1. The Corona Covid-19 virus impact on the Bedford County economy remains a major concern.
2. The lack of high speed internet and broadband seen as a major hurdles to economic development in Bedford County.
3. The opioid epidemic and illegal drug use in general have drawn concern from local treatment agencies and law enforcement.
4. Various land use issues are forcing rural communities to look at land restrictions and zoning.
5. School Districts continue to struggle with budgets, taxes and Charter Schools draining their budgets.
