*The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.*

**William Michael McCandless** (Racketeering, Fraud) -- On May 4, 1998, the offices of the U.S. Attorney and the FBI in Louisville, Kentucky indicted William Michael McCandless for Interstate Transportation In Aid of Racketeering (ITAR) and Fraud By Wire (FBW) relating to the "sponging" of four race horses at Churchill Downs in Louisville, in an attempt to fix the races. The Kentucky Racing Commission says McCandless is believed to have put sponges in the nostrils of four horses in three races: the fourth race on May 30, 1996 (2 horses), the fourth race on June 8, 1997 and the first race on June 14, 1997. Horses only breathe through their noses, not through their mouths, so a sponge in a horse's nostrils most likely will slow the horse down. Several months after race horse Class O' Lad was "sponged", he died from complications. The Kentucky State Police charged McCandless in the June 25, 1997 theft of a \$500,000 mare that was in foal to Secretariat. McCandless surrendered, then jumped bond prior to his trial. He was a fugitive for three years, until he was arrested in a federal farm equipment theft ring in Nashville. He was convicted and served three years. McCandless, who has used the aliases Michael Rhodes hangs out at racetracks and is a big gambler, but doesn't win often. He has family in the horse industry in Illinois and Nebraska, and is very close with his mother in Hendersonville, Tennessee. He has an ex-wife in Nebraska and an adult son. McCandless served in the US Marine Corps in Vietnam. He is a very nervous type who fidgets a lot, and is described as very quiet and soft spoken. He has never worked at a job. He is known to smoke Marlboro cigarettes. He wears very dark prescription sunglasses. McCandless is 52, 5'9" and 130 pounds. (See Show #517, OAD 11/7/98)

**Unknown** (Murder) - Police in London are looking for the person(s) responsible for the shooting death of British television personality Jill Dando. On April 26, 1999 Jill was returning to her home in the Fulham area of West London. Although nobody actually saw the shooting, police believe a white male lay in wait. Before she made it to her front door, the gunman fired one bullet from a 9mm semi-automatic handgun into the side of her head. Numerous witnesses placed a man fitting the description listed above pacing in front of her house before the shooting, as well as running from the scene of the shooting and walking through a nearby park, drenched in

sweat. Police believe this man may be the shooter. Jill Dando, 37, was the host of "Crimewatch UK", a crime show fashioned after AMW. Because of her job and status, police believe the killer could either be an obsessive stalker or, more likely, a professional hitman. The suspect was wearing a dark suit at the time of the shooting, and was described as wearing glasses that appear too big for his face. He was carrying a mobile phone. The suspect is 30-40 and 5'11".

**Serguie Tcharouchine** (Visa Fraud and Peonage) -- As a result of a two-year investigation, federal agents broke a sex slave ring in Chicago. The ring was allegedly operated by Alexander Mishulovich, a US citizen, and Serguie Tcharouchine, from Russia. The arrests were made on September 10, 1998 and the two were indicted in December 1998. Mishulovich is in federal custody, while Tcharouchine is an international fugitive. Agents believe he could be traveling between the US and Russia. The indictment charges Tcharouchine and his associates with luring young women from the Eastern European country of Latvia to Chicago. The women were promised jobs as dancers for an annual salary of \$60,000. The indictment alleges that the women were not told they would become nude dancers. Also, it alleges that the women were locked in an apartment, had no access to a phone and were beaten. The women were forced to dance nude at several Chicago night clubs and all their earnings went to Tcharouchine and Mishulovich. The victims, who became sex slaves, are free from their captors and fear for their lives. Tcharouchine wears his hair in a ponytail. **AMW ALL-POINTS BULLETINS:**

**Juan Ramon Carlos** (Murder, Attempted Murder, Robbery) -- Carlos is wanted for the February 1999 shooting death of Mrs. Chung-bok Hong, affectionately known as "Mama". On the morning of February 3, 1999 the Hong's were attacked by a robber in the parking lot of their family market. Mama was shot in the back and died instantly. Her son Edward was shot in the leg. The suspects took off in a red Trans Am, which was abandoned a few blocks away. Police picked up Pablo Hernandez, the driver, a few days later. Police are now looking for the man believed to be Mama's shooter, Juan Ramon Carlos. Police believe his real name may be Eladio Roman. Carlos has used the aliases Juan Ramon Carlos, Iledo Ramon, and Martin Ramirez, and has used the nicknames "Indio" or "Indian". He has his first name tattooed on his left forearm, and may have a scar on his left thigh. He has long hair and a noticeably long pointed nose. He is a knowledgeable car mechanic, and has worked as a roofer and a fruit vendor. He has a prior arrest for robbery and murder in Los Angeles, and should be considered armed and dangerous. Carlos is 31, 5'8" and 150 pounds.

**James Bohanna, Jr.** (Aggravated Battery on a Police Officer) -- Bohanna is wanted for shooting and wounding a Kansas City, Missouri police officer on November 11, 1998. The officer was responding to a "shots fired" call when he got into a foot chase with Bohanna. During the chase, Bohanna turned around and fired approximately 10 shots at the officer, hitting him in the foot. Bohanna, who was on parole at the time for a 1993 armed robbery, got away. On February 15, 1999 Bohanna fled from cops again after Fairview Heights, Illinois police officers attempted a felony car stop on him. This time he led them on a high-speed chase, hitting a car and a street sign before running off into a wooded area. Bohanna hasn't been seen since. Bohanna has used the alias James Johnson, and goes by the nicknames "Bushwack" and "Lil James". His weight varies from 120 to 170 pounds depending his drug use at the time. He is reportedly a member of the Metros Prison gang. He smokes cigarettes, "blunts" (marijuana-laced cigars) and marijuana. He was last seen wearing his hair in short, tight braids. Bohanna is 28, 5'2", and approximately 145 pounds.

Jolene Riendeau has been missing from the Pointe Saint-Charles neighborhood of Montreal, Quebec, Canada since April 12, 1999. On that Monday Jolene came home from school, walked her dog, did some chores and went out to play between 4:00pm and 4:30pm. Witnesses who know Jolene told police they saw her at 5:30pm with a bag of chips outside a local convenience store. A little while later Jolene was seen roller-blading on the corner of Wellington and Livermore Streets. Jolene's friend Karine saw her at approximately 6:05pm when Jolene stopped to talk to her on Knox Street. After that, police don't know what happened to the little girl. Jolene speaks both French and English. She has a scar on her forehead, and a dark-colored scar on her right ear surrounding an old earring hole. She is very friendly and outgoing. When last seen, she was wearing blue Addidas sports pants with a white line from top to bottom and a blue snap, a t-shirt, blue polar-fleece sweater with flowers on the shoulder, and grey shoes with thick soles, laces, and a "bubble" in the middle of the heel.

**John Slarb**

The Charles County, Maryland sheriff's office is searching for John Slarb, a heavy equipment operator for Facchina Construction company who disappeared on April 15, 1999. Police say Slarb's crew stopped work at the Naval Surface Warfare Center in Indian Head due to a heavy downpour. Slarb failed to return home from giving a co-worker a ride home after work. Slarb was last seen driving his dark green 1996 GMC pickup truck with Maryland license plate 35F099. Slarb wears a mustache and collar-length hair. He has an unknown tattoo on his upper right arm and a Tazmanian devil tattoo on his left arm. When last seen he was wearing Levi's jeans and Red Wing work boots.

