FIRST QUARTER OF 2023—JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH**

During the months of January, February and March 2023, WGOL aired daily public service announcements on a regular basis. These range from a variety of spots about receiving free COVID-19 testing kits to programs where small businesses could apply for tax credits for retaining employees during the pandemic.

Additionally, WGOL airs a daily community calendar with announcements for non-profit groups in our community. We aired announcements for numerous community events including Martin Luther King, Jr. Day activities in the City of Russellville and city council meetings. Also, we aired updates about registration for Parks and Recreation registration for spring sports of softball and baseball.

During the quarter, we aired PSAs on upcoming church and civic events of local community interest. These included subjects ranging from a public hearing to consider moving three voting precincts in the City of Russellville.

Some of the specific programs we aired relevant to local issues included:

January 10, 2023: Rev. Charles Dale interview to discuss Russellville hosting Martin Luther King, Jr. Day activities. The annual MLK Committee rotates the location of each year's ceremony among three cities and Russellville hosted the 2023 events.

January 23, 2023: Russellville High School Principal Jeremy Madden discussed the first Community Partnership Breakfast hosted on January 25, 2023, to improve relations between the school and business and community leaders.

February 1, 2023: Interview with new Russellville High School baseball coach Jess Smith to discuss taking over a three-time state champion program and discuss his roster and the upcoming season.

February 15, 2023: Interview with local officials to promote the Career Expo to take place at the A.W. Todd Centre. The event provides high school seniors the opportunity to interview and learn about local job opportunities immediately upon graduation.

February 28, 2023: Interview with Franklin County Commissioner Jason Miller about the Alabama Republican Party State Executive Committee Winter Meeting. Miller represents Franklin County as its committee member and he discussed events and goals for the state party.

March 16, 2023: Interview with 1980 RHS graduate Mark Kelly on the show his band, the Burnells, will perform on March 31st at Russellville's Roxy Theatre. The show will benefit the newly-formed Russellville Homeless Coalition.

We continue to air daily updates on news matters related to the COVID-19 health crisis, including any changes or announcements from Gov. Kay Ivey or the State of Alabama.
