The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Kenneth Marquise Tucker (Armed Robbery) B Kenneth Marquise Tucker is wanted by the Caln Township, Pennsylvania police department for a number of charges related to and including armed robbery. At approximately 1:35pm on March 2, 1999 Tucker entered the First National Bank of Malvern, where he displayed a black semi-automatic pistol and stole \$4,140. He then led authorities on a high-speed chase in a stolen car, which flipped three times during the pursuit. Tucker escaped, ran across four lanes of traffic and was hit by an oncoming car. Tucker disappeared near the Philadelphia area and continues to elude authorities. Beside armed robbery, Tucker is wanted by nearly eight other townships for purse snatching and other related crimes. Tucker has a tattoo of his nickname, AFudd@, on his upper left arm. He is known to wear wigs and dye his hair, and has dressed as a woman for disguise. Tucker is 20, 5'10" and 155 pounds.

Unknown (Murder) B Vancouver police are looking for the killer or killers or thirty or more prostitutes missing from a four block corridor of Vancouver=s downtown east side. It all began in 1995 B one by one prostitutes began disappearing. In total, more than thirty prostitutes have disappeared, and police aren=t sure who is responsible. Police have no crime scenes and no bodies. But, they do have a few clues. Police want to talk to an anonymous caller who left a message on a 1-800 number set up by a friend of one of the victims. In the recording, the caller warns police and friends of the victims to Astop searching because Sarah [one of the victims] is dead.@ It also claimed prostitutes would be killed Aone every Friday night@. Police say the call may be a hoax and there is nothing backing up the Friday night murder sprees. Prostitutes are also looking out for a mysterious brown van they say prowls the area on weekends. The prostitutes say the driver of that van may hold clues to solving this case.

AJunior@ (Murder)

ADavid@ (Murder) B Two unknown men are wanted for questioning in the 1999 murders of Diana Lynn Algar and Jose Julian Molina in Wapwallopen, Pennsylvania. On Monday July 19, 1999 the bodies of Diana Algar and her friend Jose Molina were found in Algar=s trailer. The two had been shot, execution style. Various items, including a stereo, had been stolen from the trailer. Written on the wall in mascara were the letters CFH. Algar=s light blue 1987 Dodge 600 with Pennsylvania plate BXE 4817 is missing. A witness at the campground told police she saw two young men with Algar the day before. She also provided the only names for the two that she remembered, David and Junior. The investigation led police to a truck stop on Rte. 80, where surveillance video caught the two men asking a clerk about finding a ride to Georgia just moments before Algar is seen approaching the same counter. AJunior@ is described as tall with a muscular build and shoulder-length hair that is shaved underneath. He was wearing a Cleveland Indians baseball cap. He may be carrying a wallet with a chain on it. He smokes Marlboro cigarettes. He may have a two-year-old son. AJunior@ is approximately 20 and 5'9". ADavid@ has a thin build and a buzz cut. He has either a tribal band or barbed wire tattoo. His left nipple is pierced with a neon green tomahawk. He was wearing a shirt with a Cleveland Indians logo on it and black Nike sneakers. He smokes Camel cigarettes. He may have a one-year-old son. ADavid@ is approximately 21, but may be younger, and 5'7"-5'8". The men may be traveling to the Woodstock festival in Rome, New York, or to Valdosta, Georgia. (See Show #551, OAD 7/24/99)

Richard Alan Minsky (Rape, Extortion, Fraud, Sexual Assault, Probation Violations) B Richard Minsky is wanted on charges of rape, sexual assault, extortion and fraud. He is accused of conning women at random over the phone by pretending to be the victim=s husband or friend. Minsky allegedly does two different voices on the phone, one being the husband or friend, the other being the husband=s or friend=s attorney. The Aattorney@ tells the victim that their loved one was involved in a hit and run accident and the victim must meet with the witness to

prevent the witness from pressing charges. The victim is instructed to get money and to dress sexy, then to meet the witness@ at a public place such as an airport or hotel lobby. From there Minsky allegedly takes the money, sometimes fondles the woman and in a few cases has been accused of rape. Minsky has been convicted of extortion in the past and his long criminal record dates back to 1962. Authorities believe Minsky has victimized hundreds of women over the years. Minsky has thinning hair and wears very thick glasses. He has a Boston accent. He chain-smokes Marlboro cigarettes, and is often seen at public telephones. Minsky is 55, 5'7" and 145 pounds.

