Hero Licenseco LLC ("Hero"), licensee of television station KMOH-TV (Facility ID No. 24753), Kingman, Arizona (the "Station"), hereby responds to the FCC's February 26, 2012 EEO Audit letter. Hero currently has only one employee at the Station's employment unit who is regularly assigned to work 30 hours per week or more. As a result, the Station is not required by the FCC's rules to have an EEO recruitment program. The sole full-time employee at the Station's employment unit is an Operations Manager and Chief Operator, who is regularly assigned to work 40 hours per week.

Hero has received no pending or resolved complaints during the Station's current license term before any body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the employment unit on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex. The Station is not subject to a time brokerage agreement
