The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Linda Susan Carroll (Material Witness In A Homicide) -- Police have issued an arrest warrant for Linda Carroll as a material witness in the homicide investigation of Lonnie "Ted" Binion. On September 17, 1998 Las Vegas Casino owner Ted Binion's girlfriend Sandy Murphy, came home and found Ted dead in their Las Vegas home. There was an empty bottle of Xanax lying by him, and police say, there was heroin paraphernalia found in the bathroom. Everyone assumed Ted's years of fast living finally caught up with him. But the coroner ruled the death "undetermined" and on March 16, 1999 Ted's death was officially ruled a homicide. Linda Carroll is a friend of Sandy Murphy's and authorities think she may know something about Binion's death. The police do not know where Ms. Carroll is at this time and are asking the public's assistance in locating her. Carroll may be using the surname "Rothman". She is 42, 5'6" and 108 pounds.

Unknown (2) (Murder) -- West Valley homicide detectives are looking for two men responsible for the death of Christopher Rawlings in February 1999. According to authorities, two unknown men confronted Rawlings when he entered the garage in his car, a \$300,000 Bentley. Police say the victim's wife saw the suspects after they forced her husband to the ground at gun point; she grabbed the couple's two small children, ran onto the roof of the house and called 911. When police arrived, the suspects sped away from the garage in the victim's car. A high speed chase ensued on the Ventura Freeway. After it existed the freeway, police say the Bentley collided with another car and careened into a power pole. The impact of the collision threw Rawlings' body from the trunk of the car, which had caught fire. Rawlings died a few days later from his injuries. Police say the kidnappers fled into the darkness. One of the suspects is believed to have car jacked a Mazda nearby. Searchers with dogs and helicopters were fruitless. Police say the suspects stole jewelry and other property from the Rawlings home. A Rolex Presidential with a diamond face and band; a blue Rolex oyster watch is also missing. Both suspects wore dark clothing, gloves and a mask. One suspect may be bald or have cropped hair. Both suspects are considered armed and dangerous. Both men are in their 20's, 5'10"-6'0" and 160-200 pounds.

Mac Buckley (Unlawful Flight To Avoid Prosecution) -- Mac Buckley, an attorney from Connecticut missing since March 1, 1999, is now a federal fugitive. According to authorities, Buckley was reported missing on March 1, 1999. The last time anyone heard from him was at 12:20 pm the same day, when he phoned to notify his law office he was on the way to a client's court appearance in New Haven, Connecticut. Buckley never arrived at the courthouse. Buckley's wife reported him missing at 5:45 pm the next day. According to police, Buckley was spotted outside Albany, New York on March 5, 1999. Police say Buckley's cellular phone nor credit cards have been used since his disappearance. Investigators also say nothing is missing from Buckley's home. On March 9, Buckley's law license was suspended as a result of complaints against him. A statewide committee concluded that Buckley used fraud and deceit to seize clients' assets worth between \$500,000 and \$1 million. The FBI has issued a UFAP and is working with the Connecticut State Police to locate Buckley. Buckley is a former U.S. Attorney, professional boxing promoter and lawyer to mobsters. He has coached inner-city basketball games. He may be driving a green 1998 Lincoln Navigator with a Patriots sticker in the rear window. Buckley is 57, 5'11" and 230 pounds.

Unknown (Murder) -- 45-year-old Janette Piro and her 42-year-old husband, Chris Benedetto, were native New Yorkers. He was a carpenter and she was an interior decorator. In 1989, Chris was hurt on the job and six years later was awarded a \$2 million worker's compensation settlement. They decided to retire and moved to Singer Island, Florida, north of Palm Beach. With their millions, they bought a new home, a 30-foot boat, expensive fishing rods, a BMW and kept their home stocked with fine wines and good cigars. They lived the good life on the beautiful and ritzy gold coast of Florida. They were very close to their neighbors. On November 11, 1998, when Janette and Chris failed to show up for a birthday party, neighbors became concerned. Three days later Chris' Toyota 4-Runner truck was found in the parking lot of a nearby hotel. The next day concerned neighbors phoned Chris and Janette's family in New York. Chris' two brothers, who are cops in New York, flew to Singer Island on November 18. The next day, they filed a missing persons report on Chris and Janette. They stayed in the couple's home and passed out missing posters all over town. After five days of no sign of the couple, the brothers packed up the house. While unplugging appliances they came across a three foot deep freezer in the garage that Chris used for bait. Inside, they discovered Janette's frozen body. She was killed and stuffed into the freezer. There was still no sign of Chris. Police are unsure if Chris Benedetto is a suspect or another victim. Detectives believe Chris is probably a victim. Missing are 2 to 4 fishing rods and \$100,000 worth of jewelry, including Janette's four carat diamond ring appraised at \$58,000 and her \$12,000 diamond tennis bracelet. Chris' boat was missing its anchor and 10-foot chain. (See Show #522, OAD 12/19/98)

Darrin [Bumper] Mills (Murder, Attempted Murder, Armed Robbery, Arson) -- Mills is wanted by the Battle Creek Police Department and the Michigan State Police Fugitive Team for murder, attempted murder, and armed robbery on January 27, 1999. Mills and Jamie Maclam

heard that there was a lot of cash to be had at the Kings Garden Health Spa. At midnight on January 27, Mills and Maclam entered the small massage parlor and found four Asian women inside, including the owner, two employees and a friend. The two men became upset when they could not find any money except for a \$5 bill. The women were beaten with sticks, pistol whipped, and cut with kitchen knives. Bleach was then poured on the women. To cover up the crime Mills and Maclam burned the business to the ground. Two of the victims were able to crawl away from the burning building to safety. The other two victims, Chin Jo Broderick and Sum Mi Cox, died of smoke inhalation. Three of the four suspects involved in the robbery and murders have been arrested. Angela Chase, Chavez Hall and Jamie Maclam have been arrested by Battle Creek Police, but Mills is still on the run. A \$1,000 reward is being offered. Mills has numerous tattoos on his torso and both arms. He is 30, 5'11" and 180 pounds.

