Education

1.13.24 Missouri Western and Northwest Missouri State University meet in a classic rivalry on the basketball court this weekend; with the head coaches of both teams.

1.27.24 St Joseph School District officials put the finishing touches on a \$20-million bond issue on the April 2nd ballot; with Superintendent of Schools Gabe Edgar and Assistant Superintendent Ashly McGinnis.

2.24.24 Arch-rivals Missouri Western State University and Northwest Missouri State University face off in men's basketball; with head coaches Will Martin of MWSU and Ben McCollum of NWMSU.

3.9.24 Fallout from vote against a 4-day school week; with LaTonya Williams, President, and Kenneth Reeder, Vice President, St Joseph School District Board of Education.

3.23.24 Proposed long-range plan for the St. Joseph School District; with School Superintendent Gabe Edgar.

Economy

2.3.24 Gray Manufacturing of St. Joseph invested \$500,000 in the new Convergent Technology Alliance Center at Missouri Western State University; with Gray Manufacturing President Stet Schanze and CEO Pete Gray.

Law Enforcement

1.20.24 The K-9 officer who worked with Max, the St Joseph police dog shot to death on duty in June of 2021, says he will never forget that night: with Officer Lucas Winder.

2.17.24 Twenty three people were injured, one fatally, in shooting near the Super Bowl rally in Kansas City; with Kansas City Mayor Quinton Lucas and Police Chief Stacey Graves.