**UPDATES:**

**Tina Marie Cornelius** (Child Abandonment) Two weeks ago, AMW listed Tina Cornelius as a missing person after she disappeared from Williamson County, Texas on Monday, April 19, 1999. Tina's two children, 2-year-old Dominic Logan Cornelius and 3-year-old Amanda Miller Cornelius, were found dead on April 19 at around 4:30pm. The children's bodies were located on a bank of the Brushy Creek, which is about 20 miles north of Austin, Texas. Dominic had suffered blunt force trauma to his head, and Amanda was suffocated. Tina is

nowhere to be found. Following the initial broadcast, the manager of the strip club where Tina worked told AMW that the day after the children were found murdered, Tina showed up for work -- in a cheerful mood. Detectives located Tina in Corpus Christi, Texas. She told authorities that her children had fallen into the creek; believing they were alive, she simply walked away. She has been charged with felony child abandonment, but authorities are still trying to find out exactly what happened. (See Show #539, OAD 4/24/99)

**Rex Allen Krebs** -- Krebs is a major suspect in the disappearance of San Luis Obispo, California college students Aundria Crawford and Rachel Newhouse since the discovery of the remains of two females on his property. Krebs was in jail on unrelated charges. He is not under suspicion in the disappearance of another student, Kristin Smart, as he was incarcerated at the time she disappeared. Since the original story was broadcast, the remains have positively been identified as Crawford and Newhouse; the cause of death, asphyxiation. (See Show #539, OAD 4/24/99)

**Percy Wayne Froman** (Murder) -- Froman is wanted for murder and aggravated robbery. In the early morning hours of February 12, 1999 Froman fatally stabbed 50-year-old John Crumley, a Birmingham, Alabama resident he had befriended, then took of in Crumley's father's truck. Police say Froman has been known to hustle older men for money, but are not sure what his relationship was with Crumley. Crumley's father's truck was later recovered near Atlanta, Georgia. From Atlanta, authorities now know Froman went to Tyler, Texas where, on March 9, 1999, he beat and robbed a local motel clerk. He hasn't been seen since. Froman has used the aliases William Froman, Paul Fremont, Perez Wayne Froman, and Pers W. Froman. He has also used the surname Freeman. He has crooked and chipped front teeth, and his eyebrows slightly connect over the bridge of his nose. He may have dyed his hair blond, and may have facial hair. He talks a lot, and talks big, drives fast and recklessly, and is known to have a crack habit. He frequents gay nightclubs. Froman has a criminal history for larceny, credit card fraud, and drug possession, and has spent time in jail in several states. Froman is 29, 6'2" and 170 pounds. (See Show #538, OAD 4/17/99)

**Mac Buckley** (Unlawful Flight To Avoid Prosecution) -- Mac Buckley, an attorney from Connecticut missing since March 1, 1999, is now a federal fugitive. According to authorities, Buckley was reported missing on March 1, 1999. The last time anyone heard from him was at 12:20 pm the same day, when he phoned to notify his law office he was on the way to a client's court appearance in New Haven, Connecticut. Buckley never arrived at the courthouse. Buckley's wife reported him missing at 5:45 pm the next day. According to police, Buckley was spotted outside Albany, New York on March 5, 1999. Police say Buckley's cellular phone nor

credit cards have been used since his disappearance. Investigators also say nothing is missing from Buckley's home. On March 9, Buckley's law license was suspended as a result of complaints against him. A statewide committee concluded that Buckley used fraud and deceit to seize clients' assets worth between \$500,000 and \$1 million. Last week Buckley turned himself in to authorities. (See Show #536, OAD 4/3/99)

**Luis Alfonso Lopez** (Wanted for Questioning) -- On December 31, 1996, Liz Bustamante strolled into the Floor Samples Furniture Store looking for her friend, Jacqueline Arauz. She immediately knew something was wrong - Jacqueline was nowhere in sight, and neither were any other employees. Liz finally found her friend in the back office with a co-worker, Abel Perez. They had been bound, gagged, and shot in head. Police didn't know where to begin. Was the murder a planned hit or a botched robbery? There were few clues until police talked to store manager Ramona Blanco. Just hours before she was found killed, Liz had told Ramona about some visitors she had a bad feeling about. The previous day, she reportedly had said, two men and one woman had come into the store, asking questions about how much money the store made and how many people worked there. The way they winked and snickered to each other made Liz nervous, so she wrote down their license plate number as they drove away. Police called Liz's family, and they found her note in the clothes she had been wearing the day before she was killed. The first plate the police ran led them to a junked car. But then, when they ran the numbers through the traffic infraction computer, up popped Luis Lopez. Police became extremely interested in him after learning that he reportedly had a history of theft and burglary. Police believe that Lopez, although he is not a suspect, may hold the keys that will blow this case wide open. Lopez has used the aliases Luis Mariano Lopez and Ground Quintero. He has a tattoo on his left biceps of the letter "E", and another tattoo, possibly a saint, on his back. Lopez has visible acne scars on his face. He has police records for theft and burglary. Police say he's a heavy crack cocaine user. Lopez is a Colombian national, but claims to be Cuban. He has worked as a cook and construction worker. He speaks with a Colombian accent. He may be driving a 1986 dark blue Cadillac. Lopez is 25, 5'8" and 140-160 pounds. (See Shows #1015, #501 and #529, OADs 3/8/97, 6/27/98 and 2/13/99)

**Unknown killer of Jonbenet Ramsey** -- Prosecution sources tell AMW that the case is solved, and that indictments might be handed down by May 9.

**Unknown (Robbery)** -- The FBI in Idaho Falls, Idaho is searching for the man or men responsible for the robbery of a bank in Shelley, Idaho. On December 14, 1998, around 8:30am, a man posing as a postal worker went to the home of bank manager Merri Freeman. Freeman answered the door and moments later found the man standing in her house with a gun. The man strapped a bomb to Freeman and handed her a two page letter with specific instructions in it. He told Freeman that if she didn't follow the instructions, she would be blown up. FBI gents say after the man left the house, Freeman went to the bank and filled a money bag with \$50,000. In order to get to the dropoff location, Freeman followed instructions posted on telephone poles. She traveled many winding roads through the countryside before reaching the last telephone pole. There she found a key and directions on how to disarm the bomb. Freeman then returned to the bank. Agents never found the bomb, the note or the money. They have a sketch of both the suspect and the bomb. The suspect wore a postal jacket and matching pants, a navy US postal cap, and surgical gloves under regular gloves. He was very polite, obviously educated, and speaks and writes well. He may have some kind of engineering skills or background. Parts of the bomb were purchased at a local Wal-Mart. He has wiry gray eyebrows and an olive-colored complexion. The suspect is in his late 50's, 5'9" and 150-160 pounds.

**Rudolfo "Rudy" Montoya (Escape)** -- Rudolfo Montoya is a convicted drug dealer and auto thief. He was sentenced to 18 years in federal prison on the drug charges and 9 years in state prison on grand theft auto. After serving five years in Safford, Arizona, Montoya was erroneously released from federal prison on June 24, 1994. Detectives with the Organized Crime Intelligence division did not learn of his release until November 1996. Montoya, who has used the alias Ramon Rivera, is a suspect in four murders. He enjoys luxury cars, spending money, and boxing. He considers himself a ladies' man. He dresses like a businessman and owns property in Los Angeles, but should be considered armed and dangerous. Montoya is 59 and 6'0".