Nathan Genorris Brown III (Murder) -- On October 16, 1997, Police say Nathan Brown was at "Sherry's" bar on Veterans Highway in Millersville, Maryland when he got in a argument with Jeffery Watson, 19 and two of Jeffrey's friends. As a result, police say Brown was asked to leave the bar. An hour later when Jeffery and the others left the bar, police say Brown pulled up behind them and flashed his lights. According to police, when the three men pulled over and got out of their car, Brown started shooting at them with a 12-gauge shot gun. Jeffery was hit by one of the bullets and died shortly after. Police say Brown fled in his pick truck which was recovered the next day in Baltimore City with several guns inside. No one has seen Brown since. Brown uses the nicknames Nick and Nicky. He drinks beer, wears blue jeans, drives pickup trucks and likes country music clubs. He is a registered nurse. Brown is reportedly very confrontational. Brown is 26, 6'3" and 225 pounds.

Gregory Marc Riviera (murder) -- Riviera is wanted for the 1992 murder of his ex-girlfriend, Juliette Rivera. On July 6, 1992, deputies say, Riviera convinced Juliette to meet him and go to a Pescadero, California bar for a drink. Juliette's body was discovered two weeks later in an irrigation pond several miles from the bar. Deputies say Riviera is a chronic liar who always tells tales to women to try and impress them. Juliette told friends that Riviera made her nervous and that was the reason she stopped seeing him. Deputies believe that a jealous Riviera murdered Juliette because she was dating other men. Riviera claims to be of royal Hawaiian descent but is actually Puerto Rican. He is a good cook, specializing in French sauces and likes to eat at fine restaurants. He always pays with cash, from a wad of bills, and does not have charge cards or a checking account. Through exercise, frequent facials and keeping his hair dyed black, he looks much younger than his age. He is 56, 5'10" and 170 pounds. (Shows #270, #303 and #372, OADs 6/4/93, 2/12/94 and 7/15/95).

9-year-old Sarah Skiba, her father Paul Skiba and one of his employees Lorenzo Chivers, has been missing from Westminster, Colorado since February 7, 1999. Police say Paul Skiba owns Tuff Movers, a moving company that parks its trucks in a lot in Westminster, Colorado. Sarah was visiting her father for the weekend and went with him and Lorenzo on the job they had that day. They last seen driving in Littleton, Colorado at around 6:15pm. Police say the truck was found parked at the lot but the three were nowhere to be found. Lorenzo's car was later found in Westminster and Paul's car in Denver. Police found blood and shell casings at the Westminster lot and suspect foul play in the trio's disappearance. Police are asking the public's assistance with any information they may have concerning this case. They are especially interested in anyone that saw the moving van the night of February 7th. Sarah Skiba is very outgoing, friendly, caring and talkative. She likes movies, babies, animals, and singing and dancing. She is a good swimmer and likes to read. She may wear her hair in a ponytail. She has a red scar across the bridge of her nose. Paul Skiba is described as always smiling. He has a mustache, frequently wears jeans and t-shirts, and may be wearing a silver necklace. He has used the alias Craig Michael Nelson. Lorenzo Chivers has a Scorpio symbol tattooed on his right forearm. He is described as a homebody, and has two children.

Police say six-year-old Opal Jennings was abducted on March 26, 1999 from her home in Saginaw, Texas. At around 5:30 that evening Opal was in her front yard playing with two other children when she was apparently abducted. Police say a man parked his car, got out, picked up Opal and put her in the front passenger seat of his car and took off. The abductor was described to police as a white or Hispanic male with shoulder length dark hair, possibly worn in a ponytail. The suspect may have been wearing a dark t-shirt, pants, tennis shoes and a red baseball cap. Police say they think he may have been driving a dark colored car (blue, purple or black) with tinted windows, silver or chrome wheels, bondo or primer spots on the front hood. Authorities say the car has been described as having no front license plate had has a dirty or unkept appearance and may be a Chrysler product. Opal is missing her upper front tooth, and has a lower front tooth just coming in. She has a chicken pox scar on the corner of her left eye. Her nickname is Opal Jo. When last seen, she was wearing a white t-shirt with purple vertical stripes and flowers, purple shorts or pants, white socks, pink and white Barbie tennis shoes, and was wearing her hair in pigtails.

UPDATE:

Unknown (Murder) -- Forty-two-year-old Carole Sund were reported missing February 16, 1999, along with her 15-year-old daughter, Juliana Sund, and 16-year-old Silvina Pelosso, an exchange student. The Sacramento FBI says the women were traveling together. The trio left the San Francisco area on February 12 and planned to go to the University of the Pacific in Stockton, California. Then, authorities say, the three women were going to Yosemite National Park to sightsee. The FBI says the trio was supposed to return to San Francisco and meet Carole's husband Jens at the airport on February 16. They were planning to fly to Arizona to visit the Grand Canyon. The three women never met up with the rest of their group and were reported missing one day later. The women were last seen in the Yosemite area on February 15 and were driving a red Pontiac Grand Prix rental car with California license plates 4BMV025. Carole Sund's wallet was found in Modesto, California on February 19. There is a \$300,000 reward offered. On Thursday, March 18 the women's burnt-out rental car was found at Longbarn, California, some two hours north of the park. The next day authorities announced that two bodies had been found in the trunk of the car. The bodies were identified as Carole and Silvina. Juliana's body was found near Yosemite a few days later. A waitress in Modesto believes she served the women the day after their disappearance. Along Highway 108, near where the car was found, was another possible sighting at a gas station, possibly the same day. A

further report places the women at a nearby gift shop. However, the FBI remains skeptical regarding all three reported sightings. Authorities are investigating several suspects, but to date no one has been charged with the crime. (See Shows #532, #533, #534 and #535, OADs 3/6/99, 3/13/99, 3/20/99 and 3/27/99)

CAPTURED:

Travis Sherod Wilkins (Murder, Attempted Murder, Parole Violation, UFAP) -- In less than six weeks, Travis Sherod Wilkins has collected warrants from police departments in two different states in two different shooting cases. First, on August 15, police in Plainfield, New Jersey say Wilkins got mad in a narcotics dispute. His solution, they say was to retaliate with a drive-by shooting. Two men were injured - one of them is paralyzed. A few weeks later and a few states away...on September 25, police in Cleveland, Ohio say Travis Wilkins showed up, and he was hopping mad again. This time they say the results were fatal - Wilkins broke into the apartment of Robert Taylor and shot him to death. Three others in the apartment were wounded. Following his AMW profile, tipsters led authorities to Wilkins' hideout -- at his girlfriend's apartment in Plainfield. (See Show #515, OAD 10/10/98)

David Sheldon (Child Molestation) -- This pizza delivery man, wanted for 35 counts of child molestation, was profiled in a bumper lasting less than :10. That was enough for AMW tipsters to spot him in Pierce County, Washington. He was captured following a high-speed chase which ended in a standoff at a gas station, where he took four hostages. (See Show #509, OAD 8/29/98)

Fernando Palazuelos Villar (Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sale) -- Police say Fernando Palazuelos Villar is the third member of a family business - drug dealing. He, his father, and his brother allegedly sold Rohypnol, which is legal in Mexico with a prescription. What makes this drug even more sinister than so-called recreational drugs is the fact that it is a favorite among sexual predators for knocking out their victims. Women across the nation have been raped after men slipped Rohypnol, or "roofies" in their drink. Police say Villar and his family own a large share of the blame. They were allegedly known as the largest suppliers on the west coast, and their distribution reached across the nation. In July 1997, Villar's father and brother were arrested, while he was detained for questioning. Later, police charged him with possession and possession for sale, but by then he had fled. Alert viewers placed Villar in Oxnard, California. (See Show #506, OAD 8/8/98)

Nathan Downs (Murder) -- On January 25, 1998, police say, Nathan Downs and friends were leaving San Francisco's popular Trocadero nightclub. Ahead of them were two women. Police say that Downs grabbed the buttocks of one of the women, an act that shocked the woman's boyfriend, Michael Burdette, who got out of his car and approached Downs. Detectives say that Downs shot and killed Michael outside the nightclub. Tipsters located Downs in Oakland, California, and he was in custody within hours of being profiled on AMW. (See Show #505, OAD 8/1/98)

FEATURE:

Fighting Back -- Cherokee Pettis decided to take back the crime-ridden streets of her Brady Heights, Oklahoma neighborhood. First, she put up signs with arrows pointing out crack houses and whore houses. Prostitutes working near her home get hosed down. When a john gets caught, she goes downtown to the Municipal Court and uses the public information system to print out the john's court docket. She then sends a post card to the offender with full information about his arrest and court dates, to let him know the community is aware and watching. Together with her friend Jan Edwards, she also videotapes crimes in progress, drug dealers and sellers, and hookers working the streets of her neighborhood.

Four masked men had broken into his family's Cotati, California home. Police say it was Joel Urena and three accomplices. Steve says the men attacked him and then went into his parents' bedroom. The men demanded money, jewels and guns from Mark and Mary Kerston. When the couple insisted that they had none, one of the men went out to the living room and shot Steve in the leg. When the couple still insisted they had no valuables, the men threatened to shoot Steve in the head. Mercifully, they didn't follow through on the threat. Instead, they grabbed whatever they could get their hands on and took off. Urena has scars on his face from a car accident and another scar on his right hand. Although of Hawaiian heritage, he may appear Hispanic. He may be wearing a moustache. Urena may be driving a 80's-90's silver or blue metallic Chevrolet Blazer or a 80's black Chevrolet Astro van. William Bradford Bishop, Jr. (Murder) -- Bishop is wanted on five separate counts of murder in connection with the bludgeoning deaths of five members of his family at their home in Bethesda, Maryland. On March 2, 1976, a Forestry Service employee from Tyrrell County, North Carolina responded to the scene of a fire and found the bodies of the Bishop family -- Brad Bishop's wife, mother, and three sons -- buried in a shallow grave. A shovel found at the burial site was traced to a hardware store in Potomac, Maryland and the gas can to a Bethesda, Maryland Sears store. On March 8, 1976 police in Montgomery County investigating the family disappearance found the murder scene. Bishop's fingerprints were matched to those on the gas can. The family's station wagon, used to transport the bodies, was found abandoned near the Elkmount Mountain Campground, just outside Gatlinburg, Tennessee. New information from State Department files indicates that Bishop may have fled with the help of a female accomplice, who may have been on parole from a North Carolina prison. Bishop likes to work out several times per week. He is a strong skier, plays tennis, and is fond of hiking and the outdoors. He is an amateur pilot and enjoys riding motorcycles. He reads extensively and may keep a diary or

