They did morning news reports and produced a number of news features.</p> <p>WKNO TV had a production intern in June of 2021 from Collierville High School. They helped run camera during studio and field shoots, participated in production planning and edited promos for air.</p>
8	Training Programs for station personnel.	<p>All WKNO employees completed harassment and peer sensitivity training sessions in September of 2021 using online CPB harassment training.</p> <p>In September 2021 our Director of Television Content attended a PTPA conference with other public television stations.</p> <p>The Education Manager attended the National Science Teachers Association virtual conference in April 2021. Topics included literacy, equity in science learning, dealing with COVID and the latest STEM lessons.</p>
10	Community Events sponsored by educational institution to inform/educate about public broadcasting careers	WKNO routinely provides tours of its radio and television production facilities to student and youth organizations in the area. Each tour is virtually identical. They get to see our radio station, classical music library, TV studios, TV control room, and lots of related computer and recording equipment.