**Amber Creek Killer (Wanted for Questioning, Murder)** -- The Racine County Sheriff's

office is attempting to identify the killer of 14-year-old Amber Creek whose body was dumped in a wooded area near Burlington, Wisconsin in 1997. On February 9, 1997, two hunters came across the partially frozen body of a female in a remote wooded area near the small town of Burlington. The young girl was wearing few clothes and had a black garbage bag wrapped around her head. Detectives also found on the body a \$5.00 price sticker from a book store in Schaumburge, Illinois, a suburb of Chicago. The Milwaukee coroner determined the cause of death to be asphyxiation. Detectives believe the girl had been killed at an undisclosed location and then discarded in their woods. After an exhaustive search to identify the girl, including two airings on AMW, detectives felt they had come to a dead end. That was until seventeen months later when a detective in the Racine Sheriff's office made a startling discovery while searching the website for the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. He noticed the similarity between a photo of Amber Creek, a missing girl from Chicago, and his Racine Jane Doe. A positive identification was made through dental records. Racine Jane Doe, aka Amber Creek, was a troubled 14-year-old girl who had run away from a Teens In Crisis center in Chicago in January 1997. Armed with that information, Racine detectives quickly developed several eyewitnesses who last saw Amber on January 31, 1997 getting into a grey luxury car. Detectives are hoping that once located, the driver of the car will be able to provide information regarding what happened to Amber. The driver may wear glasses and may dress and act like he has a lot of money. Some witnesses said that the car may have leather seats, and may have a white cardboard placard on the dashboard with the word "Mayor" written in black. The driver is 30-40, of average height and medium to heavy weight. (See Shows #455, #478 and #521, OADs 6/21/97, 1/3/98 and 12/12/98)

**Charles Cossio** (Child Molestation) -- Cossio is wanted for molesting his step-granddaughter in National City, California. Cossio has a long history of family molestation. Police believe that Cossio may be traveling back and forth from Southern California to Mexico. Cossio speaks Spanish fluently. He doesn't smoke or drink, and may use insulin and nitroglycerin for diabetes and a heart condition. Cossio is 72, 6'3" and 240 pounds.

**Unknown** (Robbery) -- Agents in California are looking for a heavy set man they say is responsible for five bank robberies in the Los Angeles area. Because of the hat he wears during the robberies, agents have dubbed him the "Civil War Bandit". His spree began on April 10, 1998 when he robbed a Bank of America in Montrose, California. He entered, armed with a sawed-off shotgun and carrying a bag. He struck seven months later, robbing a California Federal Bank in Glendale. He apparently robbed the same Glendale bank again two months later. He later robbed the California Federal Bank in La Canada on two separate occasions. Tellers who have serviced him say he is very polite during his robberies. The suspect has a moustache and goatee, and may wear his hair in a pony tail. He also wears sunglasses during the

robberies, and carries a black backpack or JanSport bag. Witnesses say he has gained considerable weight during the past year. The suspect is in his early 30's, 6'0"-6'2" and 240-260 pounds.

**Unknown (Murder)** -- On March 25, 1998 Jill Ann Weatherwax was found stabbed to death in a barren lot in Fresno, California. Witnesses from the night before reported that Jill had requested the use of a room at the Villa Motel in Fresno, California, to sexually service three Hispanic males. The witnesses eventually asked Jill to leave their room. She left and reluctantly entered an automobile with the three men at approximately 11:00pm on the evening of March 24. Her body was found the next morning. All three men she was with are described as relatively clean-cut, wearing a white or light-colored t-shirt and dark pants. They may be farm laborers. They were in their mid to late 20's, 5'6"-5'10" and 150-160 pounds.

**Geraldo Garcia-Michel (Vehicular Homicide)** -- On September 29, 1997 Garcia-Michel struck and killed 64-year-old Leslie Ruby. Ruby, who was on a riding lawn mower, was turning into his driveway after mowing his daughter's lawn. Garcia-Michel fled the accident scene and hasn't been seen since. Garcia-Michel has worked in the construction field, and may be laying tile. He is a known cocaine user. Garcia-Michel is 30, 5'4" and 160-180 pounds.

**UPDATES:**

**Percy Wayne Froman (Murder)** -- Froman is wanted for murder and aggravated robbery. In the early morning hours of February 12, 1999 Froman fatally stabbed 50-year-old John Crumley, a Birmingham, Alabama resident he had befriended, then took off in Crumley's father's truck. Police say Froman has been known to hustle older men for money, but are not sure what his relationship was with Crumley. Crumley's father's truck was later recovered near Atlanta, Georgia. From Atlanta, authorities now know Froman went to Tyler, Texas where, on March 9, 1999, he beat and robbed a local motel clerk. He hasn't been seen since. Froman has used the aliases William Froman, Paul Fremont, Perez Wayne Froman, and Pers W. Froman. He has also used the surname Freeman. He has crooked and chipped front teeth, and his eyebrows slightly connect over the bridge of his nose. He may have dyed his hair blond, and may have facial hair. He talks a lot, and talks big, drives fast and recklessly, and is known to have a crack habit. He frequents gay nightclubs. Froman has a criminal history for larceny, credit card fraud, and drug possession, and has spent time in jail in several states. Froman may have been spotted in New Orleans. Froman is 29, 6'2" and 170 pounds. (See Shows #538 and #540, OADs 4/17/99 and 5/1/99)

**James Bohanna, Jr.** (Aggravated Battery on a Police Officer) -- Bohanna is wanted for shooting and wounding a Kansas City, Missouri police officer on November 11, 1998. The officer was responding to a "shots fired" call when he got into a foot chase with Bohanna. During the chase, Bohanna turned around and fired approximately 10 shots at the officer, hitting him in the foot. Bohanna, who was on parole at the time for a 1993 armed robbery, got away. On February 15, 1999 Bohanna fled from cops again after Fairview Heights, Illinois police officers attempted a felony car stop on him. This time he led them on a high-speed chase, hitting a car and a street sign before running off into a wooded area. Bohanna hasn't been seen since. Bohanna has used the alias James Johnson, and goes by the nicknames "Bushwack" and "Lil James". His weight varies from 120 to 170 pounds depending his drug use at the time. He is reportedly a member of the Metros Prison gang. He smokes cigarettes, "blunts" (marijuana-laced cigars) and marijuana. He was last seen wearing his hair in short, tight braids. Bohanna is 28, 5'2", and approximately 145 pounds. Following the initial broadcast, AMW tipsters told authorities that Bohanna is back in the Kansas City, Missouri area. (See Show #540, OAD 5/1/99)

**John Slarb** -- The Washington, DC Medical Examiner's office has identified the body of a John Doe found on April 17, 1999 as that of John Slarb. The identification of the body came as a direct result of Slarb's story airing as an 8.5 second tease on AMW. Slarb, a 36-year-old heavy equipment operator for the Facchina Construction Company, had been missing since April 15, 1999. Deputies say Slarb's crew stopped work at the Naval Surface Warfare Center in Indian Head due to a heavy downpour that day. Slarb failed to return home from giving a co-worker a ride home after work. On the night of our May 1, 1999 broadcast the hotline received a call from Sgt. Robert Parker with the Metropolitan Police Department's Mobile Crime Lab. The Mobile Crime Lab found a body in a dumpster in South East Washington on April 17, 1999. The body had no identification and was categorized as a "John Doe". When Sgt. Parker watched the show that night he realized that our description of Slarb matched that of his John Doe, right down to the Tasmanian Devil tattoo on the left arm. Det. Eric DeStefano asked Parker to come down to the studio in order to compare notes. After meeting and exchanging information, the men determined that this might be a match, but they needed final confirmation from the medical examiner's office. The confirmation came the following Tuesday night. Sgt. Parker told AMW that without their help Slarb's body may never have been identified. Police want to know what happened to John Slarb and are asking that anyone who has knowledge of the case to come forward. (See Show #540, OAD 5/1/99)

**Unknown (Murder)** -- Hollywood homicide detectives are looking for an unknown African-American male they say killed 26-year-old Paul Johnson on a transit bus. Paul Johnson was a father of four who worked with the elderly at a convalescent hospital, but his one personality quirk was that he harbored a lifelong discomfort of strangers looking at him. On February 7, 1999 Johnson boarded a crowded MTA bus in Arleta, California for a two-hour trip to his mother's house in Baldwin Hills, California. As the bus snaked through Hollywood towards downtown, a man boarded the bus and walked past Johnson on his way to find a seat. Johnson asked the man if he was looking at him, but there was no argument or heated exchange. When the bus stopped at the corner of Highland Avenue and Hollywood Boulevard, cops say the man rose, pulled out a .40-caliber semi-automatic handgun and shot Johnson three times in the head. Johnson was killed instantly. The suspect then coolly walked off the bus and onto Hollywood Boulevard, disappearing into the crowd. The suspect was clean cut, but may have a light moustache and light goatee. He was wearing a light shirt, off-white pants, a long dark coat and tan boots. The suspect is in his early 20's, 5'8"-6'0" and 170-190 pounds.