James Glenn Moore (Child Abuse) -- Moore is wanted for the assault of his girlfriend's 9-month-old daughter, Gabrielle "Gabby" Harvard. On December 27, 1998 Moore was babysitting Gabby when she supposedly fell from the couch and began gasping for air. Moore took the infant down the street to her grandmother's house to get help. The grandmother told police that Gabby's legs were dark purple and she looked half-dead when Moore arrived at her door. Tina rushed Gabby to the hospital, but James refused to go. Doctors later determined that Gabby had not fallen from a couch; she was actually suffering from "shaken baby syndrome." Police say Moore shook Gabby so hard that she is now permanently blind and may never walk again. Moore is a heavy drinker and frequents bars. He may have shaved his head. He is also wanted in Oregon on unrelated drug and firearm charges. Authorities say that Moore has friends and family in California, Colorado and Wyoming. Moore is 23, 6'0" and 155 pounds.

FBI=S TEN MOST WANTED:

James Kopp (Wanted for questioning) -- Kopp is wanted for the 1998 murder of Dr. Barnett Slepian, an abortion doctor, in his home in Amherst, NY. On October 23, 1998, Dr. Slepian was shot and killed in front his family by an unknown sniper with a high powered rifle. A neighbor of Dr. Slepian's told police they had noticed a black Chevy Cavalier with Vermont plates parked on the street near Dr. Slepian's home weeks before the shooting. Authorities traced the plates and the car came back registered to James Kopp, of St. Albans, Vermont. Kopp, whose nickname is "Atomic Dog", has numerous arrests related to anti-abortion protests and is listed on the dedication page of the anti-abortion group "Army of God" terrorist manual. He has a fraternal twin brother named Walter. He is a former Eagle Scout, originally from Pasadena, California, and has a Master's in Marine Biology. Kopp has two cars, a black 1987 Chevy Cavalier with Vermont license plate BPE216, and a 1977 green Dodge, with Vermont license plate BFN959; both cars have been spotted near the areas where abortion doctors have been shot at. He is a trumpet player and loves to ride bicycles. Kopp wears prescription glasses and may wear a goatee or beard. He is 44, 5'11" and 155-170 pounds. AMW ALL-POINTS BULLETIN:

Unknown (Murder) B The FBI and the Oglala Sioux Department of Public Safety (tribal police) are offering a \$15,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person who murdered Ronald Owen Hardheart and Wallace Edison Black Elk, Jr. The men had been beaten to death. The partially decomposed bodies of the two men were discovered by a woman running on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation near the Nebraska border at White Clay on June 8, 1999. Hardheart and Black Elk, Jr. were last seen alive at 10:30pm on Sunday, June 6th, walking north on the main road from White Clay, Nebraska. Police speculate they were headed to the South Dakota side of the reservation.

MISSING:

Keteria Alexis Blackburn

Age: 2 2
Weight: 30 pounds

According to detectives with the Jefferson County, Alabama sheriff's department, 2 2-year-old Keteria Blackburn disappeared in February from Bessemer, Alabama. Blackburn's mother, Lasondra Smith, told them she traded her daughter for crack cocaine. According to court documents, Smith told police she doesn't know the man she gave her baby to and can't describe him because she was too high. Smith has been arrested and charged with child abandonment and abuse. The search continues for Keteria in and around the Jefferson County area. Keteria sometimes goes by the nickname ATeria@. UPDATES:

Cary Stayner (Murder) B Federal agents in California are trying to link the hotel handyman charged with four Yosemite National Park murders, with other unsolved California killings. Cary Stayner, the man who confessed to the murder of three female sightseers, was indicted in a Sacramento federal court on Monday for the beheading death of a 26-year-old naturalist who lived near the national park. Law enforcement sources tell America's Most Wanted that 37-year-old Cary Stayner confessed to the brutal murder of Carole Sund, 42, her daughter Julie Sund, 15, and Silvina Pelosso, a 16-year-old family friend. Local San Francisco media has reported that a few of the unsolved crimes include the beheading of a prostitute and the stabbing death of a woman whose body was then burned. Carole and Silvina's bodies were recovered in the burned-out trunk of a rental car. Julie's body was discovered in a remote area on the Yosemite park land. The three women were reported missing February 15 while on a vacation in Yosemite National Park. After a month of searching, the women's rental car was found burned-out with the remains of Mrs. Sund and Pelosso in the trunk. Julie Sund's body was found a week later in a remote area of Yosemite. During the search earlier this year, investigators focused their investigation on a number of ex-cons who were known Methamphetamine abusers out of Modesto, California. Until now, agents working the case of the Sund-Pelosso murders were confident that all responsible for the killings were behind bars on unrelated charges. According to sources, the reason agents were assured of this group's link to the murders was from fibers found at Julie Sund's crime scene. Two of the suspects had similar fibers linked to them. Sources also say that one of the suspects even implicated himself in the killings. But on Saturday, officials arrested Stayner for the brutal murder and beheading of 26-year-old Joie Armstrong. Sources say Stayner confessed to that murder and then claimed responsibility for the murders of Carole, Julie and Silvina. "Stayner provided details about the crime that are not generally known outside law enforcement," as it was written in the affidavit filed Monday in a federal court in Sacramento, California. Officials began looking for Stayner after park rangers remembered seeing his sport-utility vehicle parked near Armstrong's cabin in Foresta, California. last Wednesday, the night she was last seen alive. Armstrong's decapitated body was discovered near her home the next day. Officials say they have developed leads that link Stayner to the murder of the three other women. They would not elaborate on the specific clues. Authorities have not charged Stayner with the February killings, but they are saying that they want to wrap-up this case quickly. Unknown (Robbery) -- Agents in California are looking for a heavy set man they say is responsible for five bank robberies in the Los Angeles area. Because of the hat he wears during the robberies, agents have dubbed him the ACivil War Bandit@. His spree began on April 10, 1998 when he robbed a Bank of America in Montrose, California. He entered, armed with a sawed-off shotgun and carrying a bag. He struck seven months later, robbing a California Federal Bank in Glendale. He apparently robbed the same Glendale bank again two months later. He later robbed the California Federal Bank in La Canada on two separate occasions. Tellers who have serviced him say he is very polite during his robberies. The suspect has a moustache and goatee, and may wear his hair in a pony tail. He also wears sunglasses during the robberies, and carries a black backpack or JanSport bag. Witnesses say he has gained considerable weight during the past year. The suspect is in his early 30's, 6'0"-6'2" and 240-260 pounds. Following the initial broadcast, a number of tips pointed out a resemblance to professional wrestler AThe Big Bossman@. However, he is clearly not a suspect. (See Show #541, OAD 5/8/99)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Evelio Rivera Zacarias (Attempted Murder, Kidnapping, Rape) B Evelio Zacarias is wanted for fatally shooting four people, injuring two others, kidnapping and raping a woman on August 9, 1999 in Rosemead, California. Zacarias was obsessed with his ex-girlfriend and upset over the breakup of their 20-year romance. On Monday night, August 9, he stormed into the home of her new boyfriend=s family, shot six people, killing four, and kidnapped a female family member. After sexually assaulting his hostage, Zacarias= vehicle broke down and he was picked up by a friend driving a dark-blue pickup truck. He and the other man were seen on surveillance cameras getting gas at an Arco station in Industry, California. Zacarias= friend turned himself in to police after seeing himself on TV. He told police that he dropped Zacarias off in Tijuana, Mexico. Zacarias sometimes goes by the name Evelio Zacarias Rivera. He is clean shaven, and may be working in construction. Zacarias is 41, 5'5" and 160 pounds.

Norman Lee Johnston (Escape) B Johnston is wanted for escaping from the Pennsylvania State Correctional Institute in Huntingdon on August 2, 1999. Johnston was serving a life sentence for killing four teenagers in 1978 to cover up a multimillion dollar burglary ring he ran with his two brothers, Bruce Sr. and David. The burglary ring was responsible for stealing hundreds of trucks, cars and farm equipment in Pennsylvania, Delaware and Maryland. The 1986 film AAt Close Range@, starring Sean Penn, was based on the case. Johnson opened a window of his cell, sneaked across a grassy yard and wriggled through a fence some time after 1:00am on Monday, August 2, 1999. Authorities are offering a \$10,000 reward for Johnston=s capture. Johnston=s nose was broken in the past. He may have a buzz cut and may wear glasses. He likes to play chess, lift weights, read and job. He has worked as a body and fender repairman. Johnston is 49, 6'1" and 160-180 pounds.

Carl Alfred Eder (Murder, Escape) B Eder is wanted for the 1974 escape from the California Correctional Institute in Tehachapi. Eder was serving a life sentence for the 1958 shooting and stabbing murders of a woman and her four children. On December 12, 1958, Eder murdered Lois Pendergast and her children in their El Cajon, California home where Eder was staying. The husband and father, Tom Pendergast, made the grisly discovery. Eder was arrested three days later at Mission Beach in San Diego. The celebrated case was considered the worst mass murder in San Diego county until the 1984 massacre of twenty-two people at a McDonald=s restaurant in San Ysidro. On March 19, 1959 Eder pleaded guilty and received five terms of life imprisonment, two consecutive, three concurrent. On October 11, 1974 prison authorities say Eder walked off a work detail at the Correctional Institute in Tehachapi after serving only fifteen years. He left behind a note: AI=ve done enough time and I=m leaving@. Eder has used several aliases, including Charles Eder, Charles Harrison, John Wehee, and Max Turner. He has a scar on his left hand between his thumb and forefinger, and a surgical scar from a gall bladder operation. He has numerous moles on his face and a receding hairline. Eder is a skilled machinist and cabinet maker who is interested in chemistry and sciences. He may be working as a hospital lab technician or as a small engine mechanic. He is a follower of Zen Buddhism, and believes in the occult, Tarot, and fortune telling. He is a loner who shows little emotion. He is the outdoor type who likes boating. Eder is 57, 6'2" and 165-175 pounds. (See Shows #150, #178 and #219; 2/8/91, 8/30/91 and 6/26/92)