journal. He is described as intense and self-absorbed, and may be subject to violent outbursts. He may seek psychiatric care for depression or anxiety, and may suffer from insomnia. He likes a neat and orderly environment. He trained as a military intelligence officer, and is well versed in economic analysis and self-hypnosis. He speaks fluent Italian, Serbo-Croatian, Spanish and French. He drinks scotch and wine, and is known to enjoy spicy foods. Bishop is 62, 6'1" and 180 pounds. Victor Rodriguez Casrellanos (Murder, Attempted Murder, Escape) -- Casrellanos is wanted by Los Angeles Sheriff's deputies for a 1990 escape from the Los Angeles County jail system. On March 22, 1990, while awaiting an appeal on his 1988 murder conviction, Casrellanos escaped from L.A. County jail, Hall of Justice. Deputies say Casrellanos faked a knee injury to facilitate a transfer for medical treatment. Prior to boarding the transportation bus, Casrellanos slipped off his handcuffs, rolled under the bus, and escaped out the gate. Casrellanos was convicted of the 1986 murder of Angel Herrera and the attempted murder of Angel's brother, Raonel. On December 13, 1986, Casrellanos tried to steal Herrera's ring and a fight broke out in an apartment stairwell. Casrellanos was sentenced on June 9, 1988 to 44 years in Folsom prison. He had been returned to the Los Angeles county jail system to await his appeal. Casrellanos has a full-length tattoo of the Virgin Mary on his back, and a heart with a crown of thorns on his chest. He has a knife scar from his left wrist down to his index finger, and his left middle finger is crooked. Casrellanos is a Mexican national who speaks and writes English fluently. He is probably double jointed. He wears prescription glasses and may have a Fu Manchu mustache. He is associated with the 18th Street King Blvd South street gang. He is a body builder, and has worked as a mechanic in body shops. His nickname, "Mago", which means "magician" in Spanish, refers to his talent as an amateur magician. He has performed as a magician in minor clubs and lounges in Las Vegas. Casrellanos has used several aliases, including Victor Ramirez Rodriguez, Victor Martinez Rodriguez, Victor Martinez Casrellanos, and has used alternative spellings of his last name including Castrellanos and Castellanos. Police say 5-year-old Katheryne Lugo was abducted from her mother's Riviera Beach, Florida home on Saturday, January 8, 1994. Katheryne's mother, Francisca Moya, last saw her daughter at about 5:00am Saturday morning before leaving for work. Moya left her daughter in the care of her live-in boyfriend, Misbah Kazi. When Moya returned from work, Katheryne was gone. At the time of Katheryne's abduction, there were reports that Kazi had been verbally and physically abusive to Moya, who was then nine months pregnant with his child. Police had reason to believe that Kazi kidnapped Katheryne to persuade Moya to give up custody of their unborn child. Misbah Kazi was arrested and charged with kidnapping on January 8, 1994. In September, nine months after Katheryne's disappearance, Kazi appeared in court to face the kidnapping charges. He was found not guilty. Although Kazi was acquitted, the FBI kept the case open tracking Kazi's every move. He was always their main suspect. They hoped he would eventually lead investigators to Katheryne. Months after his trial he started making threatening phone calls to Moya with promises - never fulfilled - to reveal Katheryne's location. On December 2, 1995 Kazi was arrested for attempted murder in California. He was sentenced to life in prison. Investigators believed they could use his life sentence as leverage to convince Kazi to release Katheryne. So far, that hasn't happened but investigators are hopeful that Katheryne is still alive as they continue to follow up on every lead. Greene has a surgery scar on his left shoulder. He is 49, 5'11" and 230 pounds.

Percy Wayne Froman (Murder) -- Froman is wanted for murder and aggravated robbery. In the early morning hours of February 12, 1999 Froman fatally stabbed 50-year-old John Crumley, a Birmingham, Alabama resident he had befriended, then took of in Crumley's father's truck. Police say Froman has been known to hustle older men for money, but are not sure what his relationship was with Crumley. Crumley's father's truck was later recovered near Atlanta, Georgia. From Atlanta, authorities now know Froman went to Tyler, Texas where, on March 9, 1999, he beat and robbed a local motel clerk. He hasn't been seen since. Froman has used the aliases William Froman, Paul Fremont, Perez Wayne Froman, and Pers W. Froman. He has also used the surname Freeman. He has crooked and chipped front teeth, and his eyebrows slightly connect over the bridge of his nose. He may have dyed his hair blond, and may have facial hair. He talks a lot, and talks big, drives fast and recklessly, and is known to have a crack habit. He frequents gay nightclubs. Froman has a criminal history for larceny, credit card fraud, and drug possession, and has spent time in jail in several states. Froman is 29, 6'2" and 170 pounds.

Glen Dale Gore (Escape) -- Gore escaped from the Lexington Assessment and Reception Center in Lexington, Oklahoma on Wednesday, April 14, 1999. Gore was on a work detail, and when the guards went to do a visual count at around 2:00pm that day, he was nowhere to be

found. Gore was serving 40 years on burglary, kidnapping and assault charges. The next day two men who spent twelve years in prison for the 1982 rape and murder of Debra Carter were released after DNA tests ruled both out as the killers. Prosecutors say the DNA tests that cleared the two men identified Gore, a witness at both men's trials, as a suspect in that case, although no charges have been filed at this time. Gore is 38, 5'6" and 170 pounds.

Unknown (murder) -- Police are seeking clues in the murder of Boca Raton model and beauty queen Julie Wills, who was found murdered in her house on April 14, 1996. She had been stabbed repeatedly. Police speculate that the murderer was known to Wills because her dog did not raise an alarm. (See Shows #423 and #1002, OADs 8/25/96 and 11/16/96)

Dudley Vincent Forbes (murder) - Forbes beat his girlfriend, Lorna, beginning when she was four months pregnant. After the birth of her son, she and her two boys left but Forbes continued to stalk her, threatening to kill her and her whole family. Forbes broke into her apartment, and stabbed her 13 times before fleeing. After being tipped off by a friend, Forbes followed Lorna to a nightclub. After a brief altercation in the club he left, but returned to shoot the place up, killing two and wounding seven. Though usually soft-spoken, Forbes has an explosive temper. He has a welder's certificate and has worked as a forklift driver and compound mixer. Forbes enjoys playing soccer and dominoes. He is 37, 5'10" and 175 pounds, and speaks with a Jamaican accent. Viewer tips have placed Forbes in the Flatbush area of Brooklyn, New York, where he may be living under an assumed name. He is believed to be driving a grey 1988 or 1989 Honda with New York plates. No suggested changes. (See Shows #404, #414 and #1016, OADs 4/13/96, 5/22/96 and 3/15/97)

Augustin Rivas Salazar (Child Abuse) -- Augustin Salazar is wanted for two counts of child abuse and domestic abuse in Sauk County, Wisconsin. On January 4, 1999 Salazar threw his 4-month-old baby boy against a couch because he would not stop crying. As a result the child obtained a skull fracture and almost died. Salazar was then arrested and released on \$500,000 bond. He never attended his January 13, 1999 preliminary hearing and a warrant was issued for his arrest. It is believed that Salazar has fled to New Mexico or Mexico. Salazar has many aliases, including Augustin Rivas, Agustin Salazar Rivas and Agustin Rivas Salazar. He has a cross tattooed on his left arm. Salazar has partially curly hair and wears glasses. Salazar is 20, 5'10" and 175 pounds.

