The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Stanley A. Lacefield (Felonious Assault, Child Endangering)

Cicily K. Mason (Permitting Child Abuse) -- On September 24, 1999 a ten-year-old boy was found wandering the street outside his apartment in Dayton, Ohio. He was severely injured, wearing only his pants and a blanket to cover his shoulders. A woman happened to see him, and she approached him and asked him if he needed help. He asked her to please bring him to the hospital. On the way to the hospital the victim asked the woman if she would be his new mom and take him home with her. The boy made her promise that she would not leave him. Dayton police officers were called to the hospital, and the boy told them how his stepfather, Stanley Lacefield, had been abusing him. Lacefield beat the boy with a hammer, twisted his ears with pliers, blacked his eyes, immersed him in scalding hot water and freezing cold water, hit him over the head with a brush, and countless other offenses. The boy was made to sleep in the kitchen cupboard and his stepfather threatened to kill on the day he beat the boy over the head with a hammer. On September 24th, the victim was able to escape from the apartment, but he has a sister and a five-month-old baby brother who are believed to be with Stanley Lacefield and Cicily Mason (the boy=s biological mother). Upon further investigation, police officers learned that Lacefield had done this before. Lacefield has charges against him for battering his children and stepchildren in Little Rock, Arkansas. Evidently, Lacefield fled Little Rock when the charges were filed and started over in Dayton, Ohio. Thankfully, the ten-year-old victim is doing as well as can be expected. Stanley Lacefield and his wife, Cicily Mason, are nowhere to be found. They took off with 8-year-old Brittany Nicole Mason and 6-month-old Stanley Lacefield, Jr. More than likely, these children are in danger. Lacefield has used the alias Victor Blackman. He is a heavy drinker, and uses both crack and marijuana. He hangs out at homeless shelters. He may be working as a maintenance man in an apartment building. Lacefield is 35, 6'0" and 150 pounds. Mason has used the aliases Cicily K Jones, Stacy Love, and Cicely K. Burks. She is 25, 5'6" and 155 pounds.

Adrian Rosales (Aggravated Kidnapping, Child Molestation) B Rosales is wanted for aggravated kidnapping by police in San Antonio, Texas and for Indecency with a Child by police in Tyler, Texas. On Friday 13, 1999 Rosales tried to kidnap a 10-year-old girl from a local hotel. He hit the child over the head with a steel pipe and tried to stuff her into a five-foot-long duffle bag. The little girl was able to free herself and run for help. The girl=s uncle chased Rosales and was able to detain him until police arrived. Rosales was arrested, bonded out and disappeared. In the meantime, police in Tyler executed a search warrant on Rosales= residence and started looking into recent indecency cases. A 12-year-old victim picked Rosales out of a photo lineup as the person who had fondled her in March of 1999. Rosales trained as a manager for Luby=s restaurant. He speaks fluent English and Spanish. Rosales is 24, 5'10" and 210 pounds. (See Show #554, OAD 8/21/99)

Chaka Raysor (Murder, Racketeering, Conspiracy, Drug Charges) -- Chaka Raysor is wanted by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and the United States Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of New York for murder, racketeering, and conspiracy to distribute crack cocaine. In 1985, investigators say Raysor and his brother Umeme formed a ruthless drug gang in their Bedford-Stuyvesant neighborhood of Brooklyn. At its peak, agents say the organization raked in over \$90,000 a week dealing crack cocaine in Brooklyn, Maryland, Delaware, and Norfolk, Virginia. The federal indictment also charges Chaka Raysor with a total of nine murders. But agents believe the Raysor organization committed more than forty homicides during their ten-year reign of terror. On the streets of Brooklyn, the gang was known as "The Killers". Agents say Raysor mesmerized his gang members with fiery, Black Panther-style rhetoric, and maintained their loyalty with an iron fist. they say during their reign of terror the ruthless Raysor gang murdered innocent local residents, rival drug dealers, landlords, and a homeless man. On April 27, 1998 Umeme Raysor was convicted of federal racketeering, narcotics conspiracy and murder charges, but his brother Chaka remains at large. Chaka Raysor has used the aliases Charles Herbert Raysor, and the nicknames "Chik", "Chak", and "C". He is usually heavily armed, and is skilled in martial arts. Raysor has a stocky, powerful build, close-cropped hair and a beard, and a glass left eye with a scar underneath. He is described as ruthless, manipulative, charismatic, and extremely violent. Raysor is 30, 5'10" and 200 pounds. (See Shows #517, #535 and #559, OADs 11/7/98, 3/27/99 and 9/25/99)

Unknown (Murder) B Police in Chicago are looking for a serial killer. They say one man is responsible for the deaths of six women and the sexual assault of another. They also believe that two other women may have died at the hands of this unknown male. The women were all killed within an eight block area along 51 Street. They were found in abandoned buildings, strangled and raped. The majority of them were also beaten and stabbed. They were all crack addicts and prostitutes. The killing spree started in 1995 with the last victim being

found in June of 1999. The lone survivor of these attacks was able to tell police the suspect is a black male wearing a blue hooded jogging sweatshirt and navy blue pants with dirty tennis shoes. The suspect has a small frame and generally has the appearance of a bum or street person. The suspect may be 30-40 and 5'9"-5'10".

Trig Colin Lewis (Kidnapping) B Police in Seattle have issued an arrest warrant for Trig Colin Lewis, who kidnapped his son, Ryan James Lewis, during a scheduled supervised visit on July 31, 1999. Trig is Ryan=s non-custodial parent. Family members believe Trig took Ryan and may be living in some type of motor home or camper in Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Utah or Arizona. Trig has been known to venture into Mexico via Arizona. Trig is known to have dealings with militia-type groups, and authorities fear for Ryan=s safety. Trig Lewis has used the aliases Craig Lewis, David L. Smith, Craig Thomas, David Lewis, Craig Smith, Craig Mason and Joseph Smith. He is overweight and may appear unshaven, barefoot and dirty. He has a capped top front tooth, and breathes very heavily due to health problems. He frequents surplus auctions and repairs wrecked cars for resale. Trig Lewis is 35, 6'3" and 300 pounds. Ryan Lewis is described as a kindhearted, smart boy who is good at math and reading. He has a small brown mole on the upper right side of his nose, two small brown moles on the top outer side of his left hand just below the base of his little finger, and a one-inch linear scar on his right forearm. He enjoys playing computer games, building with Legos, watching war movies, and outdoor activities. His father may have changed his name to Bryan, James or Seth. Ryan Lewis is 7, 4'0" and 50 pounds.

James Allen Kinney (Homicide, Sexual Assault) -- Kinney is wanted for the brutal murder of 20 year-old Keri Sherlock, whose body was discovered on Mount Baker, Washington. On October 2, 1998, Keri Sherlock left her aunt 's house to go hiking when she met up with James Allen Kinney. A bank surveillance video shows Keri accompanying Kinney to a local bank. Then, police say, they went out to dinner and over to Kinney 's employer 's home, under the guise of trying to gain Keri employment. In the early morning hours of October 3, the two were later caught on a casino surveillance video in Bellingham, Washington. On Sunday afternoon, October 4, 1998, while camping on Mount Baker, two Canadian teenagers discovered Keri Sherlock 's body. Kinney was last seen on Mount Baker on October 3, wading in a mountain stream and walking back down the mountain towards town. Kinney, who falsely claims to be the heir to the Kinney Shoe fortune, takes lithium for bipolar manic depressive condition, and frequents insane asylums and Veteran Hospitals. He claims to have been married eight times and widowed four times. He has been known to use the alias Jerome Romano Porrovecchio. Although he acts grandiose, he works as a laborer, usually for a mowing and lawn service, drinks cheap beer and smokes. He may wear glasses and/or a baseball cap. Kinney is 50, 5'9" and 190 pounds. Celestino ADanny@ Payan (Child Molestation, Rape) B Payan is wanted by the San Bernardino, California sheriff=s department for the 1998 molestation and rape of his neighbor. On December 4, 1998 Payan=s 15-year-old neighbor went to the hospital for excessive vomiting and was found to be pregnant. She revealed that Payan got her pregnant by forcibly raping her. Police then arrested Payan. The next day he bailed out of jail and disappeared. The police made several unsuccessful attempts to find him to get a blood sample. His wife, from whom he is separated, said that he was accused several years prior of molesting another young girl. Follow-up on that information showed that a complaint was filed in Pasadena for fondling a 12-year-old. Late in January a confidential informant called the investigating detective and said that Payan admitted to him/her and their spouse that he indeed did rape his 15-year-old neighbor. It was then learned that Payan may have fled to Spain, and Interpol was contacted. Interpol has said that he has not entered Spain under his given name. In February the victim also admitted that Payan had been molesting her since the 5th grade and forcibly raping her since the 7th grade. Also, searches of two of his properties uncovered meth lab dumps, which the narcotics division would like to question Payan about. In March a \$5 million arrest warrant was issued as well as a warrant from the FBI. Evidence of phone records and mail could place Payan in Spain, Nigeria or Brazil. A new lead may place Payan in the Long Beach, California area. Payan has used the aliases Danny Tarango and Tarango Payan. He speaks English as well as Spanish. He could be wearing wigs or dying his hair. He may describe himself as a doctor, considers himself an herbalist and treats people with herbal medicines. He once owned an upholstery business, and may be working as a carpenter or handyman. He collects Acollectible@ dolls. Payan is 65, 5'11" and 195 pounds.

