KING 5 / KONG COMMUNITY EVENTS SUMMARY – 4th Quarter 2023

October 1st – December 31st, 2023 – Back to Action (B2A)

KING 5 partnered with Northwest Harvest and other key stakeholders to increase volunteerism in the Puget Sound region. There has been a decline of 70-80% in regular volunteers for hunger resource organizations, so we have set a goal of 3,000 individuals by the end of 2023. There was a media event with team members from the Seattle Seahawks for a day of service. KING 5 support for the campaign included PSAs, digital and social, and in-content promotion.

October 13th, 2023 – Key to Hope Luncheon

KING 5 was a sponsor for Plymouth Housing's 20th annual Key to Hope luncheon. More than 1,000 attendees joined in-person to celebrate and learn more about Plymouth Housing's work to end homelessness and address its causes. Anchor Joyce Taylor hosted the program. The event raised \$1.5 million.

October 20th, 2023 - Women in Leadership Breakfast

KING 5 was the official media partner for the Seattle Sports Commission Women in Leadership Breakfast. The breakfast aims to empower, inspire, and connect women in the community. This was the 11th annual breakfast, focusing on pay equity, investing in yourself, and navigating the changing professional landscape. Anchor Joyce Taylor hosted the program.

<u>December 2nd, 2023 – Home Team Harvest</u>

KING 5 held our annual live special for Home Team Harvest, Washington state's largest annual food drive. Along with partners Safeway/Albertsons, Swedish, Kitsap Credit Union, Warm 106.9, and Seahawks, KING 5 promoted monetary and food donations through November and December. On December 2nd, KING 5 hosted a one-hour broadcast special from four live locations, highlighting Northwest Harvest and other organizations in our community. Northwest Harvest is Washington's largest hunger relief agency, working with more than 400 food banks, meal programs, and high-need schools across the state. KING 5 support for the campaign included PSAs, digital and social, and in-content promotion.
