3-18-20 – Authorities stress that there is not a national food storage, but citizens should stock up on food essentials to last about a week and should not over stock items – An anonymous customer at a Houston restaurant (Irma’s Southwest) left staff a \$9,400 tip just hours after the county announced mandatory business closings

3-19-20 – Drive through Coronavirus test begin today for those who display symptoms, thanks to relief package signed by President Trump. The drive throughs will be open from 10AM – 8PM

3-20-20 – 79 confirmed cases of Coronavirus are being reported in the Houston area, there are now 5 different 5 tests available to determine if you have contracted Coronavirus

3-23-20 – Governor Abbott takes measures to help free hospital bed space in preparation for influx of patients, all non-medically necessary surgeries have been postponed, now more than one patient can be treated per room – Rand Paul is the first senator to test positive for Covid-19

3-24-20 – Harris County Judge Linda Hidalgo issues “Stay-at-home” order for Harris County through April 3rd over Coronavirus concerns

3-25-20 – White House and Senate reach historic \$2 trillion stimulus deal amid growing coronavirus fears – Billionaire Tillman Fertitta furloughs 40,000 workers at casino/restaurant empire

3-26-20 – Brazoria County follows Harris County in issuing “Stay-at-home” order through April 3rd over Coronavirus concerns

3-27-20 – Governor Abbott issues a 14-day quarantine for any travelers from America’s hotspots into Texas which include New York, New Orleans, and Connecticut – America leads the world in confirmed Coronavirus cases with over 86,000 throughout the country

3-30-20 – President Trump extends social distancing protocols until April 30th, projections show that between 100,000 to 200,000 Americans will die due to the Coronavirus during the pandemic

3-31-20 – Harris County Judge Linda Hidalgo says “Stay-at-home” order will be extended past April 3rd, but how long has not been decided yet with an announcement expected for later today