Mauro Valenzuela (Contempt of Court, Perjury) B Former airplane mechanic Valenzuela has been charged with mislabeling and mishandling oxygen canisters that were loaded onto a 1996 Valujet flight that crashed in the Everglades, killing 110 people. Valenzuela was indicted and ordered to appear at the Atlanta offices of pretrial services until his trial date in November. He failed to appear on August 27, 1999 and has been on the run ever since. Valenzuela was last seen in Atlanta, where he has family. He usually wears a goatee, but may have shaved it off. Valenzuela has also been charged in Dekalb County, Georgia for auto theft. The feds believe he could be driving a 1986 grey Honda Accord with Georgia license plate 662RBR. Valenzuela has used the aliases Mauro Reyes, Mauro Rey and Reyes Mauro. Valenzuela is 30, 6'0" and 170 pounds.

Tonya Nicole Dice (Homicide) B Pennsylvania police are looking for Tonya Dice, who is wanted for the January 1995 murder of Freddie Brumfield and for questioning in the murder of a Jane Doe in March of 1995. Dice moved to Chambersburg, Pennsylvania to work as a

prostitute and drug runner for her boyfriend, who was also her pimp. She also began socializing with a small-time crack dealer, Freddie Brumfield. On January 13, 1995 Brumfield=s body was found in an open field. Dice was eventually interviewed regarding the murder of Brumfield and revealed that she was present at the time of his death. She also revealed the name of the person who killed him. A short time later Dice was arrested on unrelated drug charges. Dice made bail and has not been seen since. Now police also want to question Dice about the murder of a Jane Doe. In March the murdered body of a female was found in the Chambersburg, Pennsylvania area. Investigators believe the body was there for approximately six to twelve months. At first investigators thought the body may have been that of Tonya Dice. However, forensic evidence proved that this was not Dice. Now police believe Tonya Dice may know the identity of this Jane Doe and would like to question her about this murder. Dice has a scar on her left ear. She goes by the nicknames ASnow@ or ASnowy@. She is a known prostitute and drug dealer. Dice is 26, 5'9" and 165 pounds. The unidentified Jane Doe had shoulder-length bleached blonde hair, artificial red fingernails, and an appendectomy scar. She also had a healed laceration on her left thigh. She was wearing a tan button-down shirt with the words AHook and Tackle@ on it. Jane Doe was in her late teens to early thirties, 5'3" and 130 pounds.(See Show #558, OAD 9/18/99)

Jose Luis Rios (Murder)

Jorge Mendez (Murder) -- Rios and Mendez are wanted for the 1995 murder of 19-year-old Kristie Martin. Harris County, Texas sheriffs say that at 8:00pm on December 23, 1995 Kirstie Martin, Wendy Wright, Sal and Joe Barrera went out to dinner at the Trail Dust Steak House. At 11:30pm the four drove to River Terrace Park in Sal Barrera=s blue Chevy Beretta. Wendy and Joe remained in the back seat while Kristie and Sal exited the vehicle. After a short time a red 1974/5 Chevrolet pickup truck with two occupants, believed to be Jose Rios and Jorge Mendez, drove toward them. The passenger yelled, AHey you, come here.@ Kristie told Sal, AWe better get out of here.@ Sal assisted Kristie into the passenger side of the Beretta and he rounded the vehicle to enter the driver=s side. At that moment one of the pickup=s occupants shot five rounds from an SKS assault weapon. Neither Sal nor Joe Barrera were injured. Wendy Wright was shot in the leg. Kristie Martin was shot through the back and died before an ambulance could arrive. Sal Barrera identified the truck as one owned by Jorge Mendez, and identified both Mendez and Rios out of police mug shots. Rios had purchased the SKS assault rifle legally a few weeks before the incident. Rios and Mendez are reportedly members of Los Cholos, a large gang out of Harris County, Texas. Both men are believed to travel back and forth between Texas and Mexico. Rios has two teardrops tattooed under his left eye, a box cross on a finger of his left hand (although he may have had the box cross colored in), and a skull and dagger on his right forearm. He may also have a rosary tattoo on his left wrist. His nickname is

AFlaco@. Rios may be working as a day laborer, and may be dealing in both drugs and guns. Rios is 23, 5'7" and 140 pounds. Mendez is 27, 5'3" and 160 pounds. (See Shows #1007 , #1008 and #477, OADs 12/21/96, 1/4/97 and 12/13/97)

Hazel Leota Head (Murder, Arson) -- Hazel Leota Head is wanted for the murder of Charles Barker on September 2, 1998 in Benton, Louisiana. Barker was shot in the back of the head as he sat at his trailer counter. Police found a murder weapon and say physical evidence points to Hazel Head. Hazel had met Barker at a local casino under the name Deiana Ray. She subsequently moved in with him. When Barker=s body was found, his cash and his car were gone. Upon further investigation, police found that there was an outstanding warrant for Hazel=s arrest in Nebraska, where she is accused of burning down a boyfriend=s trailer. Police also learned that Hazel has a history of moving around. She has been married multiple times, to as many as ten different men. She has lived all across the country. Head has many aliases, including Hazel Morgan, Willow Shields, Hazel Foley, Kelly Morgan, Hazel Spurbeck, Hazel Haynes, Hazel Vincent, Deiana Ray, Hazel Woodman, Hazel Fautch, Treasa ATess@ Jean Coyle, and Treasa ATess@ Venable. She has a noticeable gap between her front teeth. She is a smoker and drinker, favoring vodka. She often works as a waitress, and hangs out a truck stops, often traveling with truckers. She frequents casinos and places personal ads looking for men. A truck driver believes the woman he picked up in Madisonville, Kentucky and drove to a truck stop in Woodhaven, Michigan was Head. The woman told the trucker she was trying to get to Las Vegas. Head is 49, 5'2" and 120 pounds. (See Shows #527, #528 , #533 and #545, OADs 1/30/99, 2/6/99, 3/13/99 and 6/5/99)

CAPTURED:

William Joseph Cerra, Jr. (Rape of a Child) B Deputies in Pennsylvania are looking for child rapist William Cerra. Cerra is wanted for the rape of a 14-year-old girl and for the intimidation of a witness in another rape case. He raped the girl while she was riding in his cab in January of 1995. He became a fugitive on August 30, 1996 when he failed to appear for his trial on both cases. Cerra has two prior arrests for rape and used his job as a cab driver to lure victims. An alert AMW viewer spotted Cerra as the man who made sandwiches at a Palm Beach market -- directly across from a police station. He was arrested without incident. (See Show #557, OAD 9/11/99)

Danny Glen Vanek (Child Molestation) B Danny Vanek is wanted for the 1997 molestation of his girlfriend=s daughter in Sacramento, California. In November of 1997, when Vanek molested the six-year-old girl for the second time, she got up the courage to tell her

mother. Vanek was subsequently arrested and charged with Lewd and Lascivious Acts with a Child under 14. Vanek failed to appear for his trial. Before he vanished, Vanek made a large purchase of camping equipment from a Sacramento area store. His car was last seen on May 29, 1998 on Interstate 80 in Wyoming between the towns of Cheyenne and Pinebluff. Vanek is very attached to his St. Bernard named AMoose@, and rarely separated from the dog. In November of 1998, Vanek, an avid Internet user, made an inquiry on the web into housing availability on the island of Guam for himself and his dog. Vanek got a job with a logging company in the Sierra mountains of California. However, viewer tips immediately following the initial broadcast led to Vanek=s capture. (See Show #554, OAD 8/21/99)

Kenneth Marquise Tucker (Armed Robbery) B Kenneth Marquise Tucker is wanted by the Caln Township, Pennsylvania police department for a number of charges related to and including armed robbery. At approximately 1:35pm on March 2, 1999 Tucker entered the First National Bank of Malvern, where he displayed a black semi-automatic pistol and stole \$4,140. He then led authorities on a high-speed chase in a stolen car, which flipped three times during the pursuit. Tucker escaped, ran across four lanes of traffic and was hit by an oncoming car. Tucker disappeared near the Philadelphia area and continues to elude authorities. Beside armed robbery, Tucker is wanted by nearly eight other townships for purse snatching and other related crimes. When hiding in Ohio, an acquaintance of Tucker=s saw his scrapbook B he kept newspaper clippings and wanted posters of himself B and alerted authorities. (See Show #552, OAD 7/31/99)

IDENTIFIED:

Michael Rainey B The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department is trying to find the killer(s) of a young individual they found near electrical power lines on November 2, 1996. The individual=s skeletal remains were discovered by a man walking his dog in the area. The individual, whom they first named ATower Jane Doe@, had been shot in the head with a high caliber weapon and was buried in the ground at least six months before they found her. A forensic anthropologist first thought the individual was a female because of initial studies of the skeletal remains. But Vegas police sent the remains to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. They, in turn, brought in a forensic anthropologist from the Smithsonian=s Natural History Museum, and both agencies subsequently determined that ATower Jane Doe@ was actually a AJohn@. With that information, they used a computer to generate a reconstruction of what the victim may have looked like. Police think the victim had been bound and gagged before being shot. They found a knotted sock and duct tape along with the distinctive clothing.

