Nine out of ten women who enter the bus instead of the abortion clinic decide to not get the abortion. There are over 1,000 crisis pregnancy centers including a few mobile centers that also offer free ultrasounds across the nation. One of the largest organizations Care.net estimates it has helped save almost 400,000 babies. Planned Parenthood's new business model seems to be successful; they are doing over 70,000 more abortions per year.

Our food supply is lacking in micronutrients either it is stripped of nutrients from over processing or from over farming the land. An apple today has 77% less micronutrients in it than 80 years ago. Not having enough micronutrients in our bodies affects osteoporosis, cancer, high blood pressure, metabolism, diabetes, obesity, and even whether you sleep well or not. Over 90% of Americans are deficient in one or more critical vitamin or mineral for good health and most have no idea. The micronutrient deficiencies topping the list are Potassium, Calcium, Magnesium, and vitamins A, D, and E. At least one-fourth of the food we eat has zero nutritional value at all and some foods take away micronutrients like the phosphoric acid found in carbonated drinks interferes with our bodies' ability to absorb calcium. It is not only affecting our fruits and vegetables, but meats also. Most animals are raised inside factory farms and feed unhealthy grains and up to seven pounds of stale candy. Animals pasture raised will have 400% more vitamin A and E and 300% more Conjugated Lenoleic Acid in the meat. Other things that deplete our bodies of micronutrients are smoking, living in a polluted city, stress, and prescription medications. We should try to buy local produce and grass feed meats. We should take a supplement to make up for what we are missing like a highly absorbable powder vitamin.

Be weary of the products at eye level where grocers put the tasty unhealthy items because they sell the most. The extra effort to eat fresh foods will pay off in the long run.
