Quarterly Issues Programs List for Station – WLTL-FM April 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019

Section I. Issues.

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- **A. WLTL News:** This quarter, WLTL provided a series of on-air interviews with school and community leaders. WLTL also aired a community affairs program in conjunction with the school newspaper, *Lion*.
- **B. WLTL Involvement:** For many years now, WLTL has supported LTHS's Relay for Life through the playing of PSAs to promote the event to the community and help raise funds for the American Cancer Society.
- **C. LTHS Sports:** The community, as always, asks that WLTL provides live play-by-play coverage of LTHS Baseball and Softball, and again this quarter WLTL was able to meet this need.

Section II. Responsive Programs

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues. Programming dealing with each issue is set out below:

A. WLTL News

WLTL aired three episodes of *Happenings in the Hallway*, produced in collaboration with our school newspaper *The Lion*. These 30 minute episodes focused on local community issues such as housing costs, property developments and more.

We also aired several short features on LT and community history that aired throughout the quarter. They featured interviews with community members, faculty and staff about LT, our community and the physical building as well.

B. WLTL Involvement

Relay for Life Public Service Announcements: WLTL helped to promote the annual LTHS Relay for Life that took place on Saturday, June 8, 2019. During this quarter, WLTL aired several different PSAs for this event that began airing on May 1 and finished on June 8, 2019. The total amount of airplay was more than five (5) hours.

C. LTHS Football

Live Sports Broadcasts: LTHS community members consistently ask that WLTL provide play-by-play coverage for LTHS sports. This spring, WLTL was able to provide live play-by-play coverage for both boys baseball and girls softball. During this quarter, WLTL also broadcast five boys baseball games and two girls softball games during the months of April and May.
