1	Participated in Career Fair	On October 14, 2020 the station participated in a virtual job and internship fair hosted by the University of Tennessee and sponsored by the College of Communications and Information. News, Sales and Digital Managers participated in the first virtual job fair, meeting online with upper- level students and recent graduates to discuss job opportunities with WVLT, as well as academic paths needed to obtain a job. The Tennessee Association of Broadcasters hosted its first
		virtual Job Fair on December 7 – 14, 2020. News and Sales managers interviewed candidates through online team meetings. A TAB job fair promotional campaign ran on air and on the station website to encourage participation in the event.
		The Director of Creative Services and Production participated in a virtual career on February 26, 2021 presented by the Savannah College of Art and Design. Individual meetings were held with several upper -level students to discuss qualifications and types of broadcast employment opportunities available in Gray marketing departments across the country.
		On March 5, 2021 the News Director participated in a virtual career fair event hosted by Penn State University. The News Director meet with students virtually and discussed both academic career paths in journalism as well as job/internship opportunities at WVLT-TV.

In addition to reporting, classes are held on career pathing, networking, how to interview, developing your professional career personality profile and developing your resume reel. Class of 25 students. On October 02, 2020 both the WVLT Chief Meteorologist and a Primary Anchor participated in virtual meetings where they regularly serve on the University of Tennessee Journalism Advisory Board. This board reviews and works with journalism students to help bring real world broadcast experiences into the classroom.