**Albert Joseph Velarde (Sex Charges)** -- Velarde is wanted for molesting his girlfriend's son at his mother's house in Oakland. On Christmas Eve, 1996, police say Velarde was caught by his girlfriend molesting her son. Velarde was allowed to make bail, but did not return to court. He was last seen in Virginia in 1998. Police say that Velarde is into transvestite and transsexual relationships. During a search of Velarde's house, they discovered quantities of transsexual material. Velarde speaks fluent Spanish and some Russian. He likes to wear lots of gold jewelry and Rolex watches, but he bites his nails and has a nervous twitch. He has a noticeably loud obnoxious laugh with his mouth wide open. He is very vain; he dyes his hair and lies about his age. He once tried to be a professional model. He is well educated, and has worked as a tax attorney. Velarde loves karaoke, but is a remarkably bad singer. He has a "Z" shaped scar on the palm of his left hand. He may wear a beard and/or moustache. Velarde is 49, 5'9" and 160 pounds. (See Show #518, OAD 11/14/98)

On the night of July 16, 1998, Villalobos suddenly drove up in his van, and deliberately fired several shots into a car full of teenagers, fatally wounding sixteen-year-old Joey Cornell. Two of Joey's best friends were also wounded in the unprovoked attack. Joey Cornell was a popular teenager who lived with his mother and sister in the house directly across from the Villalobos residence. Villalobos ambushed Joey to retaliate against the Cornell family. A week prior to the shooting, Villalobos' oldest son, Milton, had been formally arraigned and charged with the statutory sexual rape of Joey's teenage sister. Although Villalobos' wife and children are still living in Las Vegas, police believe he has fled to his native country, El Salvador. His son Milton has pled guilty to the charges pertaining to the rape of the young Cornell girl. Villalobos is known to be a heavy drinker and has a bad temper. He may be working in a restaurant kitchen. Villalobos is 38, 5'6" and 178 pounds.

**Timothy Joe Mobly (Sexual Assault)** -- Federal and local authorities in Reno, Nevada are looking for Timothy Joe Mobly. He was facing life in prison after he admitted raping two women he met on the Internet. Mobly became the subject of a manhunt when he skipped bail and failed to appear at his sentencing hearing on April 30, 1999. Mobly alone pleaded guilty to a November 1998 sexual assault of a 24-year-old woman in Sparks, Nevada. Mobly and an accomplice, Aaron Matthew Cross, earlier pleaded guilty to a January 2, 1999 sexual assault on a second victim, a 17-year-old high school junior. On April 30, 1999 Cross was sentenced to two consecutive life terms in prison. Mobly is an internet fanatic who meets people through "Instant Messaging". He has military training with the air force in military avionics. He has worked as a manager at a department store and recently trained as a railroad conductor. He usually wears wire-rimmed glasses. Mobly may be camping out in the woods. He is 25, 6'0" and 170-180 pounds.

**Kathleen Ann Soliah** (Conspiracy to Commit Murder, Possession of Explosives)

**James William Kilgore** (Possession of Explosives) -- In the 1970's Kathleen Soliah and her boyfriend James Kilgore joined the Symbionese Liberation Army (SLA). The SLA was a terrorist group best known for kidnaping heiress Patricia Hearst, who later joined them. In May of 1974 six members of the SLA were killed during a shootout with the police during which the house in which they were hiding caught fire. Despite the fire, they refused to surrender. After the shootout, only three members of the group were left: William and Emily Harris, and Patricia Hearst. The group needed new members, and they were soon joined by Kathleen Soliah and James Kilgore. Soliah and Kilgore played a major role in the SLA's next wave of terror. In August 1975 three patrol cars blew up in San Francisco. In her memoir Patricia Hearst admits helping plant one of those bombs. The SLA then moved their campaign to Los Angeles. After a pipe bomb failed to detonate under a police cruiser parked outside a Sunset Strip Restaurant, the LAPD ordered an inspection of every patrol car in the city. Several bombs were found before they exploded. A month later, the FBI closed in on the SLA in San Francisco, capturing the HARRIS and Hearst. However, Kathleen Soliah and James Kilgore eluded the authorities. Soliah and Kilgore have been on the run for 25 years. There is a \$25,000 reward for information leading to their arrest and conviction. Soliah is married to a professional man, possibly a lawyer, and has two children. She is a marathon runner. Authorities believe she is not working now, but she has previously worked as a cook, house painter, teacher, and waitress. Soliah is 52, 5'7" and 130 pounds. Kilgore is an accomplished athlete, skilled at basketball and golf. He has worked on a sports book. He has two children, but nothing is known about their mother. He has also worked as a house painter and a cook. Kilgore is 51, 5'10" and 175 pounds.

**James Kopp** (Wanted for questioning) -- Kopp is wanted as a material witness in connection with the 1998 murder of Dr. Barnett Slepian, an abortion doctor, in his home in Amherst, NY. On October 23, 1998, Dr. Slepian was shot and killed in front his family by an unknown sniper with a high powered rifle. A neighbor of Dr. Slepian's told police they had noticed a black Chevy Cavalier with Vermont plates parked on the street near Dr. Slepian's home weeks before the shooting. Authorities traced the plates and the car came back registered to James Kopp, of St. Albans, Vermont. The FBI wants to stress that Kopp is not a suspect in the shooting, they just want to know what information Kopp may have about the murder of Dr. Slepian, and the shooting of four other abortion doctors in the U.S. and Canada. Kopp, whose nickname is "Atomic Dog", has numerous arrests related to anti-abortion protests and is listed on the dedication page of the anti-abortion group "Army of God" terrorist manual. He has a fraternal twin brother named Walter. He is a former Eagle Scout, originally from Pasadena, California, and has a Master's in Marine Biology. Kopp has two cars, a black 1987 Chevy Cavalier with Vermont license plate BPE216, and a 1977 green Dodge, with Vermont license plate BFN959; both cars have been spotted near the areas where abortion doctors have been shot

at. He is a trumpet player and loves to ride bicycles. Kopp wears prescription glasses and may wear a goatee or beard. He is 44, 5'11" and 155-170 pounds. (See Show #517, OAD 11/7/98)

**Unknown (Murder)** -- On September 17, 1998 Las Vegas casino owner Ted Binion's 26-year-old girlfriend, former topless dancer Sandy Murphy, came home and found Ted dead in their Las Vegas home. There was an empty bottle of Xanax lying by him, and police say there was heroin paraphernalia found in the bathroom. Everyone assumed Ted's years of fast living and his battle with heroin addiction finally caught up with him, but the coroner ruled the death "undetermined". Two days after Ted died, sherrifs in Pahrump, 65 miles outside of Las Vegas, discovered three men digging up a huge underground vault. Inside the vault was over four million dollars worth of silver bars and coins. That previous July, Ted had buried the silver. One of the men unearthing the silver was 33-year-old Rick Tabish. Tabish was a former employee of Ted Binion's and he was reportedly having an affair with Ted's girlfriend, Sandy. Obviously, the circumstances surrounding Ted Binion's death were suspicious. On March 18, his death was officially ruled a homicide. All fingers point to Sandy Murphy and Rick Tabish, but authorities have yet to make an arrest in the case.

