# Issue: Abortion and Plan B Coverage

The new abortion law in Texas is not sitting well with one of America's most popular newspapers. USA Today's editorial board printed their objection to the new law this month. They entitled the article: "Late-term abortion bans make aborting Down-Syndrome babies harder." The bill bans abortions after 20 weeks and most often pregnant women don't find out until after 20 weeks if their baby has Down Syndrome.

North Carolina has now passed new restrictions on its abortion clinics. Along with legislation, public attitudes appear to be shifting and pro-life politicians are seizing the moment. A gathering of pastors in Iowa saw Sen. Ted Cruz firing up the audience on his take on the Lone Star showdown. Libertarian Rand Paul was also quick to weigh in. The Texas bill bans abortions after 20-weeks and ups the requirements of abortion clinics. Four clinics say will close. So far this year, lawmakers have passed over 50 laws restricting abortion; in 2011, 92 laws were passed. This year the laws passed are more powerful, like in North Dakota and Kansas they banned abortion on the basis of gender. A Washington Post/ABC News poll shows that 56% of the public supports a 20-week ban.

Hawkins says that the legislation being introduced is meant to protect women and babies from the likes of Kermit Gosnell and says that veterinarian clinics have more restrictions/regulations and are more cleanly and safely run than abortion clinics. The young people view this whole issue as a human rights issue and better technology shows that it is not just a clump of cells, but a baby growing inside the womb.

Just as North Carolina follows Texas with the toughest abortion regulations, a video detailing the horrific act on one abortionist is released. The pro-life advocate group releasing the stories proves just how far some will go. Pro-life group, Life Dynamics, released their interview to prove what happened at the Kermit Gosnell clinic in Pennsylvania was not an isolated incident. The three clinic workers say the abortionist cut the spines of the fetuses or punctured the brain of the fetuses while they were still moving. One of the workers said the abortionist twisted the head off of a moving fetus, and would force an instrument thru the stomach to the spine. Boston Marathon bomber makes his first appearance in court today. 19-year-old Dzhokhar Tsarnaev plead not guilty to 30 charges to the Boston Marathon bombing where 3 people were killed and 264 people were injured, some even losing limbs. Lawmakers are now wondering why Boston police officers didn't see it coming. Hearings in the Senate and the House today had experts agreeing on that point. Homeland Security Chair Mike McCaul noted that Boston PD didn't know the FBI had opened a criminal investigation into the older brother Tamerlain and why he had visited Dagestan. McCaul questioned why the FBI hadn't informed the police, saying that state and local entities could be utilized because they want to be a part of this country's security, especially after 9/11 took place. Former NY Mayor Rudy Gulianni testified in the hearings asking why the FBI hasn't taken advantage of state and local police and security because there are 800,000 of them and only 12,000 agents. Since 9/11, only 18 people have been killed in this country due to an al Qaeda style attack, but that is still too many.

Silence will be interpreted as disapproval." So the largest group in the U.S., Christians, are having their religious freedom rights blocked by the smallest group in the nation.