James Richard Bennett (rape; sexual abuse) -- Bennett is wanted in New York and Missouri for raping his two daughters from the time they were two years old until they were about eleven years old. Bennett has been a fugitive since November 22, 1987. Bennett would sneak into the girls' bedroom several times a week and order them to undress from the waist

down. He would tell them it was okay because he loved them very much. When the girls were in the fifth grade they told their teachers about the abuse. Before officials could have the girls tested for the abuse, Bennett packed up his family and took them on the road. State police found the family living in a trailer by a New York roadside. The children were placed into foster care and Bennett fled. After AMW featured Bennett in 1994, investigators learned that he had been living alone in a trailer in Arkansas. Officials now believe Bennett is "riding the rails" or hitchhiking with truck drivers. The last confirmed sightings of Bennett were in a rail yard in El Paso, Texas in April 1997, and then at a friend's house in Southern California in June 1997. Bennett has numerous tattoos, including an anchor on his lower left arm, "Jim" on his upper left arm, a dragon on his upper right arm, a dove on his right forearm, a skull and crossbones on his right hand, a cross on the back of his left shoulder, the word "Horoscope" on his right shoulder, and the word "Suck" on his left leg. He is going bald, but has big bushy eyebrows and may be wearing glasses. He may wear a leather belt with his name etched don it. He is a cigarette smoker, although he has had heart attacks and takes heart medication. He may be working in a mill, driving a truck, picking crops, homeless or riding the rails. Police in Houston are looking for the person or persons responsible for the death of Esperanza Rodriguez and the disappearance of her three-month-old baby, Francia, on April 8, 1999. On that Thursday afternoon, Houston firefighters responding to a burning apartment discovered the body of 24-year-old Esperanza Perez. She had been brutally stabbed and her apartment set on fire in an attempt to hide the crime. Baby Francia was nowhere to be found. Police are attempting to locate and question a woman known only as "Lupe" as a possible witness. Lupe had recently met Esperanza at the Magnolia Health Clinic and Esperanza told friends that Lupe was "helping her out". Witnesses from the clinic describe Lupe as a 35- to 45-year-old Hispanic woman, about 5'1", heavysset, with medium-length black hair and oles on her neck. Police do not know if "Lupe" is the woman's real name.

UPDATES:

Unknown (Murder) -- Forty-two-year-old Carole Sund were reported missing February 16, 1999, along with her 15-year-old daughter, Juliana Sund, and 16-year-old Silvina Pelosso, an exchange student. The Sacramento FBI says the women were traveling together. The trio left the San Francisco area on February 12 and planned to go to the University of the Pacific in Stockton, California. Then, authorities say, the three women were going to Yosemite National Park to sightsee. The FBI says the trio was supposed to return to San Francisco and meet Carole's husband Jens at the airport on February 16. They were planning to fly to Arizona to visit the Grand Canyon. The three women never met up with the rest of their group and were reported missing one day later. The women were last seen in the Yosemite area on February 15 and were driving a red Pontiac Grand Prix rental car with California license plates 4BMV025. Carole Sund's wallet was found in Modesto, California on February 19. There is a \$300,000 reward offered. On Thursday, March 18 the women's burnt-out rental car was found at Longbarn, California, some two hours north of the park. The next day authorities announced that two bodies had been found in the trunk of the car. The bodies were identified as Carole and Silvina. Juliana's body was found near Yosemite a few days later. A waitress in Modesto believes she served the women the day after their disappearance. Along Highway 108, near where the car was found, was another possible sighting at a gas station, possibly the same day. A further report places the women at a nearby gift shop. However, the FBI remains skeptical regarding all three reported sightings. Authorities are investigating several suspects, but to date no one has been charged with the crime. A tipster told authorities that a friend of his described the crime: it was intended as a simple carjacking by a group of local methamphetamine users. The murders "weren't supposed to happen". This information cannot be confirmed, but several details are precise and striking. The "friend" has been interviewed by authorities and denies the story. Robin Eileen Murray-O'Hair -- On August 28, 1995 Madalyn Murray-O'Hair, her son, Jon and her granddaughter, Robin disappeared from their home in Austin, Texas. To this day, no one knows whether they left voluntarily, or under duress. Their half-eaten breakfast was still on the table. Madalyn's medicine was left on the kitchen counter. Their beloved dogs were

abandoned. So - it looks like an abduction - right? Well here's the other side of the equation. Missing along with the Murray-O'Hair trio was \$600,000 from the bank accounts of the American Atheists. Police records show that the money was wired to New Jersey, where Helen Johnson, the successor to Madalyn's organization, The American Forum, was living. Though they say Helen has refused to speak about the matter, police say that Jon Murray flew from San Antonio to New Jersey on September 21, 1995. He was accompanied by a man using the alias Conrad Johnson. Who was this man? Some speculate that it could be a man named Danny Fry. In August 1995, Fry became the roommate of David Waters. An ex-con convicted of a 1964 murder, Waters had been employed by the O'Hairs until he was accused of stealing money from Madalyn. Police don't know if there's a direct link between Fry and the O'Hairs, but oddly, he disappeared around the same time as the family. Is it coincidence? Or connection? Records indicate that Jon and his mysterious accomplice returned to San Antonio on September 22. This is where police believe the Murray-O'Hair clan had stayed since their disappearance. Their cellular phone records show activity in San Antonio throughout September. Police believe they stayed at the Warren Inn. Whether some or all of the family was being kept there as hostages or whether they were staying of their own free will hasn't been determined. A few days after police believe the Murray-O'Hairs arrived in San Antonio, an unidentified person sold the family's Mercedes for \$15,000 - CASH. The transaction took place in a strip mall parking lot - right next to the Warren Inn. Oddly, the Warren Inn is one of the last confirmed locations for Danny Fry. On September 30, Danny Fry phoned his daughter from a pay phone there and told her that he was headed home to Austin. He reportedly had one other message for her: get ready for a shopping spree. One day earlier - on September 29, police say a San Antonio coin dealer transferred \$500,000 into gold coins for Jon Murray. The dealer told authorities that he actually received \$600,000 to exchange, but only had \$500,000 on hand. They conducted the exchange in the parking lot of a Frost Bank branch. Murray agreed to return in several days for the remainder, but he never did. Who would voluntarily give up \$100,000? Is it a sign that the family got spooked and ran? Or that they were acting under orders from some abductor? Investigators just don't know. There's another baffling piece to the puzzle - the Murray-O'Hairs had access to a lot more money in various bank accounts. But those accounts weren't touched. On November 2, 1995, Waters phoned police and informed them that his roommate, Danny Fry was missing; that call was a full month after Fry was last heard from. Though there's no direct link between Fry and the Murray-O'Hairs, investigators believe the coincidences are too great to ignore. Danny Fry's nude and mutilated body has been found. His body had been dumped in a river east of Dallas after his head and hands had been severed. Police suspect that the body of O'Hair and her two adult children have been dismembered, put into 55-gallon metal drums, and buried in Real County, Texas. Police are still looking for the bodies. David Waters has been arrested and implicated in the murder. Gary Karr has also been arrested and admitted involvement in O'Hair's disappearance, though he denies any part in their deaths. (See Show