**David Roger Chavez (Murder)** -- In the early morning hours of February 4, 1995 a party at a local house turned ugly when a fight broke out. During the melee Juan Garcia was shot in the throat. He died a short while later at a local hospital. Several witnesses at the scene identified David Chavez as the shooter. Chavez was a member of the San Chuco gang. He has "David" tattooed on his upper right arm and "Sureno Treses Chavez" tattooed on his chest. He is described as a trouble maker, and should be considered armed and dangerous. Chavez is 23, 5'7" and 170 pounds.

**Eric Robert Rudolph (Causing the Death of a Person, Use of an Explosive)** -- It's hunting season in the Great Smokey Mountains and there's a price on the head of Eric Robert Rudolph. The FBI doesn't want anyone to shoot their most wanted man, but they are asking hunters to look for trash left behind by the accused abortion clinic bomber. Agents in Murphy, North Carolina put together a sampling of trash they say they've found abandoned by Rudolph. They're asking the thousands of hunters in the area to keep their eyes peeled for Rudolph clues. The woodsman has been burying his trash in an attempt to hide it, but it hasn't worked. Back in the summer, agents actually fingerprinted some of the trash they found and confirmed that it belonged to Rudolph. Inspired by the million-dollar reward, bounty hunters have descended on the area as well, but no one wants to see Rudolph behind bars more than Felicia Sanderson, a widow and mother of two. Her husband, Officer Robert "Sandy" Sanderson was killed by a bomb placed outside a women's clinic in Birmingham, Alabama - a bomb agents say was planted by Rudolph. It took guts, but Felicia traveled to the Smokey Mountains where her husband's

killer is believed to be hiding out. She went there to lend her support to the hundreds of investigators working the case. She even used a local radio broadcast to send her plea to the community. Felicia knows that some groups sympathize with Rudolph on political grounds - that they say he was doing "God's work." In response, she doesn't mince words: "God didn't have anything to do with murdering Sandy. Eric Rudolph done that all by himself." Agents say that Eric Robert Rudolph was seen on January 29, 1998, fleeing the scene of the bombing of the New Woman All Women Clinic in Birmingham, Alabama. Immediately after the bomb went off, witnesses saw a man wearing a wig running from the site. Three witnesses saw his truck pull away, and were able to provide a description and a license plate number. The truck was traced to Rudolph, but he had already made his escape. Agents say Rudolph's bomb was loaded with nails - a bomb designed not just to damage property, but to kill and maim. It did both: Birmingham Police Officer Robert "Sandy" Sanderson lost his life. Nurse Emily Lyons was severely injured by the homemade shrapnel - she lost her left eye, lost some of the sight in her right eye, and suffered several broken bones and burns. Despite speculation that Rudolph has been close to extremist groups, friends of Officer Sanderson can't view his death as part of a political action. Even though Sanderson was moonlighting as a security guard for a family planning clinic, they say he was outside of the abortion controversy - that he was just doing his job: enforcing the law. Rudolph is also wanted for questioning in a series of deadly Atlanta bombings: the 1996 Centennial Olympic Park bombing that killed one and injured more than one hundred others, an attack on an abortion clinic in January 1997 that injured seven, and a February 1997 attack on a gay nightclub. Authorities confirmed that they are investigating similarities in the construction of Rudolph's alleged bomb and the others. In particular, they're investigating a possible match between the nails in the Birmingham bomb and those in the Atlanta bombs. Rudolph has been described as a mysterious and reclusive man from the rugged mountains of North Carolina. Rudolph's truck was found in a pasture near Murphy, North Carolina on February 7, 1998. Though agents believe it's likely that he's taken to the wilderness to hide, they're confident that the \$1 million price on his head will make it hard for Rudolph to hide for long. Authorities also note similarities to Rudolph's known techniques in the bombing of an abortion clinic in Asheville, North Carolina on March 13, 1999. Rudolph, who has used the alias Bob Randolph, has worked as a carpenter and spent 18 months in the U. S. Army. He has a reputation for anti-government views. He is estranged from family. He is an experienced woodsman and completed army survival training. Rudolph is 32, 5'11" and 150 pounds. **Unknown** (Murder Of A Police Officer) -- Chris Horner thought he had it made when he made the cut at the Haines City Police Department. An eleven-year career in the Navy had prepared him for law enforcement, and his superiors say he took to police work like a duck to

water. His home life was just as happy, with his and his wife's children from a previous marriage making a total of six kids looking to him for support and guidance. But for his widow, Felecia, the world ended on March 3, 1998. Officer Horner started his shift, alone, by checking the cemetery, a known dumping place for stolen cars. His last radio transmission, at 6:38 a.m., revealed that he was stopping to check a dark Crown Victoria without license plates. Five minutes later, he failed to respond to his dispatcher's follow-up call. Officers responding to the scene found Chris on the ground with a bullet wound in his head. **Alan Pilon** (Murder, Aggravated Assault, Carjacking) -- Alan "Monte" Lamonte Pilon is suspected of being one of the gunmen who began to terrorize police and citizens along the Utah-Colorado border on Friday, May 29. Of the three men who allegedly set off a massive manhunt along the Utah-Colorado border, Pilon has been named as the most anti-government. Pilon has allegedly been linked to the Four Corners Patriots, a secretive paramilitary organization. He also reportedly had a strong grudge against the IRS for a \$1,500 debt. Pilon hails from Dove Creek, Colorado, where he lived a pretty typical life, although some claimed that he hung out with a tough crowd and, according to the Durango Herald, the mayor of Dove Creek recalls Pilon getting into trouble for allegedly breaking into the junior high school and stealing electronics. Police say the last positive sighting of Pilon and McVean was on June 28, 1998, when a little girl in Montezuma Creek, Colorado, reported she saw two men trying to steal a water truck belonging to her uncle. She identified Pilon and McVean from pictures she was shown. Pilon is known to wear thick, wire-rimmed glasses. He may walk with a limp due to ankle injuries from a motorcycle accident. He was last seen wearing camouflage clothing. He may be armed with automatic weapons. He has worked as a construction worker. Pilon has a history of anti-government views and was convicted of DUI in Durango, Colorado in 1992. Pilon is 31, 6'1" and 220 pounds. In early July authorities deliberately set fires in the wilderness area where Pilon and McVean are believed to be hiding out, in hopes of driving the two men out into the open, but the plan was unsuccessful. **Jason Wayne McVean** (Murder, Aggravated Assault, Carjacking) -- Jason Wayne McVean is suspected of being one of the gunmen who began to terrorize police and citizens along the Utah-Colorado border on Friday, May 29. Officials still have no idea where McVean is hiding out, but they have learned some details about his past, details that are so normal they make the current events even more mysterious. McVean has had only minor altercations with the law prior to the current manhunt. After he dropped out of high school, he was arrested for underage consumption of alcohol, driving a motorcycle without eye protection, and first-degree

criminal trespass, according to the Durango Herald. Relatives say that McVean lived in a camper-trailer south of Durango. **James Richard Bennett** (rape; sexual abuse) -- Bennett is wanted in New York and Missouri for raping his two daughters from the time they were two years old until they were about eleven years old. Bennett has been a fugitive since November 22, 1987. Bennett would sneak into the girls' bedroom several times a week and order them to undress from the waist down. He would tell them it was okay because he loved them very much. When the girls were in the fifth grade they told their teachers about the abuse. Before officials could have the girls tested for the abuse, Bennett packed up his family and took them on the road. State police found the family living in a trailer by a New York roadside. The children were placed into foster care and Bennett fled. After AMW featured Bennett in 1994, investigators learned that he had been living alone in a trailer in Arkansas. Officials now believe Bennett is "riding the rails" or hitchhiking with truck drivers. The last confirmed sightings of Bennett were in a rail yard in El Paso, Texas in April 1997, and then at a friend's house in Southern California in June 1997. Bennett has numerous tattoos, including an anchor on his lower left arm, "Jim" on his upper left arm, a dragon on his upper right arm, a dove on his right forearm, a skull and crossbones on his right hand, a cross on the back of his left shoulder, the word "Horoscope" on his right shoulder, and the word "Suck" on his left leg. He is going bald, but has big bushy eyebrows and may be wearing glasses. He may wear a leather belt with his name etched on it. He is a cigarette smoker, although he has had heart attacks and takes heart medication. He may be working in a mill, driving a truck, picking crops, homeless or riding the rails. He may have been spotted