Brian Joseph Evans (Child Molestation) B Placerville Police in Northern California say Brian Evans is wanted for molesting a 12-year-old girl in Meriden, Connecticut. On July 7, 1999 detectives questioned Evans about molestation allegations regarding a young neighborhood girl. After the detectives left, Evans went to his father=s house and told him that detectives were questioning him about writing bad checks in Connecticut. On July 8, 1999 around 8:00am, Evans was seen leaving his apartment with his three children in his Suzuki Samurai with California

license plate 3HBE513. Evans= father received a letter postmarked Bakersfield, California which his son wrote on July 12, saying he was en route to San Diego. Since then, Evans has called friends saying he was heading to Connecticut and Virginia. One of those calls was traced to a pay phone in Salt Lake, Utah. He is traveling with his two daughters, Christina Nicole Evans, age 7, and Victoria Lynn Evans, age 6, and his son Brett Tyler Evans, age 3. Evans speaks with a Southern accent. He is a neat freak and is considered a computer genius. He loves to eat at Taco Bell and shops at Wal-Mart. Evans is 25, 6'2" and 150 pounds.

AMW ALL-POINTS BULLETINS:

Artur A. Martirosyan (Murder) B Martirosyan is wanted for murdering two men in Aurora, Colorado. On September 7, 1998, Michael Martinez left a Denver hospital bent on getting the people who had Asnitched on him@. To seek his revenge, Martinez employed the help of three friends: Artur Martirosyan, Alex Pogosyan and an unnamed friend. Martirosyan drove the other men to the home of Ed Morales. Morales, 18, and Zech Osbert, 18, were sleeping in the basement of the house when Pogosyan and Martinez entered, each with 12 gauge shotguns. Pogosyan and Martinez opened fire and killed Osbert and Morales. After the killings, Martirosyan dropped Martinez and Pogosyan off at Martinez= apartment. From there Martinez and Pogosyan went to the home of Penny Bowman-Medla, 37. Upon entering the house the two men shot and killed Medla then proceeded to the basement where they found her son, Greg Medla, 18, and his girlfriend Marisa Avalos, 16. Medla and Avalos were also shot to death. Later that day cops were tipped off to where they would find the murder weapons. When police arrived at the area they didn=t find the guns but did find Michael Martinez. Martinez was dead from four shotgun blasts. Martirosyan and Pogosyan were later arrested. There was not enough evidence to keep Martirosyan behind bars so they let him go. Pogosyan was convicted of his involvement in the crime and now police have the evidence they need to arrest Artur Martirosyan, but he has disappeared. Martirosyan has several tatoos, including AArmenia@ on his right elbow, AArmenian [hands clasped together] Pride@ on his right front biceps, AA4L@ on his back left biceps, AA.M.@ and a series of Armenian letters or numerals and AArmenia@ and a panther on his left arm. Martirosyan is 19, 5'5" and 125 pounds.

Walentina Knappek (Felony Theft, Larceny) B Knappek is wanted in seven states for theft and larceny charges. Knappek poses as a deaf mute and performs a till-tap scheme in which she gestures to the cashier to give her change for a bill. Knappek then starts making noises, grunts and point to the register drawer, and removes handfuls of \$20 and \$50 dollar bills. Knappek appears to put the money back, but the cashier is confused and unable to communicate so Knappek takes advantage of the situation by palming wads of cash. By the time the cashier figures out that she=s been had, Knappek is long gone. Knappek has been arrested for till-tapping in Maryland, new Jersey and South Carolina. She fools authorities as to her identity by using one of more than forty aliases, including: Maria Antoska, Maria Antonesko, Lidia Czevsna, Krystena Dolinska, Dorothy Evans, Elki Hoffman, Minnie Howell, Minnie MacHowell, Christina Idcago, Maria Lee, Drobna Kanu, Elizabeth Kemenski, Walentna Kwiek, Christina Kofflske, Ros Korolski, Rose Kovolske, Ros Kowalska, Zosia Kropinska, Valentina Kwick, Walentina Kwick, Cica Lee, Lula Lee, Maria Lipinska, Krystyna Madzian, Virginia Nilson, Kristian Moaziar, Ksali Rli, Patty Geno Roznowska, Marta Starzewska, Glory Tainkow, Gloria Tycoon... By the time police figure out that Knappek is a career criminal spanning the Northeast, she has already posted bond and disappeared. She has been positively identified as the main suspect in several till-tapping incidents, many caught on surveillance tape, and reportedly committed by a deaf mute woman. Knappek is wanted for theft in Connecticut, Illinois, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and Wisconsin. Knappek frequently changes her hair color. She has a prominent nose, a large mole on her right cheek, and a heavy European accent. She often wears long skirts and aprons with big pockets. She may have an accomplice, a 20-30-year old female with dark hair who may be a relative. Knappek is 47, 5'3" and 150 pounds.

