QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST  
4TH QUARTER - 2022

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KNAL-FM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those tissues for the period October 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and are occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect and particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:30am. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Seniors/Health - 10/02/22 - IT - Interview with Dr. Erica Schwartz, President of Insurance Solutions at United Healthcare, with some tips on choosing the right Medicare plan, and about getting help from free local community classes.

Youth/Communication - 10/02/22 - IT - Interview with Elena Lister and Michael Schwartzman, Co-Authors of "Giving Hope." They gave advice to parents on how to talk to their kids about death and extended illness. They also advocated different techniques for different age youth.

Health/Consumerism - 10/02/22 - IT - Interview with Carolina Schneider, Registered Dietician and Founder of Hungry for Plants. She gave advice for those seeking a vegan diet. She also discussed the importance of taking supplements for better nutrition.

Seniors/Fraud - 10/09/22 - IT - Interview with Rebecca Kinney, Director of Administration, Office of Healthcare Information and Counseling. She described some common Medicare scams and how to avoid being ripped off.

Health/Seniors - 10/09/22 - IT - Interview with Dr. Nick West, Chief Medical Officer and Vice President of Medical Affairs at Abbott Vascular. He spoke about PAD condition affecting heart valves, covering outgoing research and potential cures for the condition.

Poverty/Health - 10/09/22 - IT - Interview with Ivonne Rodriguez-Wiewall, Executive Advisor for Direct Relief in Puerto Rico. She described the remaining major damage in Puerto Rico from the storm of 2017, and how people can give to help citizens there.

Economy/Education - 10/16/22 - IT - Interview with Howard Yaruss, Economist, Professor, and Attorney. He discussed his book "Understandable Economics." and touched on the current state of the American economy.

Inflation/National Debt - 10/16/22 - IT - Interview with Red Taylor, Founder of Arrivehome Investment Partners. He gave an assessment of the real estate market and discussed how government over-regulation is hurting the markets.

Health/Communication - 10/16/22 - IT - Interview with Dr. Yvette Miller, Executive Medical Officer, Red Cross Blood Services. She stressed the need for more donations for sickle cell patients, and getting necessary information to African-American communities.

Legal System/Crime - 10/23/22 - IT - Interview with Tim Bakken, Author of "The Plea of Innocence." He commented on changes to the legal system. He also talked about the need for more rights of the accused.

Youth/Suicide - 10/23/22 - IT - Interview with Amy Wright, President of Children's Hospital Association. She discussed the growing number of teen mental health admissions to hospitals, and expressed the need for better counseling programs in schools.

Senior/Health - 10/23/22 - IT - Interview with Sarah Chavarria, President of Delta Dental Insurance Company. She spoke about the importance of better dental health for seniors. She also discussed detailed brushing techniques.

Affordable Housing/ Inflation - 10/30/22 - IT - Interview with Dennis Shea, Executive Director of Bipartisan Policy Center. He described ways to bring down the cost of housing. He also commented on government regulations that are causing higher costs.

Environment/Entrepreneurship - 10/30/22 - IT - Interview with Josh Goralski, Affiliated with Unlocking Communities. He described efforts for entrepreneurs to be involved with policies that help the environment. He also talked about the work of the Greenhouse Project.

Youth/Railroad Safety - 10/30/22 - IT - Interview with Mark Chandler, Senior Research Associate With Safe Kids. He detailed safety precautions youth should use near railroad facilities. He also talked about how parents can better communicate with their kids about the dangers of rail crossings.

Environment/Climate Change - 11/06/22 - IT - Interview with Michael Webster, Ecologist Professor at NY University. He detailed how some species can re-invent themselves even during climate change. He also talked about how mankind can help these species.

Youth/Depression - 11/06/22 - IT - Interview with Dr. Jessica Peck, Author and Researcher. She talked about the growing problem of teen depression. She also gave tips to parents on how they can detect symptoms.

Youth/Auto Safety - 11/06/22 - Interview with Brian Moody, Executive Editor of Kelley Blue Book. He discussed ways for parents to pick the right car for newly licensed teenage drivers. He also gave some general safety tips.

Seniors/Health - 11/13/22 - IT - Interview with Jason Resendez, Board Member of Consumers for Quality Care. He detailed how the public can save money on their medical bills. He also talked about surprise billing practices.