**CAPTURED:**

**Unknown (2 Suspects) (Armed Robbery)** -- According to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, a slot machine vendor was robbed on December 28, 1997 by two unknown suspects. Police say a short time after midnight, two female workers and a security guard were taking a break outside. Two suspects approached them and demanded access to the building. One of the female workers let the suspects in, while Suspect #1 held a shotgun on the security guard. As the suspects and hostages were moving through the building, the security guard grabbed the shotgun and a struggle ensued. One of the females tried to help him, but was pushed away. The female workers opened the door to the vault area. Detectives say Suspect #2 dragged the security guard into the vault and bound his hands and feet. As Suspect #1 watched over the security guard, Suspect #2 went to get the cash with the two female workers. Detectives say the suspects were seen leaving, dragging two duffle bags filled with hundreds and twenties. Police say they took off in a small truck with a camper shell. The race of the suspects is unknown, but police think Suspect #2 is probably a man. The suspects wore masks, coveralls of some kind and carried a handgun and either a rifle or shotgun. Suspect #1, who carried the shotgun, is described as skinny, did not speak during the robbery, and "walked like a woman". Suspect #2 "walked like a farmer" and is heavy-set. Following the broadcast, a keen-eyed detective noticed that one of the employees, Kathy Toledo, did not react to the armed robbers in a normal fashion, which made him suspect she was in on the robbery. An anonymous tipster gave authorities clues as to the actual robbers, which led them back to Kathy Toledo. Toledo had a severe gambling problem, and the tipster even identified the bank where \$81,000 of the holdup money was in a safety deposit box in her name. Toledo had quit work, claiming disability from an injury suffered in the robbery. However, in a six month period Toledo gambled away more than \$1 million. When confronted with the evidence, she identified Eric Zessman and Richard Ganz as the actual robbers. Ganz, former prison employee, met Zessman at a Nevada prison where Zessman was serving time for murdering his own 2-year-old son. Upon his release, Zessman met Ganz' brother Thane, who served as the driver of the getaway car. Thane's former girlfriend was -- Kathy Toledo, who told the men how easy it would be to rob the place where she worked. All those involved in the robbery have now been taken into custody. **James Bohanna, Jr.** (Aggravated Battery on a Police Officer) -- Bohanna is wanted for shooting and wounding a Kansas City, Missouri police officer on November 11, 1998. The officer was responding to a "shots fired" call when he got into a foot chase with Bohanna. During the chase, Bohanna turned around and fired approximately 10 shots at the officer, hitting him in the foot. Bohanna, who was on parole at the time for a 1993 armed robbery, got away. On February 15, 1999 Bohanna fled from cops again after Fairview Heights, Illinois police officers attempted a felony car stop on him. This time he led them on a high-speed chase, hitting a car and a street sign before running off into a wooded area. **Jon Onuma** (Wanted for Kidnaping) -- Police would like to question Jon Onuma regarding the disappearance of Kristen Modafferi, who has been missing from the San Francisco Bay area since June 23, 1997 (See below). Kristen had only been in the Bay area for 23 days before she vanished. She arrived on June first to attend a summer photography course at UC Berkeley. Kristen worked part-time during the week at Spinelli's coffee shop and weekends at Cafe Musee at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art. Kristen was last seen leaving work at Spinelli's coffee shop at 3:00pm on June 23rd. She reportedly told fellow employees that she was interested in going to the beach in the Lands End area, and had asked for directions. The manager of Spinelli's says he saw Kristen leave the Galleria alone a short time later. Bloodhounds picked up Kristen's scent from Spinelli's to the Geary Street #38 bus that goes across town to Sutro Park Beach area near Lands End. Subsequently, her scent was picked up at the Sutro Park beach, supporting the belief that Kristen did indeed visit that beach area late in the afternoon of June 23, 1997. A month after Kristen disappeared a man called a local television station claiming to know where Kristen's body was. The caller told the TV station that two women killed Kristen because of a lesbian love triangle and dumped her body in Marin County under a bridge. Kristen's body wasn't there and police quickly learned the two women of any blame. But the two women led police to the original caller -- Jon Onuma. When questioned, Onuma admitted making the call but denied any further knowledge of Kristen's disappearance. Police believe Onuma knows more than he's saying and want to question him further. Onuma has burn mark scars. He uses the nicknames "Jade", "Toshi" and "Master Jade". He has waist-length hair, may have a slight mustache, and bites his fingernails totally off. He plays guitars and is skilled in computers. He has a history of victimizing women through telepersonal, internet, and personal ads. Onuma is 37, 5'2" and 140 pounds.

**Keith Milo Taylor** (Attempted Murder of a Police Officer)

**Matthew Taylor** (Attempted Murder of a Police Officer, Drug Charges) -- On Thanksgiving Day, November 26, 1998, Deputies from the Carteret County Sheriff's Office went to the home of 21-year-old Matthew Taylor. Taylor had missed an April 1998 court appearance

They say the shooter was 49-year-old Keith Taylor, Matthew Taylor's father. They say he was firing at the officers from another house owned by Keith's grandparents. Matthew and Keith Taylor fled into nearby woods and have not been seen since. Law enforcement officials believe that Keith Taylor is paranoid of law enforcement and the government and has been stockpiling weapons and food. The Taylors are considered armed and dangerous. Keith Taylor has scars from nine gunshot wounds in his right shoulder, torso, and legs. He is a Vietnam veteran and trained survivalist who could be living in camp grounds or militia compounds. He may have white-supremacist/militia ideals. He is a gun collector. He may be working in home construction. Keith Taylor is 49, 5'6" and 155 pounds. Matthew Taylor has a scar on his left arm. He cuts his hair very short. He smokes cigarettes and is a known drug user. He may be working with his father. Matthew Taylor is 21, 5'4" and 140 pounds.

**Unknown (Murder)** -- Detectives are looking for the person or persons responsible for the death of 20-year-old Allen Adams. He disappeared from his army base, Fort Myer in Arlington, Virginia, on July 31, 1967. The army claimed Allen went AWOL because many soldiers were skipping town to dodge the Vietnam war. His parents searched for him for more than 30 years. On December 18, 1996 his remains were found by a construction worker tearing down a building at 10th and E Street NW in Washington, DC. Many articles were found in his pockets. Detectives say Allen probably got into a fight and was killed. They then suspect that his body was stashed in the walls or floorboards of the building. The building was known as the "Crown Bar and Grill". The second floor was the Apex Billiard Pool Hall and the third floor and attic were vacant. Police believe Allen's body was hidden on the third floor or in the attic. Police are trying to locate anyone who may know something about Allen's murder or his final days.

**Ricardo Londell Harris (Escape, Armed Robbery)** -- Ricardo Londell Harris is wanted by Michigan police for escape and by Oaklawn police for questioning in a double homicide and robbery. Michigan police say Harris escaped from Genesee Prison on May 7 by overpowering a deputy. Harris was returning from a medical examination when he hijacked the deputy's car and stole her 40-caliber semi-automatic. Police believe he then ditched the car and hijacked another man. No one saw or heard from Harris until he showed up in the Chicago area days later. A witness said he tried to pawn the deputy's weapon outside a hotel in Chicago. At this time, deputies only want to question the couple. The male suspect is 25-30, 5'10" with a slim build. The female suspect is in her mid-20's, 5'6", and was full-term pregnant in March 1999.

