October 1- December 31, 2022**

October:

10-3-22 – Rescue and evacuation efforts continue in Florida where at least 80 have died after Hurricane Ian. Crews spent the weekend on Florida's devastated Pine Island evacuating residents after Ian damaged the only bridge to the island.

About 750 thousand remain without power and it could take days to restore. Center Point energy sent crews over to Florida to help.

10-6-22 – US Special Forces killed an ISIS leader and took several others captive in a midnight raid in Syria. The operation lasted several hours and there was no exchange of gunfire with US Troops.

A Texas death row inmate who challenged state prison rules preventing his pastor from touching him and praying aloud during his execution has been put to death. 38-year-old John Ramirez was executed by lethal injection in Huntsville last night with his pastor present.

Lipton Tea announced they're getting into the booze business. The brand will launch its Lipton Hard Iced Tea will be out before next summer.

10-7-22 – President Biden pardoned every Americans convicted of federal marijuana possession. White House officials also say no one can be prosecuted for the crime at the federal level going forward.

An illegal gaming room was shut down on Spencer HWY in SE Houston. Deputies got several complaints from residents in the area about the operation on Spencer Highway ... and after getting a warrant found over 200 gambling machines inside.

10-10-22 – More lane closures at Bush airport starting today for a utility project. The lanes closures will impact traffic heading to Terminals C, D, and E for the next four weeks.

Four daycare workers in Mississippi were fired after trying to scare a bunch of little kids into submission by wearing a Halloween "Scream" .. In the video, the kids can be seen crying and hiding from the woman as she chases them.

10-11-22 – 3 Fishermen fought off SHARKS with their bare hands in the Gulf of Mexico for over 24 hours after their boat sank off the Louisiana coast. They were actively being attacked when the Coast Guard showed up to save them. Two guys suffered bites on their hands, but all survived.

A man is suing the makers of Texas Pete hot sauce because it's not made in Texas. California resident Phillip White filed suit after discovering the ingredients are "sourced and made at a factory in North Carolina." In addition to damages, he wants them to change the products name.

10-12-22 – NASA's Armageddon style test was a success. The spacecraft they blasted into an asteroid did shorten the orbit by 32 minutes - the goal was just 10. The goal was to see if NASA could move an asteroid heading to Earth to avoid catastrophic impact.

The Statue of Liberty crown has reopened for visitors. The National Park Service closed the top of the landmark at the beginning of the pandemic, but they've now opened it back to visitors.

10-18-22 – Suburbs in N and W Houston including The Woodlands, Spring, and Katy ... are sinking about half an inch per year. A new geology study from the University of Houston found it's mostly due to heavy ground water usage and fault lines.

November:

11-9-22 – Greg Abbott won his 3rd term as Texas Governor. And Ken Paxton was reelected as Texas Attorney General. Meanwhile a dead guy won in Pennsylvania. Tony DeLuca was the longest-running Pennsylvania state representative, at 39 years but he died earlier this year from cancer at 85 ... his name was still on the ballot and he won.

11-10-22 – Hurricane Nicole ... a rare November hurricane, hit Florida as a Cat 1 storm overnight. It's now a tropical storm and is expected to head into Georgia and then Carolinas by Friday.

A robbery suspect was found hiding in closet at a daycare yesterday. Three suspects were under surveillance by HPD for following elderly women home and mugging them ... a crime known as jugging ... one of the men ran into the crowded daycare in hopes to elude police but he was arrested along with the others.

11-14-22 – NASA's planned Artemis launch today has been delayed again due to hurricane Nicole. The rocket was on the launch pad last week when the storm hit and needed some minor repairs. The launch, which will pave the way for a manned flight and future moon landings, is now set for this Wed.

11-15-22 – Global population hit 8 BILLION today. The US makes up 334.8 MILLION of the total. Projections estimate we'll hit 9 BILLION about 2037.

11-16-22 – After months of delays Artemis finally launched early this morning. NASA's \$4 billion rocket will orbit the moon during for 25-days ... if successful, NASA plans to send a manned crew on Artemis II for a trip to the moon as early as 2024.

11-17-22 – If your flying for the holiday be sure to ARRIVE EARLY. Officials at both Bush and Hobby recommend passengers arrive up to 3 hours ahead of flight times and you may need even more time at Bush due to ongoing construction. Also, while masks are encouraged at both airports, but no longer mandatory. H-E-B recalled 94 K pounds of ground beef products from Tyson Foods due to possible contaminated with a mirror-like material. The recall is for select 5 and 10lb chubs of Hill Country Fare and H-E-B ground beef products.