Lance Marshall Bedgood (Murder) -- Lance Bedgood is wanted by Houston Police on capital murder charges for the 1987 slaying of a 64-year-old Sunday school teacher, Opal Zacharias, during an attempted burglary. On March 6, 1987, Bedgood confronted Zacharias in her garage. Police believe that Bedgood intended to burglarize the house and had been waiting for Zacharias to leave for work. During a struggle, Zacharias was shot in the hip. Bedgood then drove over her, carrying her body forty feet down the driveway. Bedgood fled. In 1989, in an effort to throw police off his track, Bedgood planted information that he had been killed in a shootout after a falling-out with a gang. But on September 14, 1990, Bedgood was seen alive in Silsbee, Texas by someone who knew him well. Police believe Bedgood is still alive. Bedgood is balding in front and wears stolen dentures to change the look of his face. He has scars over his left eye and on his upper right forehead, and numerous tattoos, including "Debbie" on his right chest, "Love" across his knuckles, dots on the backs of his fingers, a large multicolored stagecoach being attacked by Indians on his back, and other unknown tattoos on his legs. He speaks with a slow East Texas drawl. He has asthma, but does not take medication. He has worked as a painter and sandblaster, and on docks and in construction. He is a known marijuana, heroin and methamphetamine user. He was a member of the Aryan Brotherhood, and may carry a .38 or 9mm handgun. Bedgood is 55, 5'8" and 140 pounds. (See Shows #97 and #126, OADs 1/14/90 and 8/12/90)

William Bradford Bishop, Jr. (Murder) -- Bishop is wanted on five separate counts of murder in connection with the bludgeoning deaths of five members of his family at their home in Bethesda, Maryland. On March 2, 1976, a Forestry Service employee from Tyrrell County, North Carolina responded to the scene of a fire and found the bodies of the Bishop family -- Brad Bishop's wife, mother, and three sons -- buried in a shallow grave. A shovel found at the burial site was traced to a hardware store in Potomac, Maryland and the gas can to a Bethesda, Maryland Sears store. On March 8, 1976 police in Montgomery County investigating the family disappearance found the murder scene. Bishop's fingerprints were matched to those on the gas can. The family's station wagon, used to transport the bodies, was found abandoned near the Elkmont Mountain Campground, just outside Gatlinburg, Tennessee. New information from State Department files indicates that Bishop may have fled with the help of a female accomplice, who may have been on parole from a North Carolina prison. Bishop likes to work out several times per week. He is a strong skier, plays tennis, and is fond of hiking and the outdoors. He is an amateur pilot and enjoys riding motorcycles. He reads extensively and may keep a diary or journal. He is described as intense and self-absorbed, and may be subject to violent outbursts. He may seek psychiatric care for depression or anxiety, and may suffer from insomnia. He likes a neat and orderly environment. He trained as a military intelligence officer, and is well versed

in economic analysis and self-hypnosis. He speaks fluent Italian, Serbo-Croatian, Spanish and French. He drinks scotch and wine, and is known to enjoy spicy foods. Bishop is 62, 6'1" and 180 pounds. (See Shows #180, #217, #335, #346 and #537, OADs 9/13/981, 6/12/992, 10/8/94, 12/31/94 and 4/10/99)

CAPTURED:

Rafael Camarena (drug smuggling) -- This Mexican "businessman" built a warehouse in Douglas, Arizona just across the U.S.-Mexican border and linked it to a 100 yard long, \$2 million underground tunnel originating in his home in Agua Prieta. After authorities seized 2,000 pounds of cocaine, he fled. The Mexican police picked up Camarena as a drug smuggler, but convicted him under the name Zamora. It took a while for authorities to realize that Zamora and Camarena were the same person. US authorities are attempting to extradite Camarena. (See Shows #123, #128, #165 and #209, OADs 7/22/90, 8/26/90, 5/31/91 and 4/10/92)

The following are the featured fugitives and others being sought by federal, state or local authorities. The Update (if any) gives current status, previous references, or related information.

