Pursuant to Section 325 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and Section 76.64 of the FCC rules, this is to notify you that **KCNC-TV** (the "Station"), assigned to the Denver, Colorado market (the "DMA"), elects the retransmission consent option with respect to carriage of the Station's signal on the cable system that Loveland owns and operates (the "System") that serves communities in the DMA for the 2020-2023 election period.

It will be necessary for Loveland to obtain our express, prior, and written consent in order to retransmit **KCNC-TV's** signal. In no event may the Station be carried pursuant to the FCC's must carry rules.

For purposes of clarification, this election letter does not authorize the System or any other video distribution system to retransmit the signal of the Station in any manner.
