Dear Alecia,

Thank you again for partnering with us during our experimental one-day Intermission Fundraiser on June 25th. Our goal was to cut 8 days of fundraising *and* raise funds for ArtsWave's Arts Vibrancy Recovery Fund during our 11-hour fundraiser on June 25th.

I'm happy to report we raised a total of \$18,819! Most of our donors gave one-time or additional gifts by credit card, and I've enclosed a check for \$7,597 which represents half of the proceeds we have already collected. There are 7 unpaid pledges totaling \$3,625, so we will send you a second check next month representing half of whatever we collect from these pledges. If all goes to plan, the final total to ArtsWave will be \$9,409.

We received some of the comments from listeners:

- "I listen to WGUC every day, and the Cincinnati arts community is a large part of what makes this a great place to live."
- "I'm new to the Cincinnati area. WGUC has helped to orient me to the arts in this area and had kept me company while working from home these past three months."
- "Supporting classical music & the arts. WGUC is a jewel in the Queen City's crown."
- "(Giving for the) oasis that 'GUC provided during the shutdown, and the great work ArtsWave does throughout the city."
- "WGUC has made such a difference and I have been very worried about the artists and performers in town who have not been able to get together and practice or perform. So, I called with an additional gift."

Thank you for the wonderful work you do every year, but especially now as so many of our arts organizations face a season without an audience. We're happy to offer our support and look forward to finding more ways to work together for the arts in the months to come.