Miguel J. Valerio (Murder) B Valerio is wanted by the Queens police department for the September 5, 1998 murder of 32-year-old Frank O=Laughlin. On that night, Valerio, a busboy, and O=Laughlin, a patron at the Mad Ass Tavern on 43rd Street in Queens, argued over O=Laughlin=s girlfriend, Rosemarie Gordon, a barmaid. Valerio left the bar and returned to his nearby apartment. He told his live-in girlfriend that he needed to protect his boss and that he wouldn=t be around for a while. Valerio returned to work and waited for the bar to clear. At approximately 2:25am O=Laughlin got up from his seat and walked into the tavern=s bathroom. Valerio followed him, then shot him one time in the back of the head with a .45. Valerio immediately left the bar. The gun was never recovered. Valerio, whose nickname is AMiguelito@, has also used the surname Caro. He likes to work on cars, and has worked as a handyman. He had a baby in his native Dominican Republic with a 15-year-old girlfriend. Valerio is 30, 5'8" and 180 pounds.

Theodore W. White (Statutory Rape, Child Molestation, Sex Charges) B on February 19, 1999 a Jackson County, Missouri jury found Theodore ATed@ White guilty of one count of statutory rape, five counts of child molestation, six counts of statutory sodomy, and one count of furnishing pornographic materials to minors. For years, Ted White sexually abused his 13-year-old stepdaughter, Jami White. She testified to the court and to child protective services that her stepfather molested her at least once on a Lake Ozarks outing. She also stated that Ted White raped her when she was less than twelve years old. Jami finally told her mother what her stepfather had done to her in March of 1998 and the case went into the legal system. After the jury returned the guilty verdicts, together with sentences totally 224 years, Ted White never appeared in court again. His bond was raised, but with the help of his family, he was released within a couple of days and has not been seen since. There was a confirmed sighting of White in Hot Springs, Arkansas, but he skipped town before he could be apprehended. The next confirmed sighting was in Pensacola, Florida where he was working as an investigator for an insurance company. Again, he fled. The last known sighting was in North Daytona Beach, Florida. Ted White=s identifying mark is a mole near his penis. He is known to frequent strip clubs and casinos. White is 37, 6'2" and 275 pounds.

AJunior@ (Murder)

ADavid@ (Murder) B Two unknown men are wanted for questioning in the 1999 murders of Diana Lynn Algar and Jose Julian Molina in Wapwallopen, Pennsylvania. On Monday July 19, 1999 the bodies of Diana Algar and her friend Jose Molina were found in Algar=s trailer. The two had been shot, execution style. Various items, including a stereo, had been stolen from the trailer. Written on the wall in mascara were the letters CFH. Algar=s light blue 1987 Dodge 600 with Pennsylvania plate BXE 4817 is missing. A witness at the campground told police she saw two young men with Algar the day before. She also provided the only names for the two that she remembered, David and Junior. The investigation led police to a truck stop on Rte. 80, where surveillance video caught the two men asking a clerk about finding a ride to Georgia just moments before Algar is seen approaching the same counter.

AJunior@ is described as tall with a muscular build and shoulder-length hair that is shaved underneath. He was wearing a Cleveland Indians baseball cap. He may be carrying a wallet with a chain on it. He smokes Marlboro cigarettes. He may have a two-year-old son. AJunior@ is approximately 20 and 5'9". ADavid@ has a thin build and a buzz cut. He has either a tribal band or barbed wire tattoo. His left nipple is pierced with a neon green tomahawk. He was wearing a shirt with a Cleveland Indians logo on it and black Nike sneakers. He smokes Camel cigarettes. He may have a one-year-old son. ADavid@ is approximately 21, but may be younger, and 5'7"-5'8". Following the last broadcast, a tip led to the recovery of Diana Algar=s stolen car in Winchester, Virginia. Police believe the car may have been in the area since July 19, 1999. Tipsters have also informed authorities that after abandoning the car, the pair took a bus to Georgia. (See Shows #551 and #552, OADs 7/24/99 and 7/31/99)