Following the initial broadcast, an AMW viewer recognized the drawing as Michael Rainey. According to his parents, on August 20, 1996 Michael Rainey ran away from their Henderson, Nevada home. At first, they believed he was angry and would return. He did not. Through dental records, the Clark County, Nevada coroner=s office confirmed that Tower John Doe was indeed Michael Rainey. His killer is still at large. (See Show #546, OAD 6/12/99)

FINAL JUSTICE:

Lena Dianne Townsend (Murder) -- Lena Townsend is wanted for the 1998 murder of 4-year-old Karina Rowen in Piston, Tennessee. Sheriff=s deputies say that in the summer of 1998 Karina came to live with her grandfather Richard Townsend and his new wife Lena after the girl=s mother asked for some help. Neighbors and relatives say Lena Townsend was mean and yelled at the little girl a lot. On August 21, 1998 Richard came home from work around 4:30pm. Deputies say Lena told him that Karina was taking a nap. According to authorities, Lena later told her husband that Karina was fed and in bed asleep. The next morning Richard awoke and found a note from Lena say that she went to WalMart. Richard checked on Karina and found her dead in her bed. Deputies say that she died from blunt trauma to the head. Lena reportedly took \$8,000 and a loaded pump shotgun. She left in a dark brown 1985 Lincoln town car with Tennessee tags. The car was later found in Conway, Arkansas. Inside was a receipt from a local Motel 6, empty camping gear boxes, hair dye and a bagful of hair remnants. An AMW tipster who had seen Townsend working at a Denny=s restaurant in Scottsdale, Arizona alerted authorities. When the FBI raided the apartment where the tipster said Townsend was living, two young men who also worked at the restaurant were astonished to find that their coworker Myka, who shared their apartment with them, was Townsend. Townsend was extradited to Tennessee. Head plead guilty and was sentenced to life without the possibility of parole. (See Shows #529, #530 and #534, OADs 2/13/99, 2/20/99 and 3/20/99)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Terry Leon Boyd (Murder) B Police are looking for Terry Boyd in connection with the 1999 murder of Harold Ann East and is considered the prime suspect in the death of his step-grandmother Dorothy Redd. On Friday, October 1, 1999 D.C. police were summoned to the residence of 65-year-old Dorothy Redd by concerned relatives. At first police thought Redd, who had cancer, died from her illness. But as Redd=s body was being placed into the funeral home van, the body of her roommate and caretaker, Harold Ann East, was found in the basement. East was shot in the head and possibly sexually assaulted. Police were called back and declared the house a crime scene. Authorities say that upon further examination it was determined that Redd had been strangled and her death was ruled a homicide. Cops issued an arrest warrant for Terry Boyd in the murder of Harold Ann East. Boyd is considered the prime suspect in the murder of Dorothy Redd. Boyd, who recently had been dishonorably discharged from the army, was living with Redd for two months. Cops say theft and sexual assault are possible motives. Redd may wear glasses. He frequents bars. He was a unit supply specialist in the army, so he may be trying to get work as a stock or inventory clerk. He is known to carry weapons, and should be considered armed and dangerous. Boyd is 22, 5'7" and 130 pounds.

Dwain Alexander Lawes (Murder)

Unknown (Murder) B On January 11, 1999 at approximately 12:00pm four masked and heavily armed men robbed the Toronto Dominion Bank located in Brampton, Ontario, Canada. Five employees and two customers were assaulted during the robbery and Nancy Kidd, who worked for the bank for over 18 years, was shot and killed. Two of the parties involved in the robbery have been arrested and are not cooperating with police. Authorities are actively attempting to locate and apprehend the third party in the robbery, Dwain Alexander Lawes, as well as determine the identity of the fourth party. The Canadian Bankers Association has offered \$200,000 reward for information leading to the arrest of the remaining persons involved in the robbery and shooting. Lawes is a member of a gang responsible for a total of 19 robberies in the Toronto area including take-over style armed bank robberies, home invasions, and car-jackings. He has also participated in armed robberies in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. Lawes, who

uses the nicknames AChamps@, APrentice@ and AP@, speaks with a Jamaican accent. He is 25, 5'8" and 140 pounds. His unknown accomplice uses the nickname ABrown Man@. He is 19-20, 5'10", and 140-150 pounds.

Christopher Wayne Lippard (Murder) B Chris Lippard is wanted for the murder of six family members in Jackson Springs, North Carolina, on September 29, 1999, and a sixth man the week before in Alexander County, North Carolina. Lippard and Charles Roache had stolen a car from a man in their hometown of Statesville, North Carolina, and were looking for another car to steal on September 29. As they were attempting to steal a car from Earl Phillips at his home, they were interrupted by Phillips and his family, who were coming home from the county fair. Lippard and Roache allegedly shot the five family members and fled. They crashed their vehicle two miles down the road and slip up. Roache ran into a neighbor=s field, and was captured by him. Lippard stowed away on a tractor trailer and escaped. He may have taken a bus that goes through Charlotte, North Carolina, Montgomery and Mobile, Alabama, and New Orleans, Louisiana. Investigators then learned that the body of Chat Watt had been found in a creek near Roache=s home. Police believe that Roache, Lippard and Watt had been driving in Watt=s truck when they got into an argument and Roache and Lippard killed Watt. They have not yet been charged with that homicide. Lippard has scars on his face, right and left hands, and right leg. He has several tattoos, including a cross on his left leg, a rocket on his right leg, the words AMisfit School@ on the back of his left shoulder, and barbed wire around his right biceps. He was last seen in Newton, North Carolina with his friend Ricky Lynn Williams. He is known to hitch rides with truckers. His hair is medium length and dark. He may be carrying a shotgun. Lippard is 20, 165-200 pounds, and 6'-6'2".

Unknown (Murder) B Authorities are searching for the person responsible for killing 62-year-old Charles Marisco. Marisco, a retired school teacher and principal, was stabbed to death in his Lafayette, Louisiana apartment on July 5, 1999. He was stabbed 17 times. The killer then took off with Marisco=s credit card, ATM card and personal checks, and fled in his silver 1990 Chevrolet Geo Metro. After the murder, investigators tracked usage of Marisco=s ATM and credit card through Slidell, Louisiana; Pensacola, Florida; Bay Minette, Alabama; Carnesville, Georgia; even all the way to New York City, for purchases ranging from cigarettes to golf shirts. In the Pensacola, Florida instance, cops got a break when video cameras at Sammy=s Nightclub, a strip club, captured a white or Hispanic male using Marisco=s credit card and personal checks to buy drinks. Authorities now want to know who the man in the videotape is and what connection he has to the murder. A person who had originally been considered a suspect in the case, but was later cleared, told authorities that the person in the videotape appears to be Aa transient hustler named Billy@. The suspect was carrying a large duffel bag. Judging

by the credit card receipts, the suspect likes upscale restaurants, lounges, and nicer gentlemen=s clubs. The stolen Geo has Louisiana tags FYA 186. It has accident damage to the front, a blue stripe with the word AMetro@ down the sides, and ASeattle KGB@ in yellow letters on the driver=s side rear bumper. The suspect, ABilly@, is 25-35 years old, 5'6"-5'8" and 150-170 pounds.

