> Re: WXXA-TV, Albany, New York (11970) Response to 2011 Audit Inquiry Letter

Dear Mr. Pulley:

Newport Television License LLC, licensee of television station WXXA-TV, Albany, New York ("WXXA" or the "Station"), hereby responds to your letter dated as of March 29, 2011, indicating that the Station was randomly selected for an EEO audit. The licensee is a subsidiary of group owner Newport Television LLC ("Newport").

The responses, which are provided in the order of the requests in Section 3 of your letter, were prepared under the supervision of General Manager and EEO Officer Bill Sally, with the assistance of the Station's EEO Coordinator Paul Pelliccia and Newport's Northeast Regional Hub Human Resources Manager Anne Johnson. Newport provides human resources and certain other administrative services to the employment unit through its regional hub and Kansas City corporate headquarters.

Copies of the Unit's two most recent EEO public file reports, described in Section 73.2080(c)(6). For any stations in the Unit that have websites, provide each web address. If the Unit's most recent EEO public file report is not included on or linked to on each of these websites, indicate each station involved and provide an explanation of why the report is not so posted or linked, as required by Section 73.2080(c)(6). In accordance with Section 73.2080(c)(5)(vi), provide the date of each full-time hire listed in each report provided.

The license renewal application filing anniversary date for WXXA is February 1. Exhibit A, therefore, attaches the EEO Public File Reports for the periods February 1, 2009 to January 31, 2010 and February 1, 2010 to January 31, 2011. The cover sheets supplied in Exhibit B identify the dates of each full-time hire covered by the reports. The

During the two-year reporting period covered by the two most recent EEO Public File Reports, the Station hired 16 full-time employees. Exhibit B includes a cover sheet for each of those openings which identifies the position, the number of interviewees for each opening and referral source for each interviewee and hiree, followed by copies of mailing labels, advertisements, bulletins, letters, faxes, e-mails and other communications or records reflecting announcement of the open position. The organizations that had requested job opening notifications are denoted in Section II of each EEO Public File Report.

3(c) In accordance with Section 73.2080(c)(5)(v), the total number of interviewees for each vacancy and the referral source for each interviewee for all full-time Unit vacancies filled during the period covered by the above-noted EEO public file reports.

Exhibit B includes documentation for each full-time position filled during the two-year reporting period indicating the number of interviewees and referral source for each interviewee for that position.

Occumentation of Unit recruitment initiatives described in Section 73.2080(c)(2) during the periods covered by the above-noted EEO public file reports, such as participation at job fairs, mentoring programs, and training for staff. Exhibit C includes a cover sheet noting the supplemental outreach initiatives undertaken by WXXA between February 1, 2009 and January 31, 2011, followed by

documentation which reflects the date, personnel involved, and performance of each initiative.

The Station presently has 72 full-time employees. WXXA is not located in a "smaller market," as defined in Section 73.2080 of the FCC's rules, and, thus, the Station is required to perform four supplemental initiatives over the course of the two-year period covered by these reports.

Disclose any pending or resolved complaints involving the Station filed during the Station's current license term before any body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the Unit on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex. For each such complaint, provide: (1) a brief description of the allegations and issues involved; (2) the names of the complainant and other persons involved; (3) the date the complaint was filed; (4) the court or agency before which it is pending or by which it was resolved; (5) the file or case number; and (6) the disposition and date thereof or current status. Newport acquired WXXA effective March 14, 2008. The Station has not received or resolved any employment discrimination complaints since Newport's acquisition of the Station.

3(f) In accordance with Section 73.2080(b), from the first day of the Station's current license term (or the date the licensee became the owner, if after that date) until the date of this letter, describe the responsibilities of each level of Unit management responsible for implementing EEO policies and describe how the Unit has informed employees and job applicants of its EEO policies and program.

