Dear Ms. Shanley:

We are in receipt of your notice that the City of Fort Collins intends to commence to provide cable television services to subscribers in the city of Fort Collins. Pursuant to Section 325 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and Section 76.64 of the FCC rules, this is to notify you that KCNC-TV, Denver, CO ("Station"), assigned to the Denver market ("DMA"), elects the retransmission consent option with respect to carriage of Station's signal on the cable systems and/or other multichannel video programming systems that you own, operate, or control that serve communities in the DMA for the 2018-2020 election period.

It will be necessary for your system to obtain our express, prior, and written consent in order to retransmit KCNC-TV's signal. Please contact Samira Sharif at samira.sharif@cbs.com or Mike Correia at mike.correia@cbs.com to negotiate an arrangement whereby you can provide the Station's signal to your customers. In no event may the Station be carried pursuant to the FCC's must carry rules.

For purposes of clarification, this election letter does not authorize your cable system(s) or other video distribution system(s) to retransmit the signal of the Station in any manner.

We look forward to building our relationship on mutually satisfactory terms and providing great programming for our shared viewers to enjoy.