**Joseph Daniel Bocklett** (Rape of a juvenile) -- Bocklett is wanted by the La Mesa Police Department for the sexual molestation of his four-year-old stepdaughter in February of 1995. Police say that while his wife was at work, Bocklett was sexually molesting her daughter. The brave little girl finally got up enough courage to tell her mother the horrible truth. Bocklett's wife called police and Bocklett took off and hasn't been seen since. Authorities say Bocklett has been in prison before, and if he is caught and convicted, he may be going away from a very long time thanks to the "Three Strikes" rule. Bocklett has thinning hair, but may have shaved his head and may wear a mustache. The FBI says they have now proven they were right all along, and have arrested several of Ghannt's friends at the same time. On Saturday October 4, 1997, Ghannt worked his regular shift - punching out at a little after 6:30 p.m. But unlike every other Saturday night, on this night Ghannt didn't go home to his wife. FBI agents say he waited in the parking lot until his coworkers left, then he returned to the office where he spent an hour loading more than \$14 million into an unmarked company van. Then at about 8 p.m., Ghannt left for the day -- and maybe for good. By Sunday morning, Ghannt's wife, Tammy was in a panic. She hadn't heard from her normally reliable husband all night. She was certain he'd met with foul play; she had no idea he may have been involved in his own foul play. Police found Ghannt's red pickup truck in the Loomis-Fargo parking lot - right where he'd left it. It was then that the company discovered that loot and van were missing. On Monday, agents found the van. It had been abandoned about 10 miles away and there were several million dollars inside it. But Ghannt and about \$12 million are still missing. Working on a hunch that Ghannt didn't work alone, the FBI kept tabs on his friends and associates - and the tabs they ran up. Agents say that Steve and Michelle Chambers moved from their mobile home to a \$635,000 house, and that Michelle Chambers celebrated the bank job with a breast job. Kelly Campbell went for liposuction. Before long, agents were tapping phones and watching closely. Finally, an affidavit claims, a conversation between Steve Chambers and a Michael McKinney not only located Ghannt's Mexico hideout, but may have saved his life. Agents say that Chambers and McKinney were plotting to have Ghannt killed within a few days of the conversation. Ghannt was arrested in Mexico without incident, and will spend seven and a half years in jail. An alert bank officer alerted the FBI when Michelle Chambers attempted to make a large cash deposit -- with the Loomis Fargo cash bands still in place! When the others were arrested, Steve Chambers plead guilty and received a sentence of eleven years. The women are awaiting trial. The FBI auctioned off the Chambers' extravagant

**Delvin T. Groat (Rape of a Child, Child Molestation)** -- Delvin Groat is wanted by the Aberdeen, Washington police department for raping and molesting children in the community of Grays Harbor, Washington. Groat systematically raped and photographed two girls, ages six and four, while they were placed in his home for foster care. Groat was arrested on March 29, 1996, but was released to await trial a couple of days later. He fled the jurisdiction shortly afterward and has remained at large. Groat is a deeply religious member of the Pentecostal faith, and has served as a youth minister in church. He has worked as a millwright in lumber factories. Groat is 40, 5'9" and 160 pounds.

**Carlos Mario Felix - (Rape, Kidnap, Assault)** -- Carlos Felix is wanted for the rape, kidnapping and assault of a 17-year-old woman on September 22, 1996. In the early morning hours of that day, the victim was leaving a nightclub with her friends when they met Felix, who was introduced as a "friend of a friend". Felix offered the group a ride home in his cab. The group accepted and Felix drove them all to an address in Manhattan. During the ride, the victim complained that she still had to get back to New Jersey. Felix offered her a ride, as he was going that way himself. Felix drove the victim to the Westside Highway on Manhattan, where he pulled the car over and raped her. He then continued to drive her into New Jersey. They were traveling at a high rate of speed on Route 80 in New Jersey when the victim realized that Felix was not driving towards her house. In fear of her life, the victim jumped out of the car and rolled onto the highway. A passing motorist eventually picked her up and took her to Hackensack hospital. With the victim's help, police tracked down Felix's cab, but Felix had abandoned it and has not reappeared since. Felix has used the aliases Carlos Felic and Carlos M. Feliz-Melo. He has a long surgery scar down the entire length of the center of his chest. He doesn't speak English very well, and has variously claimed to be from the Dominican Republic and Puerto Rico. He is a known cocaine user. Felix is 32, 5'9" and 200 pounds. (See Show #529, OAD 2/13/99)

**Keith J. Gardner** (Wanted for Questioning) -- The police in Fairfax County, Virginia are looking for Gardner to see what he knows about the triple murder of his parents and his grandfather. He is also wanted for a probation violation for a narcotics charge. On May 11, 1999 the bodies of Jimmy Gardner, Jannis Gardner and Elmer Gardner were found in a World War II era fallout shelter in the back yard of their home. They had been stabbed in the house and dragged out to the shelter. The bodies were covered in limestone powder and had been thrown into the shelter. The door of the shelter was then caulked shut. Although Gardner hasn't been charged with these murders, police would definitely like to talk to him, as he gave false statements to friends of the victims, saying the three victims were in Arkansas when they were actually in the fallout shelter. Gardner may wear a mustache and may still have track marks on his left arm from drug use. He is a plumber by trade, but has also worked construction and as a delivery man. He has a quick temper, drinks beer and cheap vodka, and smokes Salem Lights. He likes to gamble on sports. He has used most drugs, and is addicted to Dilaudid, a synthetic pill form of heroin. Gardner is 39, 5'10" and 165 pounds.

**Martha Ann Gomez** (Sexual Assault of a Child) -- Gomez is wanted for sexually assaulting three girls between the ages of 13 and 15 from 1996 to 1998. Gomez posed as a teenage boy and usually met her victims through phone chat/sex lines. She preyed upon girls with low self-esteem, touting herself as someone who would listen to their problems. The conversations eventually escalated to actual meetings where Gomez sexually assaulted the girls. When the girls, who still believed Gomez was a man, tried to break out of the relationship, Gomez threatened their lives and their families' lives. In at least one case, police say Gomez used a gun. Police figured Gomez out and arrested her in the fall of 1998 on one count of aggravated sexual assault of a child. She bonded out. On November 24, when she was supposed to appear in court, and as police were filing three additional charges against her, Gomez disappeared. Gomez may have cut her hair and dyed it blonde. She has acne scars on both cheeks, "Gomez" tattooed on her lower left arm near her wrist and "ACE" on her upper left arm near the biceps. She has a very masculine walk, and hunches down as she walks. She claims she injured her back years ago when working in a candle factory, and used to receive disability checks for a dislocated disc in her back. She usually does factory work. Gomez has used several aliases, including Emilio Garrison, Eric Garrison, and Eric Barragan. Gomez is 34, 4'9" and 115-125 pounds.