Richard Alan Minsky (Rape, Extortion, Fraud, Sexual Assault, Probation Violations) B Richard Minsky is wanted on charges of rape, sexual assault, extortion and fraud. He is accused of conning women at random over the phone by pretending to be the victim=s husband or friend. Minsky allegedly does two different voices on the phone, one being the husband or friend, the other being the husband=s or friend=s attorney. The Aattorney@ tells the victim that their loved one was involved in a hit and run accident and the victim must meet with the witness to prevent the witness from pressing charges. The victim is instructed to get money and to dress sexy, then to meet the Awitness@ at a public place such as an airport or hotel lobby. From there Minsky allegedly takes the money, sometimes fondles the woman and in a few cases has been accused of rape. Minsky has been convicted of extortion in the past and his long criminal record dates back to 1962. Authorities believe Minsky has victimized hundreds of women over the years. Minsky has thinning hair and wears very thick glasses. He has a Boston accent. He chain-smokes Marlboro cigarettes, and is often seen at public telephones. Minsky is 55, 5'7" and 145 pounds. Since the original broadcast, Minsky has also been linked to similar crimes in Washington, D.C. (See Show #552, OAD 7/31/99)

CAPTURED:

Dennis Ronald Scott (aka Jimmy Ronald Turner (Murder)) -- Shavawn Geoghegan was a street-smart teenager who had come home. After running away with her boyfriend to Tennessee, she realized her mistake, and came home to Santa Monica, California to reunite with her parents. But the street didn't let go, and she started hanging out with a group of teenage runaways whose lives center around the trendy 3rd Street Promenade and the abandoned buildings just a few blocks away. Her group of friends had an informal leader - 19-year-old Jason Ballis, a runaway from Texas. Smart, cunning, and devious, he established a squat for his ragtag followers in Santa Monica, complete with booby traps and passwords. As Shavawn spent more time with this group, she and Ballis started dating - friends say that the two were deeply in love. Ballis' alleged right-hand man was called Linus, because of the blanket he always carried like the comic strip character. The squatters remember Linus as a junkie afraid of his own shadow, and clearly afraid of Ballis. But not to afraid, they say, to hang on his every word and follow his every whim. His previous arrest record gives his name as Jimmy Turner, but police are unsure now if gave a false name and identity. Standing out among the teenage squatters was "Chaz," a young woman with a strong will. Also an alleged devoted follower of Ballis, Chaz was described by fellow squatters as a pagan with a strong dislike for Shavawn. Ballis told Shavawn that he was trying to get a job, but needed to leave employers a contact address and a phone number. Shavawn was happy to help, and her parents, taking a new interest in her life and circle of friends, opened their doors to the homeless Ballis. They say Ballis was always polite and pretended to be devoted to Shavawn, but while he was using her address, he was reportedly dating one of her close friends. Shavawn and Ballis were on a romantic roller coaster, breaking up and getting back together, until finally, Shavawn told him to get lost. At that point, as she reportedly told her father, Ballis turned mean, threatening her life and demonstrating his ruthlessness by strangling a rabbit in an impromptu satanic ritual. Finally, one day she told her father she was headed to the store. She laced up her boots, and walked out the door, never to be seen alive again. Hours later, her worried father began combing the squats of Santa Monica, looking for a sign. When he found her boots in an abandoned building, he knew that her life had ended. Shavawn was found by the Santa Monica police in an abandoned clinic. She had been strangled and wrapped in a sleeping bag. Ballis and Chaz were arrested hours later, and police found Shavawn's butterfly knife on Ballis. Their investigation has led them to believe that Turner was also an accomplice to Shavawn's murder, but he is nowhere to be found. Police say Turner used the name Jimmy Ronald Turner and the 8/7/75 birthdate when he was arrested prior to the homicide in Santa Monica. After his release, friends say Turner later bragged that he had given police a false name and date of birth. Police are not certain of his true identity. Turner, an alleged drug user, has scraggly facial hair and may wear prescription glasses with cracked lens. He has a pierced left nipple with a hoop and tattoos of a band on his arm, eyes on his chest, and a dagger on his right biceps. He allegedly participates in Satanic rituals, possibly including animal dismemberment. His home town and real name are not known by police, but he is believed to be from Tucson, Arizona. Turner allegedly commits petty crimes to survive on the streets. He dresses in a grungy, "punk" style. Turner is 23, 6'1" and 125 pounds. Several tipsters had confirmed sightings of Turner in Tempe, Arizona. Additional tips led authorities to a cemetery in North Carolina, where they found a tombstone bearing the name AJames Steven Turner@, who died in 1997. However, this clearly wasn't the man authorities are seeking. The real Jimmy Turner died in a car accident. ALinus@ was identified as a skateboarding buddy of the real Turner, named Dennis Ronald Scott. New clues led police to Birmingham, Alabama, where Scott apparently changed his street name from ALinus@ to AThorn@. A shoplifting incident led to a nearby apartment where Thorn was living. When Birmingham police burst into the apartment, they found the walls covered with Satanic graffiti B but no Thorn. Neighbors told police they had missed their man by less than five minutes. A short while later, Thorn was spotted in the Five Points neighborhood, where he was captured. (See Shows #493, # 522 and #547, OADs 5/2/98, 12/19/98 and 6/19/99)

