WMXC Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WMXC provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Breast Cancer Awareness ACS: During October, WMXC promoted Breast Cancer Awareness Month and the American Cancer Society's Making Strides Walk with a designated webpage on the station's website, www.mixgulfcoast.com. The page provided information on breast cancer screenings locally, local survivor stories, links to ACS programs, link for Real Men Wear Pink fundraiser, and sign-up information/donations for the Walk. The event was supported through live liners on air, recorded promos, the Best Bets For The Weekend online feature at www.mixgulfcoast.com, as well as on site the day of the Walk.
- American Cancer Society- Making Strides Walk. Information on 2018 Making Strides in Mobile on Oct 27. iHeart Mobile and WMXC co-sponsored the Walk, with Mary Booth emceeing the event at Bienville Square. Interview with breast cancer survivor Trattie Ollis and volunteer Ashley Morris (whose brother had breast cancer). Funds raised from the walk go toward research, education and local programs to support those going through breast cancer (including Look Good, Feel Better, which helps with wigs and makeup for those going through treatment; and Road to Recovery, which provides free rides to treatment).
- Children and Families: Information on Trees for Hope, an event that helps kick off the Christmas season with beautiful trees and wreaths to bid on, November 27th at Dauphin Way Baptist Church. The event provides an opportunity to learn more about Alabama Baptist Children's Homes and the guiding role they play in our community, providing a home for children in foster care. COO Dana Watson talks about his experience, growing up at the Children's Home, which provided him with stability and care he had never had. The Home also provided scholarship opportunities for him to attend college.

- Drug abuse: The Pasco Home in Mobile County provides a safe and faith based transition for those who have struggled through addiction. Pasco Home recently opened a separate facility for women struggling with addiction.
- Fire Prevention: Mobile Fire Chief Mark Sealy and public information officer Stephen Millhouse about the Mobile Fire-Rescue Department achieving a new milestone in its ISO rating. Mobile FRD brought the rating down from a 3 to a 1, with emphasis on training and updating

equipment, as well as checking hydrants for operation. The improvements mean better safety for citizens, as well as lower home owner insurance rates.

- Military/Veterans: Operation ReConnect. iHeart Radio Gulf Coast radio stations supported this program to provide free beach vacations for combat veterans and their families, when they return from deployment, to give them a chance to reconnect with each other. The program was developed by Ryan and Molly Charrier during his deployment to Iraq. The group solicits donations of time at beach condos, food from local restaurants and tickets for local attractions, as well as monetary donations, to provide a free week at the beach to these veterans and their families. Hundreds of veterans have been able to reconnect with their families since the program began 3 years ago.
- Shopping Safety: Holiday shopping safety, online and in store, and protecting our homes. Mobile Police Commander Levy says one key to protecting your belongings is to lock your car and keep packages/purses/phones out of sight.
- Special Needs/The Disabled: Melissa Harville with Goodwill Easter Seals talks about shopping at Goodwill for Halloween costumes, as well as everyday items.
