WBAP AM is licensed to Fort Worth, TX; WBAP FM is licensed to Flower Mound, TX, and with the 100% simulcast both serve the Dallas/Fort Worth area. From January 1 through March 31, 2013, WBAP AM/FM aired an average of 16 hours of news and/or public affairs programming weekly. This includes a locally produced weekday morning news program ("The WBAP Morning News") which focuses on issues affecting our local community and includes guests who have knowledge of these topics.

Additionally, WBAP AM/FM airs 30 hours per week of locally produced issue-oriented talk program that also examines these issues. "The Ben Ferguson Show" airs 9am-11am Mon-Fri, and "The Chris Krok Program" airs 8pm-12am Mon-Fri.

WBAP is a participant in "The Amber Plan", in which area radio stations alert the public of confirmed child abductions. In the First Quarter of 2013, WBAP activated "The Amber Plan" when necessary, to provide information about child abductions to the general public.

WBAP is one of the Primary EAS stations serving North Texas, and activates EAS for weather and civil emergencies as well as Amber abduction alerts.