Adrian Rosales (Aggravated Kidnapping, Child Molestation) B Rosales is wanted for aggravated kidnapping by police in San Antonio, Texas and for Indecency with a Child by police in Tyler, Texas. On Friday 13, 1999 Rosales tried to kidnap a 10-year-old girl from a local hotel. He hit the child over the head with a steel pipe and tried to stuff her into a five-foot-long duffle bag. The little girl was able to free herself and run for help. The girl=s uncle chased Rosales and was able to detain him until police arrived. Rosales was arrested, bonded out and disappeared. In the meantime, police in Tyler executed a search warrant on Rosales= residence and started looking into recent indecency cases. A 12-year-old victim picked Rosales out of a photo lineup as the person who had fondled her in March of 1999. Rosales trained as a manager for Luby=s restaurant. He speaks fluent English and Spanish. Rosales is 24, 5'10" and 210 pounds. Following the initial broadcast, viewer tips led authorities to a restaurant in Plano, Texas where Rosales had been working as a busboy, but once again Rosales eluded capture. Rosales= girlfriend and father have been arrested for aiding the fugitive. (See Shows #554 and #560, OADs 8/21/99 and 10/2/99)

Chaka Raysor (Murder, Racketeering, Conspiracy, Drug Charges) -- Chaka Raysor is wanted by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and the United States Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of New York for murder, racketeering, and conspiracy to distribute crack cocaine. In 1985, investigators say Raysor and his brother Umeme formed a ruthless drug gang in their Bedford-Stuyvesant neighborhood of Brooklyn. At its peak, agents say the organization raked in over \$90,000 a week dealing crack cocaine in Brooklyn, Maryland, Delaware, and Norfolk, Virginia. The federal indictment also charges Chaka Raysor with a total of nine murders. But agents believe the Raysor organization committed more than forty homicides during their ten-year reign of terror. On the streets of Brooklyn, the gang was known as "The Killers". Agents say Raysor mesmerized his gang members with fiery, Black Panther-style rhetoric, and maintained their loyalty with an iron fist. they say during their reign of terror the ruthless Raysor gang murdered innocent local residents, rival drug dealers, landlords, and a homeless man. On April 27, 1998 Umeme Raysor was convicted of federal racketeering, narcotics conspiracy and murder charges, but his brother Chaka remains at large. Chaka Raysor has used the aliases Charles Herbert Raysor, and the nicknames "Chik", "Chak", and "C". He is usually heavily armed, and is skilled in martial arts. Raysor has a stocky, powerful build, close-

cropped hair and a beard, and a glass left eye with a scar underneath. He is described as ruthless, manipulative, charismatic, and extremely violent. Raysor is 30, 5'10" and 200 pounds. Viewer tips placed Raysor in Williamstown, South Carolina, but authorities were unable to locate him. (See Shows #517, #535, #559 and #560, OADs 11/7/98, 3/27/99, 9/25/99 and 10/2/99)

Jerome Alan Bargo (Attempted Murder, Burglary) B Bargo was convicted in 1998 of burglary, theft of property and attempted murder of a Bentonville, Arkansas police sergeant. On May 10, 1988, Bargo escaped from the Pope County jail while awaiting trial on a previous robbery. A few months before, on September 17, 1987, Bargo and his accomplice, Gary Morse, rented a U-Haul truck and cleaned out the video store in Neosha, Missouri. While driving south through Bentonville, Arkansas, the two men were stopped by Officer David Huff and Sgt. James Dray, local police who were investigating a series of unrelated robberies. While the officers were examining the contents of the U-Haul, Bargo stole Huff=s gun and fired at Dray. The two exchanged fire and Bargo took off running into a field. Bargo was caught by Fayetteville police the next day. He was tried and sentenced to 140 years. While in Pope County jail awaiting trial on other charges, Bargo used a makeshift saw to cut his way into the air conditioning duct system and out of the building. Bargo has a scar on his nose and numerous tattoos, including a buzzard on his upper right arm, two roses on his lower right arm, the Grim Reaper on his left arm, 3" bluebirds on each breast, and a dragon on his stomach. He is balding, smiles easily, and speaks slowly, possibly with a Kentucky accent. Bargo has used the aliases Curtis Ray Fee and Dennis Whaley. He is small but muscular, health-conscious, jogs often, and is often seen doing push-ups. Although described as being outgoing and having an easy manner, he has an intense stare. He is an expert safe-peeler. Bargo is 44, 5'9" and 180 pounds. (See Shows #60, #118 and #176, OADs 4/9/89, 6/17/90 and 8/16/91)

ABand-Aid Bandit@ (Bank Robbery) B The FBI has dubbed a white male who wears a bandage on his right jaw the ABand-Aid Bandit@. Agents are uncertain if the bandage is covering up a scar or wound, or if the bandage is just there to throw off tellers and witnesses. He carries a gun concealed in his pants and under his jacket. Agents say the robber has not pointed or used the gun yet. The ABand-Aid Bandit@ has robbed nine banks. His total take is about \$25,000. He hits banks approximately every two weeks between southern Virginia and northern North Carolina. Thus far, the list of dates and location of bank robberies are February 6, 1999 in Henrico County (near Richmond, Virginia); February 23 and March 10, 1999 in Fredericksburg, Virginia; March 12, 1999 in Wilson, North Carolina; March 25, 1999 in Durham, North Carolina; April 9, 1999 in South Hill, Virginia; April 28, 1999 in Henderson, North Carolina; and May 17, 1999 in Roanoake Rapids, North Carolina. The Bandit has worn three different jackets during robberies: camouflage, letterman, and a dark running jacket. The suspect is in his late 20's to early 30's, 5'9"-6'0", and 180-200 pounds. (See Show #546, OAD

Michel Barrera (Attempted Murder, Armed Burglary) -- Barrera is wanted by the FBI for the 1998 armed robbery of two Miami banks, carjacking a Miami man, and the attempted murder of a Metro-Dade police officer during his getaway. Agents say on February 3, 1998, Michel Barrera and his accomplice robbed the Terra Bank in Miami, Florida, of approximately \$19,000. Then, on May 1, 1998 around 1:00pm they robbed the Republic National Bank in Miami at gunpoint. Following the robbery, the two men fled the bank and a high-speed chase ensued with Metro-Dade police officers. During the chase, cops say the two suspects fired on pursuing officers, then carjacked and severely injured a Miami civilian before ditching his car in a canal. Search teams combed the heavily foliated area near the canal and were able to find and arrest Barrera's accomplice, but Michel Barrera was nowhere to be found. Barrera, a Cuban immigrant, comes across as a sweet, nice young boy. However, he is a known gang member who may try to recruit other teenagers to commit crimes and may be hanging out with "punk" teenagers on the street. He has used the aliases Michael Barrera, Rene Caso, and Christopher Montefu. He has a burn scar on his left shoulder and "Maria" tattooed on his upper right rear shoulder, although he may have tattooed over this and grown his hair longer to change his appearance. He is always armed and has been known to impersonate a cop in home-invasion robberies. Barrera is a known drug user and loves to drink Malt liquor. He enjoys playing paintball, and frequents shooting ranges. Michel Barrera is 19, 5'8" and 145 pounds. (See Shows #519 and #539, OADs 11/21/98 and 4/24/99)

Michael Todd Hunsucker (Criminal Sexual Conduct, Tampering With A Witness) B Investigators in Renville, Minnesota are looking for Hunsucker after he failed to appear for a September 1999 court date to face child molestation charges. In 1997, Julie Ann Muto and her daughter, 9-year-old Jennifer, moved in with Julie=s boyfriend, Michael Todd Hunsucker. Soon after, he began molesting Jennifer. Jennifer told police the abuse started with a game he called Aspider@ where his fingers would walk up her legs until it reached her private area. Over the next two years, investigators say the abuse escalated. Hunsucker forced Jennifer to perform oral sexual and eventually vaginal penetration. In April of 1999, Julie and Jennifer moved out due to Hunsucker=s physical abuse of Julie. It was only after that point that Jennifer confided to her mother that she had been abused. Jennifer said Hunsucker threatened to kill her if she told anyone. On May 26, 1999 charges were filed against Hunsucker. He was released on \$8,000 bail and trial was set for September 22, 1999. He was last seen leaving work on September 15, 1999. Hunsucker speaks with a Southern accent. He has fine hair with a receding hairline, worn long in back. He wears a baseball cap almost all the time. Hunsucker appears buck-toothed, and

is missing a front tooth. He has worked as a commercial hog farmer. Hunsucker is 37, 5'2" and 168 pounds.

CAPTURED:

Stanley A. Lacefield (Felonious Assault, Child Endangering)

Cicily K. Mason (Permitting Child Abuse) -- On September 24, 1999 a ten-year-old boy was found wandering the street outside his apartment in Dayton, Ohio. He was severely injured, wearing only his pants and a blanket to cover his shoulders. A woman happened to see him, and she approached him and asked him if he needed help. He asked her to please bring him to the hospital. On the way to the hospital the victim asked the woman if she would be his new mom and take him home with her. The boy made her promise that she would not leave him. Dayton police officers were called to the hospital, and the boy told them how his stepfather, Stanley Lacefield, had been abusing him. Lacefield beat the boy with a hammer, twisted his ears with pliers, blacked his eyes, immersed him in scalding hot water and freezing cold water, hit him over the head with a brush, and countless other offenses. The boy was made to sleep in the kitchen cupboard and his stepfather threatened to kill on the day he beat the boy over the head with a hammer. On September 24th, the victim was able to escape from the apartment, but he has a sister and a five-month-old baby brother who are believed to be with Stanley Lacefield and Cicily Mason (the boy=s biological mother). Upon further investigation, police officers learned that Lacefield had done this before. Lacefield has charges against him for battering his children and stepchildren in Little Rock, Arkansas. Evidently, Lacefield fled Little Rock when the charges were filed and started over in Dayton, Ohio. Thankfully, the ten-year-old victim is doing as well as can be expected. Stanley Lacefield and his wife, Cicily Mason took off with 8-year-old Brittany Nicole Mason and 6-month-old Stanley Lacefield, Jr. Immediately following the broadcast, viewer tips placed the fugitive family in a homeless shelter in Memphis, Tennessee. The couple grabbed their children and fled, but were picked up within minutes. Brittany and Stanley Jr. are safe. (See Show #560, OAD 10/2/99)