Dick Tracy Beginning in September, the artists who create the classic Dick Tracy cartoon strip will use the strip and Crimestoppers to profile actual criminals, including Eric Rudolph, Osama Bin Laden, and Victor Gerena:

Eric Robert Rudolph (Causing the Death of a Person, Use of an Explosive) -- It's hunting season in the Great Smokey Mountains and there's a price on the head of Eric Robert Rudolph. The FBI doesn't want anyone to shoot their most wanted man, but they are asking hunters to look for trash left behind by the accused abortion clinic bomber. Agents in Murphy, North Carolina put together a sampling of trash they say they've found abandoned by Rudolph. They're asking the thousands of hunters in the area to keep their eyes peeled for Rudolph clues. The woodsman has been burying his trash in an attempt to hide it, but it hasn't worked. Back in the summer, agents actually fingerprinted some of the trash they found and confirmed that it belonged to Rudolph. Inspired by the million-dollar reward, bounty hunters have descended on the area as well, but no one wants to see Rudolph behind bars more than Felicia Sanderson, a widow and mother of two. Her husband, Officer Robert "Sandy" Sanderson was killed by a bomb placed outside a women's clinic in Birmingham, Alabama - a bomb agents say was planted by Rudolph. It took guts, but Felicia traveled to the Smokey Mountains where her husband's killer is believed to be hiding out. She went there to lend her support to the hundreds of investigators working the case. She even used a

local radio broadcast to send her plea to the community. Felicia knows that some groups sympathize with Rudolph on political grounds - that they say he was doing "God's work." In response, she doesn't mince words: "God didn't have anything to do with murdering Sandy. Eric Rudolph done that all by himself." Agents say that Eric Robert Rudolph was seen on January 29, 1998, fleeing the scene of the bombing of the New Woman All Women Clinic in Birmingham, Alabama. Immediately after the bomb went off, witnesses saw a man wearing a wig running from the site. Three witnesses saw his truck pull away, and were able to provide a description and a license plate number. The truck was traced to Rudolph, but he had already made his escape. Agents say Rudolph's bomb was loaded with nails - a bomb designed not just to damage property, but to kill and maim. It did both: Birmingham Police Officer Robert "Sandy" Sanderson lost his life. Nurse Emily Lyons was severely injured by the homemade shrapnel - she lost her left eye, lost some of the sight in her right eye, and suffered several broken bones and burns. Despite speculation that Rudolph has been close to extremist groups, friends of Officer Sanderson can't view his death as part of a political action. Even though Sanderson was moonlighting as a security guard for a family planning clinic, they say he was outside of the abortion controversy - that he was just doing his job: enforcing the law. Rudolph is also wanted for questioning in a series of deadly Atlanta bombings: the 1996 Centennial Olympic Park bombing that killed one and injured more than one hundred others, an attack on an abortion clinic in January 1997 that injured seven, and a February 1997 attack on a gay nightclub. Authorities confirmed that they are investigating similarities in the construction of Rudolph's alleged bomb and the others. In particular, they're investigating a possible match between the nails in the Birmingham bomb and those in the Atlanta bombs. Rudolph has been described as a mysterious and reclusive man from the rugged mountains of North Carolina. Rudolph's truck was found in a pasture near Murphy, North Carolina on February 7, 1998. Though agents believe it's likely that he's taken to the wilderness to hide, they're confident that the \$1 million price on his head will make it hard for Rudolph to hide for long. Authorities also note similarities to Rudolph's known techniques in the bombing of an abortion clinic in Asheville, North Carolina on March 13, 1999. Rudolph, who has used the alias Bob Randolph, has worked as a carpenter and spent 18 months in the U. S. Army. He has a reputation for anti-government views. He is estranged from family. He is an experienced woodsman and completed army survival training. Rudolph is 32, 5'11" and 150 pounds. Osama Bin Laden (Conspiracy to Murder, Murder, Destruction of a Federal Facility) -- According to the Federal Bureau of Investigations, Osama Bin Laden, Awith others known and unknown@, has been charged with the August 7, 1998 bombings of the U.S. Embassies in Kenya and Tanzania. These attacks killed more than 220 people and seriously injured 5,000 men, women and children. Authorities say Osama Bin Laden is the leader of AAl Qaeda@, a world-wide terrorist organization, with many members. In an indictment by the U.S. Attorney's Office handed down in November of 1998, it is alleged that Bin Laden, through al Qaeda, issues Afatwahs@, urging members and associates to target U.S. facilities and personnel around the world. The U.S. Government is offering a reward of up to \$5 million dollars for information leading to the arrest or conviction of Bin Laden. Bin Laden sometimes spells his first name AUsama@. He wears a beard and mustache, and speaks Arabic and poor English. Bin Laden is 42 and 6'5". (See Shows #531 and #546, OADs 2/27/99 and 6/12/99)