General Manager Bill Sally, who oversees the implementation of the EEO efforts and policies of the employment unit, is responsible for ensuring that the unit provides equal employment opportunity in all employment decisions. EEO Coordinator Paul Pelliccia and News Director Gary LaPlante, play an active role in ensuring that the unit effectively implements its recruitment and related programs as an equal opportunity employer. Employees in Department Head and Supervisor level positions are responsible for understanding, communicating, observing and implementing the employment unit's EEO policy in all employment related matters so as to prevent discrimination and to provide equal employment opportunities to employees as well as applicants under consideration for positions at the employment unit.

Once the General Manager authorizes recruitment for a job opening, News Director Gary LaPlante is responsible for initiating a job vacancy form used to collect key information for the job opening under the FCC's EEO requirements and transmitting notification of the vacancy to a wide array of recruitment sources designed to reach all segments of the community, including women and minorities. The EEO Coordinator supervises the recordkeeping for all job postings and collects as well as maintains records pertaining to all interviewees and their referral sources. If any of the relevant Station management has a question about compliance with applicable EEO policies and procedures, the manager may contact Regional Hub HR Manager Anne Johnson at any point during the process. A Human Resources Manager at corporate headquarters also is available to answer any questions and to further review paperwork to ensure the Station adheres to EEO policies.

The Station provides notice to applicants of its basic EEO policy commitment on employment applications, on website postings and other publications of job notices. After employment begins, each employee is required to review Newport's Employee Handbook, which includes key company policies, including those on equal employment opportunity and sexual harassment. Each new hire signs a certification that the employee has read, understands and accepted the policies. The Station conspicuously posts on Station bulletin boards notice to employees of key employment rights, including instructions about how to submit a discrimination or sexual harassment claim. The Station receives assistance, as needed, from outside counsel and periodically participates in training such as the September 2010 Webinar entitled, "What Every Employee Needs to Know - Respect in the Workplace" reflected in Exhibit C. Documentation is maintained to ensure that each participating employee understands and accepts nondiscrimination in employment policies.

In accordance with Section 73.2080(c)(3), from the first day of the Station's current license term (or the date the licensee became the owner, if after that date) until the date of this letter, describe the Unit's efforts to analyze its EEO recruitment program to ensure that it is effective and to address any problems found as a result of such analysis.

The General Manager and EEO Coordinator assess the employment unit's recruitment efforts on an on-going and quarterly basis. The quarterly review covers, for example, recruitment activities, referral sources used, recordkeeping activities and supplemental outreach initiatives. Based on this assessment, the EEO Coordinator prepares a quarterly report on the Station's EEO efforts, which is submitted to Regional Hub HR Manager Anne Johnson and to the Controller of the Regional Hub in Syracuse. The quarterly reviews provide a regular opportunity to determine if there are areas in the recruitment and outreach process that may be made more effective. In addition, the unit's recruitment and EEO efforts are continually assessed throughout the year, as appropriate.

In accordance with Section 73.2080(c)(4), from the first day of the Station's current license term (or the date the licensee became the owner, if after that date) until the date of this letter, describe the Unit's efforts to analyze periodically its measures taken to examine pay, benefits, seniority practices, promotions, and selection techniques and tests to ensure that they provide equal opportunity and do not have a discriminatory effect. If the Unit has one or more union agreements, describe how the Unit cooperates with each union to ensure EEO policies are followed for the Unit's union-member employees and job applicants.

The employment unit strives to comply with all federal, state and/or local laws regarding pay, benefits, promotions and selection techniques to ensure that the unit provides equal opportunity and does not discriminate against employees or applicants. The employment unit, with guidance and assistance from the Regional Hub, Newport headquarters and outside counsel, are responsible for ensuring equal employment opportunity in all employment related decisions.

The General Manager and Department Heads of the employment unit, in conjunction with Regional Hub management and corporate Regional Vice President of Operations Michael DiPasquale, review compensation on a yearly basis in connection with the budget process. In addition, compensation levels are reviewed with regard to industry standards and trends and market and economic conditions. Also, the General Manager, in conjunction with the pertinent Department Head and Regional management, review promotion and salary decisions at the time of new hires and promotions. Moreover, Newport, through its corporate headquarters Human Resources Manager Phil Jones, handles pension and heath plans on a company-wide basis.

The Station does not have an agreement with any labor union.