Michel Barrera (Attempted Murder, Armed Burglary) -- Barrera is wanted by the FBI for the 1998 armed robbery of two Miami banks, carjacking a Miami man, and the attempted murder of a Metro-Dade police officer during his getaway. Agents say on February 3, 1998, Michel Barrera and his accomplice robbed the Terra Bank in Miami, Florida, of approximately \$19,000. Then, on May 1, 1998 around 1:00pm they robbed the Republic National Bank in Miami at gunpoint. Following the robbery, the two men fled the bank and a high-speed chase ensued with Metro-Dade police officers. During the chase, cops say the two suspects fired on pursuing officers, then carjacked and severely injured a Miami civilian before ditching his car in a canal. Search teams combed the heavily foliated area near the canal and were able to find and arrest Barrera's accomplice, but Michel Barrera was nowhere to be found. Barrera, a Cuban immigrant, comes across as a sweet, nice young boy. However, he is a known gang member who may try to recruit other teenagers to commit crimes and may be hanging out with "punk" teenagers on the street. He has used the aliases Michael Barrera, Rene Caso, and Christopher Montefu. He has a burn scar on his left shoulder and "Maria" tattooed on his upper right rear shoulder, although he may have tattooed over this and grown his hair longer to change his appearance. He is always armed and has been known to impersonate a cop in home-invasion robberies. Barrera is a known drug user and loves to drink Malt liquor. He enjoys playing paintball, and frequents shooting ranges. Michel Barrera is 19, 5'8" and 145 pounds. (See Show #519, OAD 11/21/98)

Unknown (murder) -- On January 13, 1996 in Arlington, Texas witnesses saw an unidentified man driving a black pickup approach 9-year-old Amber Hagerman, grab her from her bicycle, and abduct her. Her body was found four days later. She had been sexually molested and her throat had been slashed five times. The killer is 25-35 years old, and under 6' tall. The police task force investigating the crime are seeking the help of convicts who may know something about Amber's killer, and are also still asking for any assistance the public can provide. (See Show #1010, OAD 1/25/97)

Unknown (Kidnapping) -- Dallas police are looking for the man who abducted 9-year-old Fleisha Moore on March 25, 1999. Fleisha and a friend were on their way home from school around 3:30pm when a man, standing in a church parking lot, started talking to the girls. After a few minutes the man grabbed Fleisha, dragged her to his pickup truck and took off. Police immediately put the "Amber Plan" into effect, broadcasting a description of the abductor and the abductor's truck. Fleisha later told police that after a few hours her abductor abruptly pulled over near a field and told her to get out of the truck. It was there, on I-45 about 60 miles from where she has been abducted, that Fleisha was found by the police. Police believe the "Amber Plan" is responsible for the abductor releasing Fleisha. The "Amber Plan" is a missing child alert system broadcast by radio stations that went into effect in July of 1997. It is named after Amber Hagerman, a 9-year-old Arlington, Texas girl who was abducted and killed in January of 1996. Police are still looking for Fleisha's abductor and are asking the public's help with any information they may have in the case.

John Reginald Killick (Armed Robbery, Firearms, Escape)

Lucy Dudko (Aiding and Abetting Escape) -- Police in Sydney, Australia are looking for Killick and Dudko. Killick escaped from prison on the morning of March 13, 1999 after his girlfriend Lucy Dudko hijacked a helicopter. Dudko forced the pilot to land on Silverwaters Prison Sport Field where Killick was waiting. Killick boarded the craft; Dudko handed him a pistol and he immediately began shooting at the prison guards. After the helicopter cleared the fence Dudko and Killick forced the pilot to land at a nearby soccer field. The two then hijacked a car and released the driver in North Sydney where authorities believe the two hopped a cab to the harbor where they may have fled by boat. They could now be anywhere in the world. Killick, who speaks with a distinct Australian accent, is a charismatic con-artist who considers himself a ladies man. He likes to pose as a writer, and has been known to disguise himself. Killick is 57, 5'10" and 180 pounds. Dudko speaks with a Russian accent. She wears glasses, and has worked as a translator. Dudko is 40, 5'8" and 120 pounds.

Larry Porter Chism (Escape) -- Larry Chism was serving a 40-year sentence for armed robbery, narcotics and violation of age of consent when he escaped on September 13, 1978, from the Turney Center in Only, Tennessee. During a bowling outing for inmates, Chism and three other inmates overpowered guards and fled with a hostage. After stealing a car from a fast food restaurant, Chism hijacked a plane to his home state of Arkansas. Chism was later captured and pled guilty to kidnapping, and was sentenced to 30 years on November 9, 1978. He was placed in the Lonoke County, Arkansas jail but almost two months later, on December 22, 1978, Chism escaped again. In January 1990, federal agents located Chism in Charlotte, North Carolina, living with Debra Brookins and using the alias Kenneth Lamara Brookins. In December 1990 Chism had traveled to Atlanta, Georgia where he sold his vehicle. In Charlotte, Chism and his girlfriend Debra Brookins were connected to a local charity called Christians United for People. Chism has scars on both arms. He wears thick prescription glasses or contact lenses. He is a heroin addict who has operated a drug ring with teen heroin addicts, and also smokes marijuana. He has a BA in accounting and three years of law school, and was the former editor of a prison newspaper. He has worked as a carpenter in warm weather climates. He enjoys hunting, fishing,

tennis, swimming, watching TV and reading. He served time in Vietnam, and frequently wears baseball caps. Authorities report Chism has a bullet-proof vest and a police scanner. He is known to frequent flea markets and auctions. Chism is 50, 5'10" and 150 pounds. (See Shows #341 and #375, OADs 11/19/94 and 8/5/95)

Unknown (Murder) -- Police in Bakersfield, California are looking for those responsible for the murder of 31-year-old Tina Blunt. Tina was last seen leaving her house around 3:30am on the morning of March 31, 1999. She was on her way to the Meadows Field Airport for her 4:00am shift as a ticketing agent for Delta Skywest Airlines, but she never made it. Tina's maroon 1993 Chevrolet S-10 Blazer was recovered a few days later on the side of the road in a residential area about 5 miles from her house. The location of the car was not along the normal route Tina would take to her job. Tina's body was found on Wednesday, April 14, 1999 in a field about ten miles from her home. The Carrington Foundation, a reward fund established by Carole Sund's parents, has contributed \$30,000 to make a total of \$40,000 being offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime.

Tina Marie Cornelius

Age: 22

Height: 5'1"

Weight: 128 pounds

Tina Cornelius has been missing from Williamson County, Texas since Monday, April 19, 1999. Tina's two children, 2-year-old Dominic Logan Cornelius and 3-year-old Amanda Miller Cornelius, were found dead on April 19 at around 4:30pm. The children's bodies were located on a bank of the Brushy Creek, which is about 20 miles north of Austin, Texas. Dominic had suffered blunt force trauma to his head, and Amanda was suffocated. Tina is nowhere to be found. Police are asking the public's assistance with any information they may have on this case. Tina Cornelius is described as very friendly and talkative. She likes to wear slacks and blouses. She knows auto mechanics and has worked as a clerk at Wal-Mart, but she was last working as a topless dancer. She was driving a 1990 white Pontiac two-door Grand Prix with Texas license plate ZPC-70M.

