According to Dyson, every fundamental argument about race in America was heard in that room.</p> <p>Fifty-five years after this historic year, the tense intersection of conflict between conscience and politics—between morality and power—in addressing race continues on with Black Lives Matter. In his new book <i>What Truth Sounds Like</i>, Michael Eric Dyson confronts a difficult situation directly: whether we embrace political resolution or moral redemption to fix our fractured racial landscape in this country.
