A Colorado Springs woman says a local car dealership sold her a truck with a rolled back odometer. The mileage discrepancy was documented in the vehicle's Carfax history report , but it was not disclosed on the "Bill of Sale" documents every dealership in the country is required to provide.

The law requires car dealerships (new and used) to disclose the actual mileage of a vehicle and inform the buyer if an odometer has been tampered with or destroyed, but there's a legal "loophole".