Norman Lee Johnston (Escape) B Johnston is wanted for escaping from the Pennsylvania State Correctional Institute in Huntingdon on August 2, 1999. Johnston was serving a life sentence for killing four teenagers in 1978 to cover up a multimillion dollar burglary ring he ran with his two brothers, Bruce Sr. and David. The burglary ring was responsible for stealing hundreds of trucks, cars and farm equipment in Pennsylvania, Delaware and Maryland. The 1986 film AAt Close Range@, starring Sean Penn, was based on the case. Johnson opened a window of his cell, sneaked across a grassy yard and wriggled through a fence some time after 1:00am on Monday, August 2, 1999. Johnston returned to his home town of

Chadd=s Ford, Pennsylvania where AMW viewer Rick Mercurio recognized Johnston and called authorities. Johnston was arrested without incident. (See Show #553, OAD 8/14/99)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Michael Todd Hunsucker (Criminal Sexual Conduct, Tampering With A Witness) B Investigators in Renville, Minnesota are looking for Hunsucker after he failed to appear for a September 1999 court date to face child molestation charges. In 1997, Julie Ann Muto and her daughter, 9-year-old Jennifer, moved in with Julie=s boyfriend, Michael Todd Hunsucker. Soon after, he began molesting Jennifer. Jennifer told police the abuse started with a game he called Aspider@ where his fingers would walk up her legs until it reached her private area. Over the next two years, investigators say the abuse escalated. Hunsucker forced Jennifer to perform oral sexual and eventually vaginal penetration. In April of 1999, Julie and Jennifer moved out due to Hunsucker=s physical abuse of Julie. It was only after that point that Jennifer confided to her mother that she had been abused. Jennifer said Hunsucker threatened to kill her if she told anyone. On May 26, 1999 charges were filed against Hunsucker. He was released on \$8,000 bail and trial was set for September 22, 1999. He was last seen leaving work on September 15, 1999. Hunsucker speaks with a Southern accent. He has fine hair with a receding hairline, worn long in back. He wears a baseball cap almost all the time. Hunsucker appears buck-toothed, and is missing a front tooth. He has worked as a commercial hog farmer. Hunsucker is 37, 5'2" and 168 pounds. (See Show #561, OAD 10/9/99)

Juan Manuel Casillas, Jr. (Murder) B Juan Casillas wanted for the double homicide of Jessica Zavala and Olivia Munguia on June 8, 1999. Casillas approached the two cousins on their way to school and fatally shot them both in the back. Police believe Olivia Munguia had broken off a relationship with Casillas a month prior to the shooting. Munguia=s relatives claim that Casillas was obsessed with her and couldn=t accept her decision. Casillas, whose nickname is AJuanelo@, has used the alias Juan Casillas Arellano. He speaks Spanish fluently, and may be affiliated with street gangs in Los Angeles and Mexico. He wears his hair longer on top and combed back, and may wear a goatee and/or mustache. He has piercing green eyes. Casillas speaks with a slight stutter. He does not smoke cigarettes, but is known to smoke marijuana and may be using meth or cocaine. He has worked as a mechanic. Authorities warn that he should

be considered armed and dangerous. Casillas is 20, 5'7"-5'9" and 160-185 pounds.

Hazel Leota Head (Murder, Arson) -- Hazel Leota Head is wanted for the murder of Charles Barker on September 2, 1998 in Benton, Louisiana. Barker was shot in the back of the head as he sat at his trailer counter. Police found a murder weapon and say physical evidence points to Hazel Head. Hazel had met Barker at a local casino under the name Deiana Ray. She subsequently moved in with him. When Barker's body was found, his cash and his car were gone. Upon further investigation, police found that there was an outstanding warrant for Hazel's arrest in Nebraska, where she is accused of burning down a boyfriend's trailer. Police also learned that Hazel has a history of moving around. She has been married multiple times, to as many as ten different men. She has lived all across the country. Head has many aliases, including Hazel Morgan, Willow Shields, Hazel Foley, Kelly Morgan, Hazel Spurbeck, Hazel Haynes, Hazel Vincent, Deiana Ray, Hazel Woodman, Hazel Fautch, Treasa ATess@ Jean Coyle, and Treasa ATess@ Venable. She has a noticeable gap between her front teeth. She is a smoker and drinker, favoring vodka. She often works as a waitress, and hangs out at truck stops, often traveling with truckers. She frequents casinos and places personal ads looking for men. A truck driver believes the woman he picked up in Madisonville, Kentucky and drove to a truck stop in Woodhaven, Michigan was Head. The woman told the trucker she was trying to get to Las Vegas. Head is 49, 5'2" and 120 pounds. (See Shows #527, #528, #533, #545 and #560, OADs 1/30/99, 2/6/99, 3/13/99, 6/5/99 and 10/2/99)

Tonya Nicole Dice (Homicide) B Pennsylvania police are looking for Tonya Dice, who is wanted for the January 1995 murder of Freddie Brumfield and for questioning in the murder of a Jane Doe in March of 1995. Dice moved to Chambersburg, Pennsylvania to work as a prostitute and drug runner for her boyfriend, who was also her pimp. She also began socializing with a small-time crack dealer, Freddie Brumfield. On January 13, 1995 Brumfield's body was found in an open field. Dice was eventually interviewed regarding the murder of Brumfield and revealed that she was present at the time of his death. She also revealed the name of the person who killed him. A short time later Dice was arrested on unrelated drug charges. Dice made bail and has not been seen since. Now police also want to question Dice about the murder of a Jane Doe. In March the murdered body of a female was found in the Chambersburg, Pennsylvania area. Investigators believe the body was there for approximately six to twelve months. At first investigators thought the body may have been that of Tonya Dice. However, forensic evidence proved that this was not Dice. Now police believe Tonya Dice may know the identity of this Jane Doe and would like to question her about this murder. Dice has a scar on her left ear. She goes by the nicknames ASnow@ or ASnowy@. She is a known prostitute and drug dealer. Dice is 26, 5'9" and 165 pounds. The unidentified Jane Doe had shoulder-length bleached blonde hair, artificial red fingernails, and an appendectomy scar. She also had a healed laceration on her left thigh. She was wearing a tan button-down shirt with the words AHook and Tackle@ on it. Jane Doe was in her late teens to early thirties, 5'3" and 130 pounds. (See Shows #558 and #560, OADs 9/18/99 and 10/2/99)

Kyle Kenneth Bell (Escape) B cops throughout New Mexico are searching for a prison escapee convicted of murder and child molestation. On October 13, 1999 Kyle Bell was one of a number of inmates being transferred to a prison in Oregon. Their trek took them through

Santa Rosa, New Mexico where the bus stopped and the guards took an extended break from the drive. At some point during this stop Bell, equipped with handcuff and leg shackle keys, freed himself, climbed through the ventilation hatch of the bus and made his escape. In July 1999 Bell was convicted of the 1993 abduction and murder of 12-year-old Jeanna North in Fargo, North Dakota. Despite the fact that her body has yet to be found, evidence, including her hairs found in his truck, led to Bell=s conviction. Bell was sentenced to life in prison. Bell has a 1" vertical scar on his right knee, and is missing the tip of his right middle finger. He has tattoos of a panther on his left upper arm, the Grim Reaper with a scythe on his upper right arm, two unicorns on his chest, and another tattoo on his right chest. His hair may be dyed or permed. He is charming and outgoing, a real smooth talker. He smokes Camels and drinks beer. He has worked as a cook, auto body repairman and meat-packer. Reinaldo Silvestre (Aggravated Battery, Practicing Medicine Without A License, Drug Charges) B Reinaldo Silvestre is wanted for illegally performing surgery on three patients in Miami Beach, Florida in 1999. Silvestre met and befriended three victims, Alexander Baez, Myleidi Pimienta and Jeanette Brunell. He allegedly convinced each of them that he was an accomplished plastic surgeon. He then promised to perform a breast augmentation for the two women and a pectoral implantation for Baez. During the procedures, Silvestre illegally used Ketamine, a horse tranquilizer, as an anesthetic. All three surgeries failed. The two women received misplaced and mis-attached implants and Baez, instead of a small pectoral implant, received women=s breast implants, one of which leaked. All have needed further surgeries to correct the work done by Silvestre, and all are left with disfigurements. Silvestre may have a beard and mustache. He speaks Spanish, French, Italian and English fluently. Silvestre is 58, 6'0" and 170 pounds.

Unknown (Murder) B On October 1, 1998, 62-year-old Jimmie Penn was shot and killed while repairing his rental property in Roanoke, Virginia. The murder occurred at 7:45pm and no motive has been determined for the crime. Penn=s family is offering a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of his killer.