Police say six- year-old Opal Jennings was abducted on March 26, 1999 from her home in Saginaw, Texas. At around 5:30 that evening Opal was in her front yard playing with two other children when she was apparently abducted. Police say a man parked his car, got out, picked up Opal and put her in the front passenger seat of his car and took off. The abductor was described to police as a white or Hispanic male with shoulder length dark hair, possibly worn in a ponytail. The suspect may have been wearing a dark t-shirt, pants, tennis shoes and a red baseball cap. Police say they think he may have been driving a dark colored car (blue, purple or black) with tinted windows, silver or chrome wheels, bondo or primer spots on the front hood. Authorities say the car has been described as having no front license plate had has a dirty or unkept appearance and may be a Chrysler product. Opal is missing her upper front tooth, and has a lower front tooth just coming in. She has a chicken pox scar on the corner of her left eye. Her nickname is Opal Jo. When last seen, she was wearing a white t-shirt with purple vertical stripes and flowers, purple shorts or pants, white socks, pink and white Barbie tennis shoes, and was wearing her hair in pigtails. Morgan Nick

Morgan Nick was abducted from Alma, Arkansas on June 9, 1995. Morgan went to a local baseball game with her mother and grandmother. Morgan and other children went to play in a sand pile nearby. On their way back, Morgan stopped to empty sand out of her shoes. The other children kept walking. That was the last time the children saw Morgan. Witnesses told police they saw a man put Morgan into a dull red colder model Ford pick-up truck with a red-and-white shell camper which has damage to the right rear side. He was described as a white male, six feet tall, with a medium build. He is 25-40 years old and has a dark mustache and beard. The Alma, Arkansas Police Department and other agencies are now investigating two other abductions, apparently by the same suspect. Police say Morgan's abductor tried to kidnap other area children on June 9th and 10th. Witnesses said that on Friday, June 9, 1995 at 10:30am the suspect enticed a 4-year-old girl into the same red truck at a local Alma laundry. The abductor released the child when her mother approached him and screamed. The second incident occurred in Fort Smith, Arkansas, approximately 15 miles from Alma. A man fitting the same description as Morgan's abductor tried to entice a 9-year-old into a men's restroom at a local convenience store. The little girl pulled away and the suspect backed off. Arkansas State Police have announced that they are now searching for a serial abductor. When last seen, Morgan Nick had shoulder-length hair and

Michael Petrow

Age: 29

Height: 5'10"

Weight: 165 pounds

Michael Petrow has been missing since April 16, 1999. Petrow and his girlfriend had an unrelated argument earlier in the day. The two made up and she went out with friends. When she returned home, she found various notes around the house, including a packing list. There was no indication of where Petrow would have gone. Petrow went to his place of employment on the evening of April 16 or early morning hours of April 17, and took \$2,500 from the safe. Petrow also took two guitars, one of which he left at his grandfather's house. Petrow has recently used the credit cards he shares with his parents. An Aamco card was used on April 16 at an unknown location in Jacksonville, Florida, and on April 17 in Valdosta, Georgia. Petrow has a rose tattooed on his left shoulder. He has long hair and looks young for his age. He has several piercings, including a small ring in the webbing between his ring and pinky fingers of his right hand, two earrings in his left ear and a ring in his right nipple. He is a known alcohol abuser, reportedly depressed, and possibly suicidal. He was last seen driving a teal two-door 1994 Acura with Broward County, Florida license plate VGF97V. Petrow is 29, 5'10" and 165 pounds.

UPDATE:

Rex Allen Krebs -- Krebs is a major suspect in the disappearance of San Luis Obispo, California college students Aundria Crawford and Rachel Newhouse since the discovery of the remains of two females on his property. Krebs is currently in jail on unrelated charges. He is not under suspicion in the disappearance of another student, Kristin Smart, as he was incarcerated at the time she disappeared.

CAPTURED:

Randolph Allan Biernat (Sex Charges) -- in 1994, Randolph Biernat plead guilty to First Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct for the ongoing sexual relationship he had with his stepdaughter, "Jenny". According to authorities in Wayne county, Michigan, the abuse began when "Jenny" was only six years old and the abuse continued until she was sixteen. When "Jenny" was thirteen years old she actually confided in a cousin about the abuse. Eventually school officials found out and social service workers were called into the school and met with the girl. However, according to the victim, Biernat threatened he would kill himself and therefore the victim's mother would blame her. "Jenny" was so scared she told investigators she had lied about the whole thing. According to police, the abuse continued for three more years until "Jenny" was sixteen. At that point she moved out of the house and moved in with a friend. Again social service workers and school officials met with "Jenny" but the abuse was hard to prove. It wasn't until "Jenny" was nineteen, three years after she moved out of the house, that charges were brought against Biernat. "Jenny's" younger brother had found a videotape that Biernat had made which showed him sexually abusing his stepdaughter. A search warrant was executed and cops found more videotapes as well as a book on father/daughter incest. Biernat was arrested but he was able to post bail. Eventually Biernat plead guilty to the charges and he was scheduled to be sentenced on June 24, 1994, but he never appeared before the court. Instead he sent the judge a letter explaining he was mentally ill during the abuse and that he has sought psychiatric help. He also explained that he was sorry for abusing "Jenny" and that he would do any type of community service to stay out of jail. Then he disappeared. Following the broadcast, tipsters identified him as a boys' soccer coach in Canada, using the alias "Jim Martin", which he stole from the tombstone of a small boy. Using this identity, he obtained a driver's license and Canadian passport. He became friendly with a couple who had young children, and tried to get close to the 8-year-old boy; however, when the mother of the family saw Biernat profiled on AMW she called to the tip line and authorities picked him up in Vancouver without incident.
