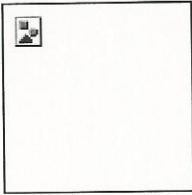

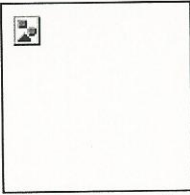

"OIS NELSON FIGUEROA" - An officer of the Palm Springs Police Department responds to a home invasion call. The victim of the home invasion robbery tells a dispatch operator that a man held him at gun-point, tied him up and then fled in his vehicle. During a routine search of the neighborhood, he spots the stolen vehicle and gives chase. The dangerous suspect eventually disables the victim's vehicle by crashing into a fire hydrant. He bails out of the vehicle and flees on foot. After jumping a couple of walls the desperate suspect is found in the backyard of a nearby residence. The officer is forced to shoot the suspect in the leg after he points a gun at him. "A SHOOTING AT UNM" - An officer of the Albuquerque Police Department is dispatched to a shopping center near the campus of UNM where a man in a wheelchair is in a stand-off with campus police. The unstable suspect is reported to have fired several rounds from his shotgun in the parking lot of the shopping center. During the brief stand-off, the suspect unexpectedly gets out of his wheelchair and fires several rounds at the officers and is subsequently wounded by return fire. "JUST DROP IT" - Officers of the Lynn Police Department respond to an assault call involving a man with a knife. The officers lend assistance to another unit who has detained the hostile suspect. During an intense stand-off, the defiant suspect marches down a vacant highway ignoring the officer's demands for him to drop his knife. Ultimately the officers are forced to take action. When a patrol car cuts the suspect off, another officer is forced to shoot the man when he lunges at him.