**Santiago Sanchez** (Sexual Abuse) -- Maryland police are looking for sex offender Santiago Sanchez. They say he molested his three stepchildren for two years. Sanchez is charged with three counts of sexual abuse and is believed to be in the Langley Park area. He disappeared after making bond. He is still receiving disability checks but authorities are unclear as to who is cashing them. Sanchez can be recognized by his crooked teeth and limp. He has

**Markeith Lamar Braxton** (Murder, Armed Robbery) -- On the morning of January 11, 1997, Igor Razilov, a hard-working Russian immigrant with a wife and two children, was sitting behind the safety of bulletproof glass in a South Central Los Angeles pawn shop. His boss, Tony, had gone to the bank, and Igor was working alone. That's when, police say, Markeith Braxton and his partner in crime walked through the front door. The scene that unfolded that morning was caught on a disturbing video surveillance tape. Posing as customers, the two suspects asked for assistance with a television set, and Igor left his cage. After he helped them and returned, they called for help again. Again, the unsuspecting victim exposed himself to danger, and it came. The robbers tried to wrestle him to the ground and get behind the counter, and when Igor fought back, police say, Braxton pulled his 9mm Glock pistol and shot him through the head. The suspects immediately panicked and ran out the door empty-handed, only to find that their getaway driver had panicked as well, and had left without them. They fled on foot and disappeared into the vast Los Angeles metropolis. Police had plenty of evidence, but they had no suspects until a year later, when someone caved in. In January 1998, one of the accomplices was identified by a former jailhouse informant arrested on a narcotics charge. Police soon had the suspected accomplice and the driver in custody, and then the name of the alleged shooter - Markeith Braxton. After Braxton's profile was aired on America's Most Wanted, one of the citizens who came forward was his own mother, who, after watching the video tape, pleaded with her son to turn himself in. The other important call that came in to AMW was from someone who reportedly grew up with Braxton and knew where his family could be found. This sent police to Kansas City, Missouri, to the home of Braxton's grandmother. There, they found another fugitive from California - the suspect's uncle, Bruce Williams. Williams, who had an outstanding warrant for drug possession, was arrested and gave police their next clue. Braxton's father, Jessie Braxton, would know where his son was hiding, the fugitive reportedly told detectives. The search moved back to California, where, after a little digging, police learned that Jessie Braxton also had an outstanding warrant and was now living in Los Angeles under an assumed name. After he was arrested, it wasn't long before he agreed to cooperate with police in finding his son. He reportedly was convinced that the cops would kill his 19-year-old son in a shootout if he didn't lead the LAPD to his hideout. Wearing a wire, Jessie Braxton reportedly visited a friend of Markeith Braxton and got a phone number. When he called his son, the murder suspect wouldn't give his exact location, but gave him enough information about his surroundings for police to spring into action. Markeith Braxton was arrested near 42nd and Kansas Streets in Los Angeles. He was discovered walking casually

toward the back door of an apartment complex, where police say he planned to make his getaway. If Braxton is convicted, he could face the death penalty. (See Shows #460, #488 and #493, OADs 8/2/97, 4/4/98 and 5/2/98)

**Daniel Fling** (Murder) -- On April 25, 1998, deputies in Iron County, Utah, responded to a call from a rancher. He'd found a suspicious truck abandoned on his property. The plates were missing, but the truck's VIN number revealed that it belongs to accused murderer, Daniel Fling. Friends, family, and associates describe Daniel Fling as driven, ambitious, and full of promise. After completing high school and college in just six years, the son of a prominent Texas attorney chose to follow in his father's footsteps by enrolling at the University of Oklahoma Law School. At the age of 24, he was just shy of graduation when he met Kathryn Canning -- a meeting that would change both of their lives forever. Kathryn had studied hard to make the grade at University of Oklahoma Law School, but found herself struggling. She needed help, and Daniel's academic reputation suggested to her that he was just the sort of help she needed. His other reputation as something of a loner wasn't her concern. But, Kathryn says, as they studied together for long hours, Fling soon became obsessed with his classmate. His phone calls and conversations grew more personal and more suggestive. Before long she realized that he was determined to possess her. Kathryn's heart, however, belonged to another. She had been seeing 35-year-old Greg Randall who would regularly drive 180 miles from Ft. Worth, Texas to be with Kathryn in Norman, Oklahoma. One of these trips placed him at Kathryn's door as she was studying with Fling. As Kathryn and Greg embraced, Kathryn noticed that Fling's expression turned to an icy stare. She believes that this is when he set himself on a deadly course. On January 8, 1998, Kathryn received a phone call from Greg, who could barely contain himself. He had picked out a ring, and if Kathryn would accept it, they would be married. Kathryn, of course, accepted. The next day she received another phone call, but this one was from Fling. She recalls that he told her he was going to make her suffer for not accepting his advances, and that he had a sawed-off shotgun in his car, "ready to go." That day, Fort Worth Police received a frantic 911 call. A neighbor had just found Greg in his doorway -- he'd been shot in the head at point-blank range with a shotgun. A man matching Fling's description was seen running from the grisly scene. Police say Fling spent the weekend packing up his belongings. He stopped by his father's home to drop off his beloved cat, then he disappeared. When Utah deputies found Fling's getaway truck police had their first lead in months. Unfortunately, it's impossible to tell how long the truck has been there. Left behind in the truck, deputies found a bewildering array of evidence: an empty gun case, spent shells, new scuba gear, bike gear - but no bicycle, and strangely, cat food. Did Fling set out on bicycle and travel far from Iron County, Utah? Or did he simply take a gun and disappear into the Utah wilderness, armed to do battle with whoever got in his way? Perhaps he planned to battle his own inner demons. Fling is usually clean-shaven. He wears baseball caps and his ears stick out noticeably. He may wear glasses or blue-tinted

contact lenses. He writes poetry and is knowledgeable about computers. He owns firearms, is an avid target shooter, and police suspect ties to militias. He enjoys camping and has a quiet personality. Fling is 25, 6'1" and 150 pounds. (See Shows #488, #497 and #515, OADs 4/4/98, 5/30/98 and 10/10/98)

**AMW ALL-POINTS BULLETINS:**

**Unknown (Bank Robbery)** -- The FBI is looking for a bank robber described as calm, congenial, armed, and dangerous. As this suspect enters the bank, he appears to be the most pleasant customer to grace the teller's window. Often, he discusses opening an account for a business, opening an account for his wife, or just getting some change rolled. Once the tellers are charmed and off-guard, out comes a black semi-automatic pistol. After this point, there's no need for him to be polite. Agents say that this robber has ripped off eleven banks in as many cities, all within 200 miles of Kansas City, Missouri. Banks in Kansas, Nebraska, and Missouri have met with his dubious charms. He always carries a plastic grocery store bag, which he typically hands to the trembling teller. His travel patterns and demeanor suggest a traveling salesman who has found a lucrative sideline. So far, no one has been shot, but after he was surprised in Web City, Missouri when a customer walked into a robbery in progress, he forced the customer to the floor. These sort of unexpected surprises will, agents say, lead to someone getting hurt or killed. The suspect has a medium build, wears his hair short or clean cut, has a neatly-trimmed mustache and wears wire-rimmed glasses. He wears a thick gold wedding band on his left ring finger, and usually sports a baseball cap, wind breaker, sweat shirt, khaki pants, and loafers. He carries a cellular phone clipped to his pants or belt. He appears knowledgeable about construction and small business. The suspect is in his mid-30's to early 40's, 6'2"-6'3" and 220-230 pounds. **David Cosby Crowe (Mail Fraud, Money Laundering)**

**Martha Jackson Crowe (Mail Fraud, Money Laundering)** -- David Crowe and his wife, Martha Crowe, are wanted for operating a pyramid scheme that bilked 96,000 people of 48 million dollars over a 16 month period from November 1993 to March 1995. Postal Service agents say the Crowes had been operating Gold Unlimited in Madisonville, Kentucky, which they claimed was a multi-level marketing company. Authorities say Gold Unlimited recruited thousands of investors because it marketed itself as a gold investment company. Recruits would invest a minimum of \$200 and when they recruited two more individuals they would be rewarded with a gold coin worth about \$400. Investors were actually encouraged to invest more than the initial \$200 so their return would be greater. U.S. Postal Inspectors began investigating Gold Unlimited after they received consumer complaints that the company was actually a
