Sessions included expanding education outreach, integrating children's TV program content with educational learning, and professional development. The Director of Finance attended a webinar on January 19, 2024 hosted by TIAA. It included changes coming with Secure ACT 2.0 and how it will affect employees going forward. The Director of Finance attended an all-day seminar at the University of Memphis sponsored by The Plan Sponsor University in October of 2023. The various sessions included information on the new Secure ACT 2.0, fiduciary responsibility of pension plans and best practices for various employee benefit plans. WKNO routinely provides tours of its radio and television production facilities to student and youth organizations in the area. Each tour is virtually identical. They get to see our radio station, classical music library, TV studios, TV control room, and lots of related computer and recording equipment. They are given a brief history of WKNO and some insight into less visible aspects like our administrative and membership departments. In April of 2023 there was a festival called Art in the Loop in Memphis. Because of all the close partnerships that WKNO has with the local Arts and Culture scene, WKNO rented a booth and promoted related cultural programs, education outreach and the types of careers WKNO has for these types of positions. WKNO partnered with local newspapers, museums, other non-profits, and most colleges and universities in the city.