Felipe Abriz Solorio (Murder) B Solorio is wanted in the 1999 shooting death of Robert Ybarra in Grayson, California. Witnesses told police that 22-year-old Robert Ybarra was standing on a street corner on March 7th when a 1993 red Pontiac with four men in it pulled up. A man jumped out of the vehicle and shot Ybarra in the face and chest. The gunman then jumped back into the car and it sped away. The car, registered to Solorio, was later found abandoned. Detectives think the killing was in retaliation for a fight that had occurred two

weeks before. Authorities quickly arrested two of the three men in connection with the murder, but Solorio and another man, Juan Alardin, went on the run. The Carol Sund/Carrington Foundation put up a reward of \$5,000 for the arrest and conviction of Solorio and Alardin. In July a tip to police located Alardin, but Solorio is still on the run. Solorio has a rose tattoo on his left ankle. He is 27, 5'10" and 220 pounds.

Unknown (Murder) B Authorities are looking for the person or persons who are responsible for the 1999 death of 4-year-old Jonique Williams. The little girl disappeared on July 4th while at a relative=s holiday party. The little girl was last seen walking in the living room asking for her parents, who had gone to the store. She was reported missing around 6:30pm. When police arrived they conducted a search of the house and surrounding area. 24 hours later, an uncle found Jonique=s body in the pool. Due to autopsy findings and the fact that the body wasn=t in the pool when they searched earlier, police suspect foul play. To help spur new leads, the Carol Sund/Carrington Memorial Fund has offered a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the little girl=s killer or killers.

Chaka Raysor (Murder, Racketeering, Conspiracy, Drug Charges) -- Chaka Raysor is wanted by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and the United States Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of New York for murder, racketeering, and conspiracy to distribute crack cocaine. In 1985, investigators say Raysor and his brother Umeme formed a ruthless drug gang in their Bedford-Stuyvesant neighborhood of Brooklyn. At its peak, agents say the organization raked in over \$90,000 a week dealing crack cocaine in Brooklyn, Maryland, Delaware, and Norfolk, Virginia. The federal indictment also charges Chaka Raysor with a total of nine murders. But agents believe the Raysor organization committed more than forty homicides during their ten-year reign of terror. On the streets of Brooklyn, the gang was known as "The Killers". Agents say Raysor mesmerized his gang members with fiery, Black Panther-style rhetoric, and maintained their loyalty with an iron fist. they say during their reign of terror the ruthless Raysor gang murdered innocent local residents, rival drug dealers, landlords, and a homeless man. On April 27, 1998 Umeme Raysor was convicted of federal racketeering, narcotics conspiracy and murder charges, but his brother Chaka remains at large. Chaka Raysor has used the aliases Charles Herbert Raysor, and the nicknames "Chik", "Chak", and "C". He is usually heavily armed, and is skilled in martial arts. Raysor has a stocky, powerful build, close-cropped hair and a beard, and a glass left eye with a scar underneath. He is described as ruthless, manipulative, charismatic, and extremely violent. Raysor is 30, 5'10" and 200 pounds. Viewer tips placed Raysor in Williamstown, South Carolina, but authorities were unable to locate him. Derrick Henderson (Murder, Conspiracy, Weapons Charges) -- Derrick Henderson is wanted by the United States Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of New York, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms for murder in aid of racketeering and conspiracy to distribute crack cocaine. Agents say Henderson is a trusted lieutenant of alleged Brooklyn drug lord Chaka Raysor. Agents say the gang dealt large quantities of crack cocaine and terrorized the Bedford-Stuyvesant community of Brooklyn between 1985 and 1996. In the early morning hours of January 18, 1994, agents say Henderson ordered a crack addict to douse an occupied apartment building with gasoline and set it ablaze. One resident, Yvonne Archibald, leapt to her death from a third-floor window in a desperate attempt to escape the inferno. Henderson is know to frequent drug havens in Norfolk, Virginia, Maryland, Delaware and North Carolina. Agents say he has numerous weapons convictions and should be considered armed and dangerous. Hendricks is an alleged rug dealer and gang enforcer; agents say he's always armed, and extremely violent and vengeful. He is a member of the Raysor drug gang. Henderson is 30, 5'6" and 160 pounds. Tipsters have spotted Henderson in Fairmont, West Virginia. (See Shows #517, #535 and #559, OADs 11/7/98, 3/27/99 and 9/25/99)

Crystal Dawn Vigil (Attempted Murder, Carjacking) B During the weekend of June 19, 1999 three women began a 26-hour crime spree. Local AEasyrider@ gang members Adriana AScrappy@ Uribe, Mabelin ATeardrop@ Torres and Crystal AGoofy@ Vigil began their spree with the carjacking and attempted murder of the first victim. Continuing in the first victim=s car, at least two of the women were involved in the murder of 26-year-old taxicab driver Gerardo Jimenez on June 20. Uribe and Torres have been apprehended and charged with murder for their involvement in this case, while Vigil is still at large. She is wanted for the kidnapping and carjacking of the first victim and may possibly be involved in the murder of the second victim. Vigil may have a tattoo on her right calf. She is a possible cocaine user and is very unpredictable and erratic. She may be engaged in prostitution. She should be considered armed and dangerous. Vigil is 19, 5'6" and 145 pounds.

Elaine Antoinette Parent (Passport Fraud) -- Elaine Parent is wanted by the State Department for Passport Fraud and has been named a AVital Link In A Murder Investigation@ in a 1990 homicide in St. Lucie County, Florida. On July 19, 1990 the mutilated remains of 34-year-old Beverly McGowen were found in a rural canal in St. Lucie County, Florida. Deputies say a short time before she died, Beverly told her family and friends that she had a new roommate by the name of AAlice@, who police believe was actually Elaine Parent. On June 16, 1990 Beverly wrote a Agoodbye@ letter to her brother, telling him she was going away. Her brother knew something was wrong and canceled Beverly=s credit cards, hoping it would force her to call him. Deputies say she never did and her body was found a few days later. On July 23, 1990 a woman tried to use Beverly McGowen=s credit card to rent a car at London=s Heathrow airport. But since the card had been canceled the mystery woman, whom police believe was Parent, ended up paying cash. The canceled card raised suspicions and when Scotland Yard was informed the Beverly=s gruesome murder, they intensified their manhunt. Three days later Parent called Avis and tried to extend the rental. British authorities say Parent told them she was near Cornwall, but in reality she was near Heathrow airport, where she

abandoned the car. Police boarded every U.S.-bound aircraft looking for Parent but to no avail. Authorities say Parent eventually made her way back to the United States and in May of 1991 was found sleeping in her car. At the time she was using the name Charlotte Cowan. There was a warrant for Failure to Return the Leased Vehicle. Parent was arrested but was able to post bond just a few days later and hasn=t been seen since. Parent=s countless aliases include Charlotte Rae Cowan, Sylvia Ann Hodgekinson, Ann Tremont, Beverly McGowen, Elaine Haviland, Alex Hart, Alexis Marshal Hart, Antonia Hamilton Russell, Victoria Dark and Bret Tremont. Police describe her as a chameleon who often dyes her hair different colors. She has a Alazy@ right eyelid, and may adopt a British accent, though she was born in New York City. She loves the good life and is a gourmet cook. She supports environmental issues, and loves animals though she may be allergic to cats. She has asthma and has been known to use the medication Ventolin. She travels all over the world but always seems to return to Florida. She has worked as a real estate agent and in the telecommunications field. Parent is 57, 5'7" and 125-145 pounds. (See Shows #531 and #532, OADs 2/27/99 and 3/6/99)

Margaret Rudin (Murder) -- She's held the dubious distinction of appearing on America's Most Wanted six different times, but she continues to elude capture. On August 29, 1998, AMW made another plea to the nation to bring this fugitive to justice. The tips came in, but the alleged Las Vegas Black Widow slipped through the cop's fingers once again. One tipster in Phoenix, Arizona knows her face by heart - she photographed it. The tipster works at the Motor Vehicles Department, and took a picture of Rudin for an Arizona State ID. She's a true chameleon. She also has a new alias - Annette Boatright. She had evidently been living at the YMCA and working at a hotel giftshop for three months. The Spartan conditions at the "Y" were a stark contrast to her pre-fugitive lifestyle. When police picked her up, her ID checked out, and she returned to the "Y," called a limo, and checked out. Las Vegas detectives, searching her room days later, found keys with Rudin's late husband's name on them, but she was already gone. Police now believe she's on her way to Guadalajara, Mexico. Police in Las Vegas, Nevada call Margaret Rudin a gold-digging black widow; married five times, she's a professional bride - with each marriage, they say her net worth grew. In September 1987, Rudin married husband number five - wealthy Las Vegas real estate developer, Ron Rudin. Ironically, Margaret became the fifth Mrs. Ron Rudin. For seven years, the Rudins seemed the perfect couple. But on December 18, 1994, Ron mysteriously disappeared. Ron's employees were alarmed and wanted to report him as a missing person. Oddly, Mrs. Rudin insisted they wait a full two days before calling police. For two months, Ron's fate remained a mystery. Then on January 21, 1995, fishermen found a pile of ashes and a skull near Lake Mojave - about 45 miles from Las Vegas. Dental charts revealed that the fishermen had found Ron Rudin's remains. He had been shot in the head four times, decapitated and stuffed into an antique trunk before being set on fire. Now police had enough evidence to search the Rudins' home for evidence. They