Victor Manuel Gerena (Bank Robbery, Armed Robbery) B Gerena, one of the FBI's Ten Most Wanted, is wanted for the 1983 robbery of a Wells Fargo armored truck depot in West Hartford, Connecticut. On September 12, 1983 Gerena took two of his fellow Wells Fargo employees hostage and escaped with \$7 million. Gerena pulled a gun, tied up his hostages, and injected them with a substance to make them sleep. Gerena loaded the money into a rented Buick and fled to Massachusetts. The FBI says Gerena was recruited and trained for the robbery by Los Macheteros, a violent Puerto Rican independence movement. The Macheteros moved Gerena through Texas to Mexico in a trailer, then sent him to Cuba. An FBI investigation into the robbery led to the indictment of nineteen alleged Macheteros. One was acquitted, four pled guilty, and in April 1989 four more were found guilty. Gerena has used the alias Victor Ortiz. He speaks English with a marked accent. He has a one-inch scar and a mole on his right shoulder blade. He has strikingly green eyes and wears wire-rimmed prescription glasses. He wears his hair combed straight back with no part, and can grow only a sparse mustache. He drinks lots of strong coffee. Gerena has precise, meticulous handwriting and dresses very neatly. He was a paralegal assistant at the Puerto Rican Center for Justice in Hartford, and enjoys watching TV news and discussing politics. He has also worked as a machinist, truck driver, security guard, concessionaire, playground worker, and as an aide at the state capitol. He lifts weights, jogs, and plays racquetball. Gerena is 41, 5'6" and 170 pounds.

Sammy Ellis Jones (Escape, Kidnapping, Robbery) B The Kansas Department of Corrections issued a warrant for the arrest of inmate Sammy Ellis Jones, who escaped from his work assignment in a private industry work program in Leavenworth, Kansas on Friday, August 6, 1999. Jones was committed to the KDOC on January 16, 1991 after he was convicted of three counts of kidnapping and one count of aggravated robbery. Jones was sentenced to twenty years to life by a Johnson County District court. At the time of his sentencing, Jones was considered dangerous. However, at the time of his escape he was classified as a minimum custody inmate. He may be traveling in a red four-door Isuzu Rodeo with Kansas plate MZU 052. Jones is 36, 6'1" and 215 pounds.

Adrian Rosales (Aggravated Kidnapping, Child Molestation) B Rosales is wanted for aggravated kidnapping by police in San Antonio, Texas and for Indecency with a Child by police in Tyler, Texas. On Friday 13, 1999 Rosales tried to kidnap a 10-year-old girl from a local hotel. He hit the child over the head with a steel pipe and tried to stuff her into a five-foot-long duffle bag. The little girl was able to free herself and run for help. The girl=s uncle chased Rosales and was able to detain him until police arrived. Rosales was arrested, bonded out and disappeared. In the meantime, police in Tyler executed a search warrant on Rosales=s residence and started looking into recent indecency cases. A 12-year-old victim picked Rosales out of a photo lineup as the person who had fondled her in March of 1999. Rosales trained as a manager for Luby=s restaurant. He speaks fluent English and Spanish. Rosales is 24, 5'10" and 210 pounds.

Danny Glen Vanek (Child Molestation) B Danny Vanek is wanted for the 1997 molestation of his girlfriend=s daughter in Sacramento, California. In November of 1997, when Vanek molested the six-year-old girl for the second time, she got up the courage to tell her mother. Vanek was subsequently arrested and charged with Lewd and Lascivious Acts with a Child under 14. Vanek failed to appear for his trial. Before he vanished, Vanek made a large purchase of camping equipment from a Sacramento area store. His car was last seen on May 29, 1998 on Interstate 80 in Wyoming between the towns of Cheyenne and Pinebluff. Vanek is very attached to his St. Bernard named AMoose@, and rarely separated from the dog. In November of 1998, Vanek, an avid Internet user, made an inquiry on the web into housing availability on the island of Guam for himself and his dog. Vanek has scars on his abdomen and left hand. He and AMoose@ may be traveling in a silver and black 1983 Chevrolet Suburban with California vanity plate 2MYDOG. Although Vanek may currently be using drugs, AMoose@ doesn=t like alcohol in his presence. Vanek has had formal training as a big rig truck driver, laborer, and plumber. Authorities say he has a violent temper and should be considered armed and dangerous. Vanek is 33, 5'11" and 145 pounds.