11-18-22 – Target says it's lost about \$600M this year due to criminal networks. The retailer blames organized shoplifting rings and says the issue started as an isolated localized problem but has been spreading across the country.

11-28-22 – The entire city of Houston plus parts of Fort Bend and Bellaire are under a boil water notice after power was lost to three treatment plants yesterday morning. Water has been restored to all customers. If you're experiencing low pressure report it to 311. City officials the earliest the boil water notice will be lifted is Tuesday morning.

HISD and several other school districts have canceled classes due to the water issue. All schools, offices, and facilities will be closed for the day.

Mahna Low-a, the World's largest active volcano, erupted this morning for the first time in nearly 40 years on Hawaii's Big Island ... it's triggered over a DOZEN earthquakes. Geologists don't think there's a risk of magma falling but there could be heavy ash fall in the area.

11-29-22 – The boil water notice has been lifted for the city.

People in the affected area should run all cold-water faucets for at least one minute. Clean automatic ice makers by making and discarding three batches of ice. Run water softeners through a regeneration cycle.

Many schools are still closed for the day as districts announced the closures before the water crisis was resolved.

Over 200 people had to be rescued from a large 'ice chunk' that broke free on Upper Red Lake in Minnesota while they were fishing yesterday. It drifted about 30 yards out into open water before the Sheriff's Office and EMT's got on scene. They got everyone off safely.

11-30-22 – Shoppers spent a record breaking \$11.3 billion Cyber Monday, making it the biggest online shopping day in history. This follows a record-breaking Black Friday for online sales at just over 9 billion.

5 French bulldog puppies were stolen during a home invasion in Jersey Village while young kids were home. Two people were seen on surveillance kicking in the front door of their apartment before swiping only the 5-week-old puppies. A 12-year-old boy and his younger brother hid in a closet and called 9-1-1.

December:

12-1-22 – A North American Bat species was just added to the endangered list. The Northern Long-Eared Bat population has been rapidly declining because of a deadly fungal disease, called white-nose syndrome only discovered in 2006. It's only found in bats.

12-2-22 – Authorities are warning Aldine residents to be vigilant after a pack of stray dogs killed some students FFA animals. Police said a lamb and several turkeys were attacked by the stray dogs near Stephens Elementary. They're searching for the dogs.

Don't tape your mouth shut before bed. Doctors are warning the latest bogus TikTok health hack can cause people to suffocate. The social media users are claiming you can improve your sleep and even lose weight by taping your mouth shut before bed, but Dr's say don't do it.

12-5-22 – Lava is flowing within about 2 miles of a major highway on Hawaii's big island ... Molten rock from Mauna Lowa the world's largest active volcano would make the road impassable but geologists say lava is very unpredictable might miss the Highway entirely. It's flowing at about 2.5 mph

A Los Cuco's Mexican restaurant that's been in Wharton since 1992 was destroyed by fire yesterday morning. Crews from 4 area fire departments battled the blaze for over 5 hours but by the time it was out the restaurant was a total loss.

12-6-22 – 2 Time Emmy award winning actress Kirstie Alley died yesterday after a brief battle with cancer. Alley was best known for her role as Rebecca Howe on "Cheers" She was 71 years old.

Music can be as effective as therapy for treating mental health issues. Scientists created a new APP that selects music based on your mood ... and found it can help relax people who are stressed, be uplifting for those feeling down and even act as a pain killer by distracting listeners who are in pain.

12-9-22 – Congress passed a bill dubbed the Tiger King bill that bans the private ownership of big cats in the US. It was backed by Carole Baskin who became famous after the Netflix docuseries Tiger King in 2020. It will head to President Biden to sign it into law.

The Navy is prepping for Orion's return. They've been practicing drills with a mock capsule near San Diego ahead of the final leg of the Artemis I Mission. The exact location of the splashdown has not yet been determined.

A Texas surfer was bitten by a shark in the Gulf of Mexico. It happened off the coast near Padre Island while an anonymous man was waiting for a wave and the shark came up from behind and bit one of his feet. Texas Parks and Wildlife said there are about 40 species of sharks living in the Gulf!

12-12-22 – Tonight's Mega Millions jackpot is up to \$400 million after no one matched all 6 numbers for the top prize Friday night.

NASA's historic Artemis I mission around the moon ended Sunday as the Orion capsule splashed down in the Pacific Ocean and was successfully retrieved by the Navy. NASA says the mission was a success.