discovered traces of blood which proved that Ron had been killed in his own bedroom. Police started tailing Margaret Rudin and found some big surprises: the grieving widow skipped her husband's funeral, and misplaced his ashes. She also had a secret boyfriend. Police suspected Margaret Rudin was behind Ron's murder, but they didn't have enough evidence to make a case...until July 21, 1996. On that day, a diver in Lake Mead found a handgun with a silencer, wrapped in several plastic bags. It was the murder weapon. On April 18, 1997, a grand jury indicted Margaret Rudin on charges of murder, but she'd already disappeared. Rudin, who has used the names Margaret Frost, Margaret Mason, Margaret Zumbrunn, Margaret Brown and Margaret Krafbe, likes expensive clothes and jewelry. She often dyes her hair, and has been a blonde, redhead and brunette. She has a mother and sister in Palm Springs, California and relatives in Illinois. Margaret Rudin is 56, 5'7" and 130 pounds. As a result of the 8/29/98 broadcast, police positively placed Rudin in Phoenix, Arizona. Police confirmed that Rudin was living at a local Y.M.C.A. for several months and working in a hotel gift shop. One tipster provided a new picture of Rudin showing that she was once again a brunette; another tipster provided Rudin=s latest alias, Annette AAnn@ Boatright. Unfortunately, when questioned by local police Rudin=s fake I.D. passed muster and she wasn=t arrested. A few days later when Las Vegas police got to Phoenix to check out ABoatright=s@ room, they found keys with Ron Rudin=s name on them. By then Rudin had checked out of the AY@ and police believe she traveled to Guadalajara, Mexico. Now authorities believe Rudin may be hiding out in upstate New York, possibly in the Rochester area. Margo Freshwater (Escape) B Margo Freshwater escaped October 4, 1970 from a women=s prison in Nashville, Tennessee. She was serving a 99-year sentence for the December 6, 1966 murder of Hillman Robbins, Sr. in Memphis, Tennessee. Robbins was tied with rope and shot execution-style with a .38 and a .22 pistol. Freshwater and her accomplice, Glenn Nash, a local attorney, then drove throughout the southeastern United States until they were captured December 27, 1966 after getting off a bus in Greenville, Mississippi. Freshwater was found guilty of the Robbins murder on January 29, 1969. Nash was declared mentally incompetent to stand trial. Alden Joe Daniels, Jr. (Rape of a Child, Other Sex Charges) B Daniels is wanted for the 1997-1998 sexual assault of three girls on his All-Star basketball team. His youngest victim was twelve years old. Daniels, a beloved girls basketball coach, recruited girls aged 10-13 from around the country to play on his Amateur Athletic Union team. Daniels= daughter was the star player and he used her to gain access to the other teammates. Daniels had the girls over to his house where he molested and raped them while his wife and daughter were asleep. In the summer of 1998, a twelve-year-old girl reported Daniels to police, even though he had threatened to kill her if she talked. Two other teammates also came forward. Daniels has a scar on his upper lip, may have a mustache, and may have dyed his hair red or blond. He has worked as a flower delivery person. He was last seen driving a dark red or maroon 1987 Toyota Camry. Daniels is 37, 5'11" and 190 pounds.

Martha Ann Gomez (Sexual Assault of a Child) -- Gomez is wanted for sexually assaulting three girls between the ages of 13 and 15 from 1996 to 1998. Gomez posed as a teenage boy and usually met her victims through phone chat/sex lines. She preyed upon girls with low self-esteem, touting herself as someone who would listen to their problems. The conversations eventually escalated to actual meetings where Gomez sexually assaulted the girls. When the girls, who still believed Gomez was a man, tried to break out of the relationship, Gomez threatened their lives and their families= lives. In at least one case, police say Gomez used a gun. Police figured Gomez out and arrested her in the fall of 1998 on one count of aggravated sexual assault of a child. She bonded out. On November 24, when she was supposed to appear in court, and as police were filing three additional charges against her, Gomez disappeared. Gomez may have cut her hair and dyed it blonde. She has acne scars on both cheeks, AGomez@ tattooed on her lower left arm near her wrist and AACE@ on her upper left arm near the biceps. She has a very masculine walk, and hunches down as she walks. She claims she injured her back years ago when working in a candle factory, and used to receive disability checks for a dislocated disc in her back. She usually does factory work. Gomez has used several aliases, including Emilio Garrison, Eric Garrison, and Eric Barragan. Gomez is 34, 4'9" and 115-125 pounds. (See Show #544, OAD 5/29/99)

She fools authorities as to her identity by using one of more than forty aliases, including: Maria Antoska, Maria Antonesko, Lidia Czevsna, Krystena Dolinska, Dorothy Evans, Elki Hoffman, Minnie Howell, Minnie MacHowell, Christina Idcago, Maria Lee, Drobna Kanu, Elizabeth Kemenski, Walentna Kwiek, Christina Kofflske, Ros Korolski, Rose Kovolske, Ros Kowalska, Zosia Kropinska, Valentina Kwick, Walentina Kwick, Cica Lee, Lula Lee, Maria Lipinska, Krystyna Madzian, Virginia Nilson, Kristian Moaziar, Ksali Rli, Patty Geno Roznowska, Marta Starzewska, Glory Tainkow, Gloria Tycoon... By the time police figure out that Knapek is a career criminal spanning the Northeast, she has already posted bond and disappeared. She has been positively identified as the main suspect in several till-tapping incidents, many caught on surveillance tape, and reportedly committed by a deaf mute woman. Knapek is wanted for theft in Connecticut, Illinois, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and Wisconsin. Knapek frequently changes her hair color. She has a prominent nose, a large mole on her right cheek, and a heavy European accent. She often wears long skirts and aprons with big pockets. She may have an accomplice, a 20-30-year old female with dark hair who may be a relative. Knapek is 47, 5'3" and 150 pounds. (See Show #553, OAD 8/14/99)

Astarte Davis-Rice (Escape) -- On August 7, 1998 Astarte Davis-Rice escaped from the minimum security Federal Prison Camp in Dublin, California by simply walking off the grounds. Davis-Rice has an extensive criminal history of embezzlement, fraud and forgery. Police suspect she may have had her common-law husband, James Rice, killed in the Virgin Islands, but don't have enough evidence to charge her. James Rice's body has never been located (see below). She has left a trail of several male victims she has scammed, who were all in the real estate or development field. Davis-Rice has used many aliases, including Peggy Tyler Morris, Esterbelle White, Peggi S. Morris, Peggi Stahlcap, John Henry, and Astarte Rice. She is youthful and has had plastic surgery on her breasts, stomach, eyes and face. She is always well-dressed and manicured, calm and confident with a charming personality, and considers herself part of the "neat and elite crowd". However, she does not look people in the eye. She has worked as a bookkeeper/accountant, and has three sons: Loyal, Noble and Regal. Rice-Davis is 67, 5'7"-5'8" and 140 pounds. (See Shows #517 and #551, OADs 11/7/98 and 7/24/99)

Sadie Wallace Nelson (Material Witness to Murder) B A dead man=s 77-year-old girlfriend may be on the run. In June of 1996, John Burlie Pike was found dead in the driveway of his Polk County, Tennessee home. Mr. Pike=s live-in companion, Sadie Wallace Nelson, was

missing from the residence and has not been seen since. John pike is described as a good ol= boy hog farmer who didn=t have an enemy in the world. In fact, he was known to carry at least \$3,000 cash on him at all times. He was the caretaker of a 400 acre farm in rural Tennessee and carried large amounts of cash just in case he found a hog he needed to purchase. In 1990 Sadie Wallace Nelson moved in with John and they were considered by friends and neighbors to be paramours. Sadie and John knew each other when they were teenagers but they went their separate ways. After nearly 40 years and six marriages for her, they ended up back together. On the morning of June 6, 1996 farmers checking nearby crops discovered John=s body dressed in pajamas. Lying next to him was a lantern. Agents from the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation say John was struck by a blunt object and his throat was slashed. Agents do not suspect the murder was a botched robbery. A safebox with \$30,500 was found hidden under the house. John=s wallet and other valuables were found in the house. The only thing missing was John=s girlfriend Sadie and her suitcase. She then sends a post card to the offender with full information about his arrest and court dates, to let him know the community is aware and watching. The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Unknown Memphis Rapist B The suspect is wanted for four counts of rape and one count of attempted rape. The first attack was in January 1999, and the last, which was unsuccessful, was in May 1999. All of the attacks have occurred within the Memphis city limits. The Memphis Police Department has charted all of the rape sites within a five mile radius. In the early morning hours the perpetrator walks up to his victims brandishing a knife, states that he has a gun, and forces the victims to walk to another location. Detective Marcus Worthy named the perpetrator the AWalk-With-Me Rapist@ because of his modus operandi. The victims have been forced to walk as far as 1/4 mile and as little as one block. All of the attacks have occurred near schools or school bus stops. None of the victims has ever seen the gun. The suspect targets girls 13-16 years old. He has an extremely thin build and bumpy, pitted facial skin. One victim noted scars or scratches on his arms. He may be wearing cologne. The suspect is 25-40, 5'8"-6'0", and 140-170 pounds.

