Notice is hereby given that on December 12, 2013, an application was filed with the Federal Communications Commission seeking consent to the assignment of a construction permit for FM translator station K262CH, Pocatello, Idaho, from Bonneville Holding Company to Riverbend Communications, LLC. The translator will operate on Channel 262 with a maximum effective radiated power of 0.075 kW from a transmitter site located at 42° 57' 47" North Latitude; 112° 29' 59" West Longitude.
