1	Participated in Career Fair	On October 09, 2019 the station participated in a job and internship fair held on the campus of the University of Tennessee and sponsored by the College of Communications and Information. News Managers, on air staff, Sales Manager and station employee alumni participated, meeting with attendees and discussing job/internship opportunities with WVLT, as well as academic paths needed to obtain a job. On October 21, 2019 the News Director participated in a career fair event at the Columbia Convention Center sponsored by the University of South Carolina. The News Director meet with students and discussed both academic career paths in journalism as well as job/internship opportunities at WVLT-TV.
2	Participate in Events Sponsored by Education Institutions relating to Careers in Broadcasting	Several times each a semester on an ongoing basis the WVLT General Manager teaches Media Leadership classes at the University of Tennessee School of Communications. Topics discussed are what to expect when looking for a job in the field of broadcast journalism and leadership development. Two classes were taught during the period (April 2019 and October 2019). There are 15-20 Junior/Senior level students in each class. Station managers volunteer as speakers for upper level classes (20-25 students) at the University of Tennessee School of Communications. During this period class presentations were presented by the General Sales Manager (November 2019), Digital Sales Manager (November 2019), Meteorologist (November 2019) and Primary Anchor (April 2019). A WVLT Primary Anchor serves on the Lincoln Memorial University Advisory Board to help review and establish curriculum and promote outreach for communications students. Formal board meetings and outreach was completed in April 2019 and October 2019. Beginning September 20, 2019, WVLT Chief Meteorologist regularly serves on the University of Tennessee Journalism Advisory Board. This board reviews and works with journalism students to help bring real world broadcast experiences into the classroom.

		A WVLT Primary Anchor is the course instructor at University of Tennessee for the upper level TV News Reporting (JREM411). This class was offered during the Summer 2019, Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters. This is a class open to upperclassmen and is designed to give the students the tools needed to be successful multimedia journalists. In addition to reporting, classes are held on career pathing, networking, how to interview, developing your professional career personality profile and developing your resume reel. Class of 25 students. On October 21, 2019 the News Director spoke to an upper level TV Journalism class of 40 students at the University of South Carolina about career paths and breaking into the business of television news. On November 13, 2019 a WVLT Primary Anchor spoke about careers in television. This meeting was hosted by the University of Tennessee Center for Career Development for their student athletes.
3	Participate in Events Sponsored by Community Groups interested in Broadcast Employment	In June 2019 the WVLT General Manager was a presenter at the Tennessee Association of Broadcasters Radio Talent Institute. A group of 12 students from across the state of Tennessee were competitively selected by TAB to attend this event. The presentation was titled "Broadcasting: Whether on Camera, On the Mic, Sales or Production" gave the students a look not only to WVLT-TV, but to the opportunities in the television industry. On April 9, 2019 The Emerald Youth Foundation of Knoxville held a Career Event for inner city students which provided an introduction to careers including those in television news. The WVLT News Director, Anchor, and Producer spoke with about 20 students about careers in journalism.

4	Internship Program	WVLT offers students enrolled in a college/university the opportunity to gain practical experience in a broadcast environment. During the reporting period the station had a total of 11 interns. Participation was as follows: Summer Semester 2019 – Three students participated. Two students from The University of Tennessee and one student from the University of Alabama. All students interned in the News/Sports Department. Fall Semester 2019 – Four students from the University of Tennessee participated in the internship. Three in the News/Sports Department and one in the Sales Department. Spring semester 2019 - Four students from the University of Tennessee participated in the internship. One in the Sales Department and three in the News/Sports track.