Central City Kidnapper B An unknown man in Central City, Pennsylvania, has tried three times to kidnap young females; the third time he was successful. At approximately 2:30pm on September 19, 1999 a 10-year-old girl was walking down the street with two of her friends. A man pulled up, got out of the car and asked for directions. Next, he grabbed the girl, threw her over his shoulder and drove off. The little girl was released several hours later in Fayette County, Pennsylvania, just north of the West Virginia border. This incident horrified the Somerset county area, which has a population of only 4,400. Police believe the same man tried to strike again two other times in nearby communities but was unsuccessful. On July 11, 1999 a man tried to lure two young girls into his car with money, but they ran off. On September 10, 1999 the same man showed a little girl a gun and told her to get into his car, but the child also ran away. There is a \$10,000 reward being offered by the Pennsylvania State Police Department for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect. The suspect was last seen wearing a green t-shirt with an alien cartoon printed on it, green silky shorts with a Boston Celtics logo, a green/tan baseball cap, and black and blue athletic shoes. He was driving a teal

green compact car, possibly a Geo Metro. The suspect is 20-30 years old.

Unknown (Murder) -- The Nashville country music scene will never be the same; Skull is dead. David "Skull" Schulman was the so-called and widely-loved "Mayor of Printer's Alley," a title he earned by operating one of the best-known clubs in Nashville, Skull's Rainbow Room. The Rainbow Room was lined with photographs of Skull posing with country music's elite--Tanya Tucker, Dolly Parton, Waylon Jennings, Willie Nelson. Skull, 81 years old when he died, opened the Rainbow Room in the 1940s, and jump-started the careers of numerous country celebrities. When the hit show "Hee-Haw" moved to Nashville, he was adopted as a cast member. When he wasn't on the set wearing his overalls or entertaining his club's patrons, he could be seen walking his poodle Sweetie down Printer's Alley. But on January 21, 1998, Skull's long life was suddenly taken from him by an unknown attacker. At 4:30 p.m. that day, the freshly-shaved Skull was picked up by a cab in front of Leonard's Manor Barber Shop and dropped off at his club. An hour and a half later, a cigarette vendor found Skull lying on the floor of his club. He had been cut six times, and his throat slashed. Police found evidence of a fight, but also found that Skull still had his wallet, with more than \$140. Skull hung on to life until 3:10 a.m. During his struggle, Tanya Tucker visited the hospital, and sang "Farther Along" to the dying man. Now, she and the rest of Skull's many friends want a suspect to be named and captured. It is a crime, they say, that shouldn't go unsolved. The unknown suspect spent time in Nashville in January and February 1998. He may be a homeless drifter who lives in shelters and hangs out in nightclubs. He could be working as a bouncer and may be familiar with country music. (See Shows #502 and #524, OADs 7/11/98 and 1/9/99)

James J. Hall (Murder) B Police in New Hampshire are looking for Hall in connection with the 1999 murder of his own mother. On May 20, 1999 the body of 77-year-old Joan Hall was found in a rural area outside Concord, New Hampshire. Her body was badly decomposed and was found inside a sealed garbage barrel. Two witnesses remember seeing James Hall load what seemed to be a heavy garbage barrel into the back seat of his mother=s car. Police also recovered surveillance tapes from banks which revealed James Hall withdrawing large sums of money from his mother=s Visa account. He has been charged with second degree murder. Hall has thinning hair which he wears in a comb-over to hide his baldness. He is very intelligent, holds a Master=s degree in philosophy, and has expressed a desire to become a Buddhist monk. He is a chronic complainer who will complain about anything and everything. He has talked about traveling to Canada, and may still be driving his mother=s green 1995 Chevrolet Corsica, with New Hampshire plates CLL-423. Hall is 45, 5'7" and 140 pounds.

Two Fat Bandits (Armed Robbery) B The FBI is looking for two armed robbers who have been targeting armored trucks for the past seven years. Beginning in Lexington, Kentucky in 1992, these two men may have robbed five different armored car messengers as they either entered or exited a bank with a delivery of cash. When they were caught on tape in a 1994

robbery in Knoxville, Tennessee, the two subjects seemed to be heavy-set. Subject #1, the taller of the two, seemed to weigh around 250 pounds. Subject #2 had a stockier build and probably weighed between 180-200 pounds. They were not caught on tape again until their latest robbery on September 21, 1999 in Birmingham, Alabama. This time both bandits seemed to have gained even more weight, each putting on more than fifty pounds. For their size, they are very agile and should be considered dangerous. Subject #2 seems to be the more aggressive and talkative of the two robbers. During a botched robbery in 1996, Subject #2 fired several rounds of bullets at the back of a Brinks truck as it sped away. These two men have stolen more than \$1 million in their career and may now be in hiding. They follow a pattern of only doing an armored car robbery once every two years, or, agents speculate, when they run out of money. Subject #1 has a Southern accent, a receding hairline, and may have a mustache. He is described as Avery large, like a football player. Subject #1 is 30-40, 6'2"-6'4", and 280-300 pounds. Subject #2 also has a Southern accent. He may have a reddish beard and may have a mustache. It seems likely he is the leader of the pair. He is described as very calm and controlled during robberies. Subject #2 is 30-40, 5'8"-6'0", and 230-250 pounds.

Pepe Miranda (Murder, Armed Robbery) B These eight are wanted for the murder of a retired New York City police officer, as well as multiple armed robberies in New York and around the country. On August 27, the eight plus another man named Fernando Colorado ambushed Donald Pagani as he was escorting a bookkeeper on his way to drop off receipts from his family=s business, the American Sirloin Company in the Bronx. The gang robbed and shot the bookkeeper; then Pagani shot and killed Colorado. Items found on Colorado=s body led to the identification of the other members of the gang. This group is also responsible for multiple armed robberies, mostly of jewelry couriers. This group surveils couriers as they go to and from jewelry dealers and shows, then meticulously plans their robbery. All of the group are armed, and their robberies are becoming more and more violent. Baez has a bump on his nose and another prominent bump on his left forehead. He reportedly had his fingerprints removed. Baez is 25, 5'11", and 170 pounds. Garcia is 34. Cordova is 22. Restrepo is 25, 5'5", and 160 pounds. Cabrera is 39, 5'4", and 170 pounds. Santander is 25. Coronel is 17. Miranda is 37.

Kyle Kenneth Bell (Escape) B cops throughout New Mexico are searching for a prison escapee convicted of murder and child molestation. On October 13, 1999 Kyle Bell was one of a number of inmates being transferred to a prison in Oregon. Their trek took them through Santa Rosa, New Mexico where the bus stopped and the guards took an extended break from the drive. At some point during this stop Bell, equipped with handcuff and leg shackle keys, freed himself, climbed through the ventilation hatch of the bus and made his escape. In July 1999 Bell was convicted of the 1993 abduction and murder of 12-year-old Jeanna North in Fargo, North Dakota. Despite the fact that her body has yet to be found, evidence, including her hairs found in his truck, led to Bell=s conviction. Bell was sentenced to life in prison. Bell has a 1" vertical scar on his right knee, and is missing the tip of his right middle finger. He has tattoos of a panther on his left upper arm, the Grim Reaper with a scythe on his upper right arm, two unicorns on his chest, and another tattoo on his right chest. His hair may be dyed or permed. He is charming and outgoing, a real smooth talker. He smokes Camels and drinks beer. He has worked as a cook, auto body repairman and meat-packer. When last seen, he was wearing a purple shirt and black pants. Bell is 32, 5'11" and 200 pounds. Following the October 1999 broadcast Bell was spotted in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin. On Friday 13, 1999 Rosales tried to kidnap a 10-year-old girl from a local hotel. He hit the child over the head with a steel pipe and tried to stuff her into a five-foot-long duffle bag. The little girl was able to free herself and run for help. The girl=s uncle chased Rosales and was able to detain him until police arrived. Rosales was arrested, bonded out and disappeared. In the meantime, police in Tyler executed a search warrant on Rosales= residence and started looking into recent indecency cases. A 12-year-old victim picked Rosales out of a photo lineup as the person who had fondled her in March of 1999. AMW viewer Dawn Bacon spotted Rosales= posting on the HBO website trying to sell the cable network his story. She alerted authorities, who set up a sting: San Antonio police asked HBO to establish contact with Rosales, indicating they were interested in his story. A meeting between Rosales and a fictitious television producer was set up in a hotel room in Wichita Falls, Texas. He showed up right on time and was arrested.
