Section I: Issues

- A. **Recreation More Recreational Opportunities for Youth:** There is a general feeling that citizens in the area must travel to Houston, San Antonio, or Corpus Christi to have access to safe family friendly recreational activities.
- B. **Education Access to Educational Resources in Victoria County:** Victoria has high rates of high school dropouts and a lower percentage of people with advanced degrees, which are needed to fuel continued growth opportunities in the community.
- C. **Health/Wellness Healthier Living Options:** Victoria County suffers from higher-than-average obesity and diabetes rates than average for Texas communities. There needs to be more wellness programs and healthier living programs in the community.
- D. Veterans More Resources for Local Veterans including Mental Health Care: Suicide rates and mortality rates for Veterans in Victoria County exceed national and state averages. There is the need for more Veteran focused programs to reverse the trend.
- E. Public Safety Ways to Strengthen Victoria Public Safety and Maintain Security in local neighborhoods: Crime rates are falling and there is a general feeling that things are not going in the right direction.
- F. Poverty More Resources for Coping with Hunger/Homeless in Victoria: There are more homeless on area streets and programs that feed the poor are finding it difficult to provide enough services for those who need it.
- G. **Economy Expanding Economic Opportunities:** Texas is in the middle of an economic boom. People in the area worry that Victoria is not keeping up.
