Section I. Issues

The above stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **Labor Rights:** 2022 has been a year of strikes and unionizations. Had the recent railway industry strike not been averted, it would have had a profound impact on the Tri-Cities workforce and economy. The major railway companies employ hundreds of workers in Benton and Franklin counties. The stations covered the issues that are driving workers to revolt.
- B. **Clean Technology:** With thousands of tons of nuclear waste at the Hanford Facility, the Tri-Cities is known as one of the most toxic areas in the nation. The government and contractors continue to go to introduce new climate friendly technology to change our area's image. Also, more and more local residents are becoming more focused on clean energy by investing in solar and electric vehicles. The stations presented information and tips on how to purchase EVs and more affordable options coming in the future.
- C. **Mental Health:** The City of Pasco was recently named one of the fastest growing cities in the nation. As more people move to the area it has become more and more difficult to navigate in traffic, schedule recreation, and make appointments. The stations presented proven tips on how to get organized and navigate the new busy environment in the area.
- D. **Education:** The Biden administration's proposal to cancel student debt has brought the cost of higher education to the forefront once more. Many students in the Tri-Cities area are choosing local community colleges over high-priced state and private schools. The stations presented solutions on how to solve the problem of student debt in the future and the consequences if things don't change.
- E. **Health:** The winter months in the Tri-Cities are cold and dark which impacts exercise and eating habits of many area residents. Too many holiday sweets and less activity is a recipe for weight gain. The stations presented easy holiday dessert ideas and substitutes with low calories and less sugar.