Economy/Inflation - IT - 11/13/22 - Interview with Farhad Omeyr, Program Director Research and Data at Center for City Solutions. He commented on the most financially distressed cities in the country. He discussed how pension debt has become a major stress factor

Veterans/Unemployment - IT - 11/13/22 - Interview with Terrone Sims, Advisor on Veterans and Military Life Issues at Merit International, Inc. He discussed how Vet spouses have a hard time transferring professional licenses from state to state. He gave some advice on how the situation could be improved.

China Trade/Economy - IT - 11/20/22 - Interview with Nan Su, Senior Investigative Reporter for Epoch Times. He gave a report on deteriorating economic conditions between China and the United States. He also commented on China invading Taiwan.

Health/Drug Costs - IT - 11/20/22 - Interview with Jim Geraghty, Researcher and Author. He discussed efforts to get more orphan drugs for rare diseases. He also talked about government regulations to increase treatments.

Youth/Education - IT - 11/20/22 - Interview with Blythe Thomas, Director of 1000 Days. She tackled the issue of infant food insecurity. She also talked about their efforts to educate the public about good nutrition.

Unemployment/Veterans - IT - 11/27/22 - Interview with Brantlee Underhill, Managing Director of Project Management Institute. He discussed how veterans can better transition from the military to civilian life. He also talked about how they educate vets on possible careers.

Health/Youth - IT - 11/27/22 - Interview with Robin Koval and Dorian Fuhrman, Members of Truth Initiative. They detailed their efforts to stop vaping among teens. They also offered support for those states prohibiting flavored vaping products.

Health/Education - IT - 11/27/22 - Interview with Dr. Ken Redcross, Concierge Medical Practitioner. He commented on the growing problem of Diabetes in society. He also discussed how healthy diets help control the problem.

Affirmative Action/ Education - IT - 12/04/22 - Interview with Dr. Luran Star, Psychologist and Researcher. She detailed how Vets can better prepare for civilian life. She also talked about the need for better marketing on Vet programs.

History/Education - IT - 12/04/22 - Interview with Martin Dugard, History Researcher and Author. He discussed World War II and how lessons from then apply to today. He also profiled heroes from the war.

Health/Veganism - IT - 12/04/22 - Interview with Andrew DeCoriolis, Executive Director of Farm Forward. He discussed how the U.S. can continue to improve sustainable farming. He also commented on ways that free-range practices can be improved.

Consumerism/Retirement Benefits - IT - 12/11/22 - Interview with Kevin Crain, Head of Retirement Research and Insights, Bank of America. He discussed how employees can make the most of their job benefits. He also talked about how companies are increasing retirement benefits.

Unemployment/Seniors - IT - 12/11/22 - Interview with Aaron Terrazas, Chief Economist at Glassdoor. He gave a report on workplaces trends around the country. He also talked about demographic shifts in workers.

Youth/Drug Abuse - IT - 12/11/22 - Interview with Bruce Sheridan, Family Life Expert and Author. He detailed how teens can better cope with difficult family life. He also touched on drug abuse in the country.

Youth/Health - IT - 12/18/22 - Interview with Dr. Wendy Hasson, Medical Director, Pediatric ICU, Portland, Oregon. She gave an update on the RSV and Flu epidemic. She also detailed symptoms parents should watch out for.

Police Funding/ Health - IT - 12/18/22 - Interview with Aaron Negherbon, Founder and Executive Director of Cops Direct. He gave a brief history of the group that aids police departments in receiving specialized equipment. He also expressed the need for more funding as requests are larger than current funding allows.

Domestic Violence/Crime - IT - 12/18/22 - Interview with Ed Bartlett, Member of Abuse and Violence International Alliance. He described the growing problem of domestic violence against men. He also talked about the need for more exposure about the problem.

Health/Education - IT - 12/25/22 - Interview with 1. Dr. James Cottrell, Former President of America Society of Anesthesiologists. He gave the in's-and-out's of anesthesiology. He also talked about the need for physicians to explain the procedures better.

Taxes/Seniors - IT - 12/25/22 - Interview with Les Winston, Philanthropic Financial Planner. He gave tips on how consumers can do long-term philanthropic planning. He also talked about tax benefits.

Pet Safety/Inflation - IT - 12/25/22 - Interview with Charlotte Reed, Executive Producer of "The Pet Buzz." She detailed solutions to 'petflation.' She also gave advice on how to save money on pet health problems.
