AJW492 – 12/13/19 - Group Think- Talked about what God expects from us as a group of people. In Hebrew there are a lot of words to describe groups. Very important to the Jewish culture. Their perspective is that we are an isolated individual God looks at society as a whole, 1 unit. Everything we do good or bad affects our families, community, the world especially when it's damaging to people. Society is like the body hurting or one part affecting the whole. The root word for this in Hebrew contains letters with numerical value that represents each age group of people. The idea is that all are always affected so all must be a part. Requires group strength. In society, the more people you connect with the more you will grow.

AJW521 – 12/16/19 – Blessing the Children 2Blessing the Children (2)-The names Ephraim & Manasseh have great significance. Manasseh means God has blessed me with financial abundance and forgotten about the former troubles. Ephraim means deep spiritual connection with God.

There is a purity on the 1st.

AJW500 – 12/31/19 – Never Settle-talked about how insecurity as an adult can be a very unhealthy feeling. God wants us to experience this period of insecurity to appreciate life once we do settle.
