of the Institute for the Study of Global Antisemitism and Policy (ISGAP) explains that 75 percent of Middle Eastern donations come through the Qatar Foundation. The Qatar Royal Family and foundation are closely allied with the Muslim Brotherhood, the movement that birthed Hamas. In a seven-year study of foreign funding to American universities, Small's group found that, in recent years, nearly \$5 billion flowed from Oatar to American Institutions of higher learning. They include major universities like Texas A&M. Georgetown, Cornell, Carnegie Mellon, Northwestern, and Virginia Commonwealth. He believes the money specifically going to Texas A&M poses a national security threat to the United States. There's also the growth of antisemitism on campus coming from pro-Palestinian groups like Students for Justice in Palestine. According to the Anti-Defamation League (ADL), the SJP is a leading organizer of the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement. The group reportedly works closely with the Jewish Voice for Peace (JVP), which, according to the Washington Free Beacon, has received \$650,000 since 2017 from the George Soros Open Society Foundations. Also, Soros has reportedly given California's Tides Foundation, a group advocating social change and immigrant children's rights, at least \$3.5 million to support student protests similar to a recent demonstration at San Francisco's Balboa High School. So, what can people do to change the prevailing anti-Israel, antisemitic attitudes on U.S. college campuses?

CBN National Security Correspondent Caitlin Burke Reports: The U.S. military is experiencing one of the worst recruiting shortfalls in 50 years. In fiscal year 2023, the military branches collectively missed their recruiting goals by approximately 41,000 recruits. Earlier this week, representatives from each, testified before the House Armed Services Committee about the underlying causes behind the shortfall. While witnesses outlined challenges ranging from getting recruiters into schools during COVID, to decrease in eligibility, Republicans zeroed in on polling that suggests the problem is because the military has become, "the administration's next social justice project." Only two military branches met their active duty, enlisted, and recruiting goals for 2023 – the Marine Corps and the Space Force. Alex Wagner, Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Manpower and Reserve Affairs, credits the success to an Air Force pilot program which waives previous requirements on body composition, tattoo placement, and THC use. All branches admit it's critical to find ways to persuade Gen-Z to take an interest in military service. That's because as one of the most tech-savvy generations, their skill sets will likely be key to future military readiness.

CBN Reporter Charlene Aaron Reports: For more than a year, the Federal Reserve has raised interest rates to lower inflation. Prices are still high, however, especially when it comes to necessities like gas and groceries. With a growing number of Americans living paycheck to paycheck, many are struggling to make ends meet. Earling this year when food prices reached 4.7% higher than the year before, some took to social media to air their frustration. Amber Bergeron of Dutchtown, LA is a stay-at-home mother of four. Her husband works as a tankerman in the oil field. She recently shared how tough it is trying to keep up with rising monthly expenses. Amber is not alone. The standard of living for Americans has dropped in the last two to three years. And according to a recent CNBC survey, 52 percent of adults said they have felt more financially stressed since before the pandemic in 2020. Reasons for the economic stress include sticker shock for everyday goods and services. For example, according to Edmunds, new car costs have skyrocketed around 32 percent higher over the last five years. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, auto insurance is also more expensive. In July, those figures jumped 16 percent more than the same time last year and have grown a whopping 70 percent in the last decade. And the list keeps growing. Car maintenance is up 13 percent since 2022, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. And median homes prices are up 31 percent since 2020. And because of these soaring prices Quicken found that 61 percent of Americans, even those bringing in \$150,000 a year, live paycheck to paycheck. Mark Hamrick, Senior Economic Analyst for Bankrate, points to record inflation as the driving force. During the pandemic, inflation hit a 40-year high of 9.1 percent. It is currently rising by 3.7 percent. So, that means prices are still much higher than they used to be, and they're still rising, but not as fast. Hamrick also said the major issue is that prices are going up faster than incomes. That means the essentials like housing, gas, and groceries cost more although people have less money to pay for them. Dan Darling, Director of the Land Center for Cultural Engagement suggested that lawmakers fight inflation as a family value. Local food banks are also feeling the impact. Chris Tan, of the Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and The Eastern Shore, also highlighted demand is higher today than when COVID-19 sent the economy reeling. He explained local food bank partners are feeling the pain. To cope, a growing number of Americans are turning to credit. Quicken also reports that 46 percent of consumers making more than \$100,000 a year are more dependent on their credit cards than ever before. And about a third say they can't afford to pay off their balances by the end of the year. Financial Planner Robin Tull, of Tull Financial Group in Chesapeake, VA suggests ways to manage and save. Meanwhile, as inflation seems to be cooling, many say government policies remain out of touch with reality and the pain families are facing.

CBN News Medical Reporter Lorie Johnson Reports: News of atrocities committed against Israelis this past weekend have saturated television, the internet, and social media. Psychiatrists say children and families who see these pictures and hear the stories can become traumatized. That's why mental health experts recommend parents try to limit their family's exposure to news programs and the web during events like we're experiencing this week. Taking that action can protect them from graphic images and other damaging information, according to psychiatrist Daniel Amen. Dr. Amen said parents can help frightened children by simply spending more time with them. Dr. Amen said since children usually don't have the perspective on news events that parents possess, they may think what they see and hear about might happen to them. Therefore, it can be helpful for parents to tell children the incidents are isolated and are taking place far away. Psychiatrist Stephen Grcevich told CBN News parents might want to keep their own emotions in check. Dr. Grcevich said children often learn from watching their parents how to behave in times of trouble. Instead of fostering fear in their children, parents can instead help their kids respond to trials in a proactive, positive manner. Now more than ever, parents should pray for their children, Sharon Jaynes, author of "Praying for Your Child from Head to Toe" told CBN News. Jaynes recommends praying the Word of God. Jaynes said no one will be a perfect parent, but we can be praying parents who confidently pray for God's protection and provision in the physical and spiritual realms.
