Our contact with leaders in the Tucson Community, as well as, our audience KDRI has determined that issues of importance to the community are Inflation and the economy, streets and roads, government issues and information, crime, social services, health and safety, education and border security.

Programming that addressed these above issues from January 1 through March 31, 2023 include:

Open and Not Open is a continuation of original Pandemic era news segment title that runs twice daily Mon-Fri with a 3:00 average. These news segments inform our listeners about what is occurring in the area with a broad spectrum of news and information about the communities, local meetings, events and actions of interest. The topic range is wide and varied to include many businesses, charitable and governmental agencies and events about which people need to know.

“Open or Not Open” (O/NO) segments are at approximately 6:30a, 7:30a, 8:30a and/or 9:30a and were broadcast sixty-five (65) times during the quarter with 25 shows addressing issues of greater local importance.
